Preface

When God speaks, you listen. When you understand how God speaks, then you are on the path to understanding the truth in God's word. God's word doesn't mean anything, unless you want to know the truth. Do not have a complacent attitude toward repetitive acts of religion and the endless repetition of religious verses. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. And God said, Let there be light: and there was light. And God saw the light, that it was good: and God divided the light from the darkness.

God measures your attitude by the things that you love from the heart. God requires you to make a decision to either love the things of your flesh or of the spirit. God will challenge you and it is up to you to put your trust in him. When you believe in the one true God, then God will seek to use your services. God tested Abraham with a request to offer his son. Abraham did as God directed and God saw that his heart was pure. God

then presented Abraham a ram for a burnt offering. When God speaks, you listen.

Genesis 22:1-3,7-8,10-13,15-16,18 - And it came to pass after these things, that God did tempt Abraham, and said unto him, Abraham: and he said, Behold, here I am. And he said, Take now thy son, thine only son Isaac, whom thou lovest, and get thee into the land of Moriah; and offer him there for a burnt offering upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of. And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and saddled his ass, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son, and clave the wood for the burnt offering, and rose up, and went unto the place of which God had told him. And Isaac spake unto Abraham his father, and said, My father: and he said, Here am I, my son. And he said, Behold the fire and the wood: but where is the lamb for a burnt offering? [8] And Abraham said, My son, God will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together. And Abraham stretched forth his hand, and took the knife to slay his son. And the angel of the LORD called unto him out of heaven, and said, Abraham, Abraham: and he said, Here am I. And he said, Lay not thine hand upon the lad, neither do thou any thing unto him: for now I know that thou fearest God, seeing thou hast not withheld thy son, thine only son from me. And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind him a ram caught in a thicket by his horns: and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering in the stead of his son. And the angel of the LORD called unto Abraham out of heaven the second time, And said, By myself have I sworn, saith the LORD, for because thou hast done this thing, and hast not withheld thy son, thine only son: And in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice.

When you walk in the light, the devil will put temptation of sin in your way daily. When you partake of this temptation, you enter into darkness. You can't live in the light, while walking in darkness. When you understand God's word, you know exactly what you are to do to please God. Do not be deceived. After God created Adam, he told Adam not to dwell in darkness by eating of the tree of knowledge. God then created Eve and she ate of the tree of knowledge. When Adam saw that nothing happened to Eve, he too ate of the tree of knowledge. The devil will tell you that this one beer won't hurt! When God gives you a command, then you listen. Never doubt the power of God's word.

Genesis 2:15-17,23 - And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it. And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die. And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.

When God shows you his power, he is preparing you to do great things for him. After God called out Moses from the burning bush, God made it clear that Moses was to deliver his people out of the hands of the Egyptians.

Exodus 3:2-4,6,8 - And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush: and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed. And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt. And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, Here am I. Moreover he said, I am the God of thy father, the God of

Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God. And I am come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up out of that land unto a good land and a large, unto a land flowing with milk and honey; unto the place of the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites

God speaks to you when you least expect it. The Lord God spoke to Moses in a cloud. All Moses could do is to bow his head and worship.

Exodus 34:5-8 - And the LORD descended in the cloud, and stood with him there, and proclaimed the name of the LORD. And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth, keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation. And Moses made haste, and bowed his head toward the earth, and worshipped.

God no longer found pleasure in the sinful life of the people and sin sacrifice by burnt offerings. He needed to turn them away from the sacrifice of animals for the remission of sins. To love from the heart is more than the total sum of all burnt offerings and sacrifices. Burnt offerings can never take away sin.

Mark 12:33 - And to love him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love his neighbour as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices.

Hebrews 10:11 - And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins:

At thirty years old. Jesus had no clue as to what was about to happen in his life. Jesus was sent by God. John the Baptist was sent by God to baptize for the remission of sins. God gave Jesus an introduction to the job at hand like no other. God spoke from heaven, telling all that Jesus was his beloved Son in a monumental fashion. (Matthew 3:16,17; Mark 1:8-11; Luke 3:22)

Luke 3:22 - And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased.

As a prophet, Jesus experienced little honor amongst his own.

Mark 6:4-6 - But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, but in his own country, and among his own kin, and in his own house. And he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed them. And he marvelled because of their unbelief. And he went round about the villages, teaching.

When God spoke, Jesus listened. God knew that Jesus needed followers to carry God's word to the ends of the earth. God spoke from a cloud. God told his disciples to hear Jesus. (Matthew 17:1-5; Mark 9:2,7)

Mark 9:2,7 - And after six days Jesus taketh with him Peter, and James, and John, and leadeth them up into an high mountain apart by themselves: and he was transfigured before them. And there was a cloud that overshadowed them: and a voice came out of the cloud, saying, This is my beloved Son: hear him.

*Jesus knew that his followers must do the will of God the Father.
(Matthew 12:50; Mark 3:35)*

Matthew 12:50 - For whosoever shall do the will of my Father
which is in heaven, the same is my brother, and sister, and
mother.

*When God texted me “Ecclesiastes” and then “Romans 8:28”, I
listened. When God sent me the jail ministry, I listened. When
God sent me verse after verse and witness after witness to
document the truth in his word, I listened. When God sent me
“Ecclesiastes 4:12-15”, I knew my witness to the fifty plus
churches was completed. God’s gospel of Love shown forth
from the truth in God’s word out of the mouth of two or three
witnesses. So simple and so pure. A doctrine for all of mankind

Chapter 1: Introduction

At 59 years old, my wife and I started studying the bible. Growing up with little, we were trained to work hard. Shortly after starting my walk with God's word, my phone had a text message at work, as though I texted the message myself, which read, "Ecclesiastes." After reading that book seven times, it is clear that God does not intend for one to give up your life for the glory of money. The message is simple. Vanity of vanities, all is vanity.

Shortly thereafter, I wanted freedom from years of addictions and walked free from them on 12/3/13. What is 12/3/13 in bible numbers: 12 – Government perfection/Divine Authority; 3 – Divine fullness/Perfection; 13 – Rebellion. Twelve years later in this ministry, I recognized that God's plan for me was to rebel against the doctrine of man and to put forth the truth in God's word. His word that is perfect out of the mouth of two or three witnesses and establishes God's divine authority.

After three years studying the bible at that first church, I knew God wanted more out of me. I prayed. God gave my wife and I pneumonia to break us of that drive to that church and we went to a second church closer to home. Although it was a bible church, it was not in God's plan for us to be there. The church was musty and we went to a third church. It was there that God put me into the jail ministry, working with addicts. Once your walk with the Lord matures, you'll recognize that God's has a plan for you. My walk started when I repented of my sins, asked for forgiveness and started fresh.

This third church's doctrine was all about the false doctrine of saving people, without repentance, which is not God's will. It was this error that drove me to publish his first Gospel book, "Jesus Is Coming." Telling an addict that he is saved by

repeating a couple bible verses and then telling them that they can never lose their salvation is deception. I knew that I could save no one. A person has to want a life with God. Over and over again, I prayed to God to help me out on this false doctrine. Finally, on 9/6/21 God texted me "Romans 8:28" on my phone, in the same manner as he texted me "Ecclesiastes."

Romans 8:28 - And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

After I received this text, I sent a text to the pastors and ask them not to send people to the jail and promise the inmates salvation by reading a couple of bible verses. After some excitement, a short time later the jail ministry was mine. Later, I looked up the bible numbers for that date. 9/6/21 in bible numbers is, "A message from God to a man in distress."

It was then, when God sent me three witnesses. These three witnesses reinforce his doctrine of salvation per the will of God. Let's review these witnesses.

Witness #1: Thomas was raised as a Catholic. He showed his love of God by loving people. Only God knows when Thomas was converted from a lover of self to a lover of God and people. His love has shown forth in his many years of volunteering and coaching youth sports. Thomas died on the surgery table and saw himself on the table on his way to heaven. He talked to God in heaven and also talked to his brother that died by miscarriage. Thomas stated that heaven was beauty, calm and peace beyond description. Thomas did not want to come back to earth. God said that he was not done with Thomas and sent him back to earth to be a witness. Thomas had been dead for over 22 minutes.

Witnesses #2: Rick had been a lover of himself for 60 years. He loved people, but sin ruled his life. He had no time for God. His wife was raised in a Church of God and raised their family in the love of God. At 60 years old, Rick repented of his sins and fell in love with God. Being born again, people loved Rick as a Christian. In his battle with cancer, Rick lost a lung and struggled to breathe while on oxygen. Rick never gave up his faith in Jesus Christ. He battled through two cases of COVID and had died and went to heaven. He talked to God and testified that heaven was beauty beyond belief. God sent him back to earth to be a testimony for God. Rick endured to the end and is now with the Lord.

Witnesses #3: Randy is a lover of self, alcohol and drunkenness. He was saved and baptized in a Baptist Church. His life is living hell. His house is trashed. His cars don't work. Adult children don't work. When I met Randy, his third wife of 38 years had just tried to kill him with a knife. He wanted his wife to be saved and baptized. His wife wants Randy dead and out of her life. I prayed with Randy that he'd give his life over to God. To repent of his sins and live his life for the glory of God. After 30 minutes, I got back into my Jeep and realized that the engine had been running and it was still in drive!

Three witnesses. Three testimonies.

#1 - Thomas is doing the will of God and is alive with Christ.

#2 - Rick did the will of God and his testimony (recorded by his daughter) is leading many people to Christ.

#3 – Randy is walking with the devil, confused by man's religion into thinking his sinful life has saved him.

During his last month on life here on earth, my brother-in-law was experiencing organ failure. After receiving several pints of

blood, Warner had recovered and we all prayed for God's mercy. Warner then immediately told us of the time he was engulfed in the flames of a 60 feet long fiery furnace that exploded and not a hair on his face was singed. His coworkers thought he would be dead. In Daniel 3, the Lord kept Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-nego safe from the flames of the fiery furnace. God kept them and Warner safe from the fiery furnace. I told Warner that God has kept him safe his whole life. It is now time to give God the glory and accept Jesus as your Lord and Savior. Repent of your sins, ask for forgiveness and ask to be with him in heaven. Only you can ask God for this gift. We all cried and prayed. None of us know if he asked God for salvation.

*One-week later Warner was moved into a nursing home. I took four of my latest books to the nursing home facility to visit Warner. With the titles of the books hidden by showing the only back of each book facing up, I asked the receptionist, Simone, if she would like a gospel book. What she saw was black with white letters. No titles. I told her to pick one and God will give her the one she needs. She picked "**Power of God.**" Totally amazed, she opened her journal and she showed us the last line where she asked God to show her his power! Simone, my wife and I had witnessed the power of God. The next morning at the jail ministry, a man also picked the book, "**Power of God**". The following morning, my granddaughter also picked the book, "**Power of God.**" These were three separate cases on three sequential days. All picking the Power of God from a group of four books.*

God sent me another witness, Ron Wyatt, who had prayed to God and asked God to use him to prove the bible real. Through Ron Wyatt, an anesthesiologist, God proved the bible real. God directed Ron to find, Noah's Ark, the Red Sea crossing, Mt Sinai, Sodom and Gomorrah and the Ark of the Covenant. While Ron

was walking outside the walls of Jerusalem, God directed Ron where to dig and to find the Ark of the Covenant. In an area filled with loose rock, like as a dump, Ron found the original site of where Jesus was crucified. At the base of the cross, the rock was rent or cracked as described in the bible at the time of the death of Jesus. In a cave immediately below this crack, Ron had found the Ark of the Covenant covered in dried blood. He scrapped up the blood and filled a 35mm film cannister. The blood was reconstituted in saline at body temperature by stirring for 72 hours and it became alive with white blood cells. This is not normal as white blood cells of dried blood are dead and never come back to life. Jesus's blood came back to life. The white blood cells contained only 24 chromosomes and not the normal 46. 23 chromosomes were from Mary and only 1 (a single Y chromosome) from the Holy Ghost. The other 22 chromosomes, normally from a male, were not there. With physical characteristics of Mary, Jesus was no ordinary man. Only half Jew, like as a Samaritan. The Jewish leaders told Ron that the Ark of the Covenant would be unveiled when the temple is finished. Documentaries by Ron Wyatt are on the web, describing God's plan.

Ron's findings confirmed God's word to be real:

- 1) Noah's Ark – God stopped the car three times to locate the Ark and key sites, earthquake after the find to confirm structure of boat. Sonar and spectrum analysis confirmed boat construction. Core drill confirmed animal dung, cat hair and metal working ballast deep in the hull.*
- 2) Red Sea crossing – Crossing site down the Red Sea, with findings of artifacts from Egyptian chariot wheels, etc.*

- 3) *Mt Sinai – Burnt Sinai mountain, split rock, altar and gold smelting furnace. Pattern for wing of Ark of the Covenant.*
- 4) *Sodom and Gomorrah – Vitrified landscape, 99% elemental pure Sulphur balls, not found in nature.*
- 5) *Ark of the Covenant – Confirmed existence of the Ark of the Covenant, table of shew bread, seven branch candle stick holder, Golden altar of incense, Golden Censer, Brass shekel weight, book of the laws and ten commandment tablets.*

Salvation for the Gentiles is a promise from God out of the New Testament. My lessons focus on New Testament doctrine. God had me publish several lessons on Jonah and the city of Nineveh following a documentary on Nineveh, sent to me by my son. Two months later, God sent his eclipse over middle America that passed over several towns named Nineveh. My son asked me to go to that 4/8/24 eclipse and following the witness with 350 “Redemption” and “Best You Now” gospel tracts, God sent me several witnesses. God made it clear that the Salem eclipse seven years earlier and this Nineveh eclipse were not just random. They were planned by God. Several days later God launched his churches, Church of Nineveh and One World Church with a dream and his third verse given to me, “Ecclesiastes 4:12-15.” I knew that God wanted my witness to the 50+ churches terminated.

Ecclesiastes 4:12-15 - And if one prevail against him, two shall withstand him; and a threefold cord is not quickly broken. Better is a poor and a wise child than an old and foolish king, who will no more be admonished. For out of prison he cometh to reign; whereas also he that is born in his kingdom becometh poor. I considered all the living which walk under the sun, with the second child that shall stand up in his stead.

*After working with the guys in the jail, of all different denominations, I prayed to God, weekly to help me find the truth in his word. That truth is established by the preponderance of evidence out of the testimony of two or three witnesses. Four times in the Old Testament and eight times in the New Testament God tells you through 5 witnesses, that out of the mouth of two or three witnesses you shall know the truth. That doctrine is used to establish the word of God and his doctrine for the Church of Nineveh and One World Church. His doctrine out of the multiple witnesses, found its way, starting into God's sixth book, "**New Beginning.**"*

God is real. He will use you if you let him. Today, this can be the start of your new beginning.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 2: God is King

All that has been made known to you from the preponderance of evidence from the testimony of the witnesses reveals that God is King. Multiple lessons have pointed to the power of God that makes God, the King.

God is the beginning and the end. God is the Alpha and the Omega. God is a spirit that no one has ever seen. God is responsible for all that you see and all that you don't see. God created the heaven and the earth!

Genesis 1:1 - In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

You are to worship God, who made heaven and earth.

Revelation 14:7 - Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.

God reveals himself in the New Testament as the one and only true God. He is the God that sent Jesus to the earth.

John 17:3 - And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent.

God in the Spirit that no one has ever seen.

John 4:24 - God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

1 John 4:12 - No man hath seen God at any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and his love is perfected in us.

The one and only true God that sent Jesus to be a propitiation for your past sins.

Romans 3:25 - Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;

1 John 4:10 - Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

The only true God that raised up Jesus from the dead, following his crucifixion. You are bought with a price. May your faith and hope be in the one true God. Therefore, glorify God in your body and spirit and bringing forth your fruit unto God. (See Acts 2:32; Acts 3:15,22,26; Acts 10:40; Acts 13:30; 1 Corinthians 6:14,20; Romans 7:4; Galatians 1:1; Colossians 2:12; 1 Peter 1:21)

Acts 3:15,22,26 - And killed the Prince of life, whom God hath raised from the dead; whereof we are witnesses. For Moses truly said unto the fathers, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you. Unto you first God, having raised up his Son Jesus, sent him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities.

1 Peter 1:21 - Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God.

God is one God and one Lord God. The preponderance of evidence from the multiple witnesses, will overwhelm you. Verse after verse from the mouth of eight New Testament witnesses, God is referred to as the one and also one God. The Lord our God is one Lord. In these verses, the witnesses are giving testimony of Jesus recognizing the God almighty as one God. (See Matthew 19:17; Mark 10:18; Mark 12:29; Luke 18:19; Romans 3:30)

Mark 12:29 - And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord:

Romans 3:30 - Seeing it is one God, which shall justify the circumcision by faith, and uncircumcision through faith.

You will stand before God and give account of yourself on judgement day. You can believe and tremble in the hope of pleasing the almighty God or you can believe by loving God and living your life doing the will of God. You see, the devil believes, but he is not going to love nor serve God.

James 2:19 - Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.

Romans 14:12 - So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.

You are exposed to the power of God on a daily basis. Slow down and pray. Be his witness. Find that place where God talks to you. You will see his power. You will see that God is King over all the earth. He is King above all gods. Today, you will hear his voice.

Psalms 47:1-2,6-9 - O clap your hands, all ye people; shout unto God with the voice of triumph. For the Lord most high is terrible; he is a great King over all the earth. Sing praises to God, sing praises: sing praises unto our King, sing praises. For God is the King of all the earth: sing ye praises with understanding. God reigneth over the heathen: God sitteth upon the throne of his holiness. The princes of the people are gathered together, even the people of the God of Abraham: for the shields of the earth belong unto God: he is greatly exalted.

Psalms 95:1-7 - O come, let us sing unto the Lord : let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation. Let us come before his

presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto him with psalms. For the Lord is a great God, and a great King above all gods. In his hand are the deep places of the earth: the strength of the hills is his also. The sea is his, and he made it: and his hands formed the dry land. O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the Lord our maker. For he is our God; and we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand. Today if ye will hear his voice,

God is the living God and everlasting King.

Jeremiah 10:10,12 - But the Lord is the true God, he is the living God, and an everlasting king: at his wrath the earth shall tremble, and the nations shall not be able to abide his indignation. He hath made the earth by his power, he hath established the world by his wisdom, and hath stretched out the heavens by his discretion.

In your hour of need, God as your King will deliver.

Daniel 6:20-22 - And when he came to the den, he cried with a lamentable voice unto Daniel: and the king spake and said to Daniel, O Daniel, servant of the living God, is thy God, whom thou servest continually, able to deliver thee from the lions? Then said Daniel unto the king, O king, live for ever. My God hath sent his angel, and hath shut the lions' mouths, that they have not hurt me: forasmuch as before him innocency was found in me; and also before thee, O king, have I done no hurt.

The kingdom of God, is ruled by God the King. His kingdom is righteousness, love, peace and charity.

Romans 14:16-17 - Let not then your good be evil spoken of: For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.

Matthew 7:21 - Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

Seek the kingdom of God and all these things shall be added unto you.

Luke 12:30-32 - For all these things do the nations of the world seek after: and your Father knoweth that ye have need of these things. But rather seek ye the kingdom of God; and all these things shall be added unto you. Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

God is King, working salvation in the midst of the earth.

Psalm 74:10,12 - O God, how long shall the adversary reproach? shall the enemy blaspheme thy name for ever? For God is my King of old, working salvation in the midst of the earth.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 3: Paul the Author

There are eight New Testament witnesses that walked with, were brothers of or were converted to followers of Jesus. Matthew, John and Peter walked with Jesus and became his Apostles. Mark and Luke, who both wrote Gospels and the Acts, appears to have walked with Jesus as his disciples. Jude and James, each wrote epistles and were brothers of Jesus. Paul was converted from a prosecutor of Christians to a lover of Jesus and preached fervently winning souls for the kingdom of God. In summary, Matthew, Mark, Luke, James and Jude each wrote one book of the New Testament. John wrote five books. Peter wrote two books and Paul wrote fourteen books.

Paul was on fire for the Lord. This is exactly what John the Baptist meant when he said that “he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire.” (See Matthew 3:11, Luke 3:16)

Matthew 3:11 - I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:

Paul did not walk with Jesus. He was a Pharisee that was versed in all matters of the law. He was also responsible for the stoning to death of the Apostle Stephen. Once God pricked his heart, it was all over. Saul's or Paul's conversion is reported in three different testimonies in Acts. (Acts 9:3-8, Acts 22:6-11 and Acts 26:12-20.) Acts 9:3-8 is second hand reporting as Paul is referred to as he. Acts 22:6-11 is first hand reporting as Paul refers to himself as I and me. The words that the Lord spoke in these two accounts were simply this.

“Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest: it is hard for thee to kick against

the pricks. And the Lord said unto him, Arise, and go into the city, and it shall be told thee what thou must do. “

In the third witness, Paul was speaking to King Agrippa of his encounter on the way to Damascus. It was clear that Paul wanted to impress King Agrippa with his walk as he reported the Lord speaking the following:

“Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks. And he said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest. But rise, and stand upon thy feet: for I have appeared unto thee for this purpose, to make thee a minister and a witness both of these things which thou hast seen, and of those things in the which I will appear unto thee; Delivering thee from the people, and from the Gentiles, unto whom now I send thee, To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.”

From these three testimonies, it is clear that the testimony of one witness does not establish the will of God. Since Paul did not walk with Jesus, he wanted to make it clear that out of the mouth of two or three witnesses, you shall know the truth. Five times, Paul spoke of this fact in his epistles. Paul knew that one would need to compare his doctrine against that of the Apostles for the truth. (See 1 Corinthians 14:29; 2 Corinthians 13:1; Hebrews 6:18; Hebrews 10:28; and 1 Timothy 5:19)

1 Timothy 5:19 - Against an elder receive not an accusation, but before two or three witnesses.

You know from the testimonies of the eight New Testament witnesses that God is the Father and Jesus is the Son of God. This is repeated verse after verse at least thirty-one times by six witnesses.

1 Timothy 1:2 - Unto Timothy, my own son in the faith: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord.

2 Peter 1:17 - For he received from God the Father honour and glory, when there came such a voice to him from the excellent glory, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

It is clear that God is the spirit that no one has ever seen. Jesus was a man offered as a blood sacrifice for the sins of man. God and Jesus are two separate beings.

In the most desperate of times during the death of Jesus on the cross, he referred to the Father multiple times. If Jesus was God, then he would not have stated that he had forsaken himself. Nor would he ask the Father to forgive them. He even asked the Father to forgive those responsible for his crucifixion and he commended his spirit unto the Father. These testimonies make it clear that God and Jesus are two separate beings. God is the Spirit. Jesus was a man in the flesh.

Matthew 27:46 - And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?

Mark 15:34 - And at the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani? which is, being interpreted, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?

Luke 23:34,46 - Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots. And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost.

When you look at this one chapter and look at the preponderance of evidence of one witness, Paul's testimony to the Colossians,

you see that he was created as an apostle of Jesus by the will of God. In these first 6 verses, it is once again clear that God is the Father and Jesus is the Son. Two different beings.

Colossians 1:1-3,6 - Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, and Timotheus our brother, To the saints and faithful brethren in Christ which are at Colosse: Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you, Which is come unto you, as it is in all the world; and bringeth forth fruit, as it doth also in you, since the day ye heard of it, and knew the grace of God in truth:

With all of the preponderance of evidence testimony from the six witnesses, Paul includes a word salad of him's and he's which confuses God's word. Verses 14 through 20 is a word salad between his and him, with unknown reference to either the Son or the invisible God.

Within this word salad, the witness testifies the following:

"For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:"

In this verse, it is not exactly clear who him is. Is it the invisible God? Some scholars say "by him" is Jesus, declaring that Jesus is God.

Colossians 1:14-20 - In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins: Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature: For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and

for him: And he is before all things, and by him all things consist. And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence. For it pleased the Father that in him should all fulness dwell; And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven.

Paul the author does not give a testimony like this in any other of his fourteen books of the bible that he wrote. So why did he include this testimony in only this one book!

Did Paul try and overplay this verse to the Colossians like he had done with King Agrippa?

It could be because this is the only time he wrote to the Colossians. He went to the Corinthians three times and specifically told them that every word should be established at the mouth of two or three witnesses.

2 Corinthians 13:1 - This is the third time I am coming to you. In the mouth of two or three witnesses shall every word be established.

It could be because maybe he didn't write the book. Who were the Colossians and why did Paul contradict himself in this one book compared to the other thirteen books he had wrote?

The Epistle to the Colossians is the twelfth book of the New Testament. It was written, according to the text, by Paul the Apostle and Timothy, and addressed to the church in Colossae, a small Phrygian city near Laodicea and approximately 100 miles (160 km) from Ephesus in Asia Minor. Scholars have increasingly questioned Paul's authorship and attributed the letter to an early follower instead, but others still defend it as

authentic. If Paul was the author, he probably used an amanuensis, or secretary, in writing the letter (Colossians 4:18), possibly Timothy. The original text was written in Koine Greek.

Regardless of the source for verses (Colossians 1:14-20), the author Paul even told you to understand the truth in the word of God from the mouth of two or three witnesses. Do not get confused by one verse or one witness testimony that contradicts the preponderance of evidence testimony of the eight New Testament witnesses. Awake to righteousness with the knowledge of God and truth in his word.

1 Corinthians 15:34 - Awake to righteousness, and sin not; for some have not the knowledge of God: I speak this to your shame.

One thing for sure is that you know from the preponderance of evidence testimony who God is from the all eight witnesses, including Paul!

John 4:6-12 - We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error. Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God. He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love. In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him. Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another. No man hath seen God at any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and his love is perfected in us.

God is but one God. The creator of heaven and earth. God is King.

James 2:18-19 - Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works. Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 4: God and Christ

Using the preponderance of evidence from the testimony of the New Testament witnesses, it is apparent that God the Father is the creator and Jesus Christ is a man sent by God to be a sacrifice for the sins of mankind. Jesus Christ or Christ is not God the Father. Christ is the Son of God. Let's review the testimony.

God is the Father and Christ is the Son of God.

2 Corinthians 1:1-3,18 - Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, and Timothy our brother, unto the church of God which is at Corinth, with all the saints which are in all Achaia: Grace be to you and peace from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ. Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort;

Matthew 16:16 - And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God

Matthew 26:63 - But Jesus held his peace. And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God.

Mark 1:1 - The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God;

Luke 4:41 - And devils also came out of many, crying out, and saying, Thou art Christ the Son of God. And he rebuking them suffered them not to speak: for they knew that he was Christ.

John 6:69 - And we believe and are sure that thou art that Christ, the Son of the living God.

Acts 2:30,36 - Therefore being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him, that of the fruit of his loins,

according to the flesh, he would raise up Christ to sit on his throne; Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ.

Acts 4:10 - Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole.

Galatians 1:3 - Grace be to you and peace from God the Father, and from our Lord Jesus Christ,

1 Peter 1:3 - Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

1 John 5:17-20 - All unrighteousness is sin: and there is a sin not unto death. We know that whosoever is born of God sinneth not; but he that is begotten of God keepeth himself, and that wicked one toucheth him not. And we know that we are of God, and the whole world lieth in wickedness. And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life.

God the Father is the true God. Jesus Christ was sent by God.

John 8:42 - Jesus said unto them, If God were your Father, ye would love me: for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of myself, but he sent me.

John 11:27 - She saith unto him, Yea, Lord: I believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world.

John 17:3 - And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent.

Jesus Christ was the brother of James, Jude and others.

1 Peter 5:10 - But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle you.

Jude 1:1,4,21 - Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, and called: For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ. Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

James 1:1 - James, a servant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, to the twelve tribes which are scattered abroad, greeting.

208 times Jesus and God are referred to as two separate beings by all eight witnesses. There is only one God.

Matthew 3:16 - And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:

Mark 10:18 - And Jesus said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God.

You are to worship and serve only God the Creator.

Romans 1:25 - Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen.

Jesus came as a prophet unto the world. Jesus declared himself to be a prophet.

Mark 6:4 - But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, but in his own country, and among his own kin, and in his own house.

Luke 4:24 - And he said, Verily I say unto you, No prophet is accepted in his own country.

John 6:14 - Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said, This is of a truth that prophet that should come into the world.

Luke 7:16 - And there came a fear on all: and they glorified God, saying, That a great prophet is risen up among us; and, That God hath visited his people.

Luke 24:19 - And he said unto them, What things? And they said unto him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, which was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people:

Luke 13:33 – Nevertheless, I must walk today, and tomorrow, and the day following: for it cannot be that a prophet perish out of Jerusalem.

Matthew 21:11 - And the multitude said, This is Jesus the prophet of Nazareth of Galilee.

The truth in God's word is determined out of the mouth of two or three witnesses. God the Father is the one true God. He sent Jesus to spread God's doctrine of love by doing the will of God. Regardless as to who you believe Jesus is, God's will is the same. It doesn't matter if you believe that Jesus is a prophet or the Son of God. God wants you to repent and turn from sin, to love God and to love your neighbor. Do this and you shall live!

*Share God's gospel of love and live every day to the love of
God. Keep yourself in the love of God, unto eternal life.*

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 5: Sectarianism

The term "sectarianism" is defined in the Oxford English Dictionary as "excessive attachment to a particular sect or party, especially in religion". The phrase "sectarian conflict" usually refers to violent conflict along religious or political lines, such as the conflicts between Nationalists and Unionists in Northern Ireland (religious and class-divisions may play major roles as well). It may also refer to general philosophical, political disparity between different schools of thought, such as that between Shia and Sunni Muslims. Non-sectarians see free association and tolerance of different beliefs as the cornerstones to successful, peaceful human interaction. They adopt political and religious pluralism.

God is non-sectarian. There is one true God that is not bound by religious laws. There is one true God that offers everlasting life with him when you leave this earth. There is one true God that is looking for peace on this earth. There is one true God who looks at all men and women created equal. There is one true God that is looking for all men and women to live the gospel of Love. A God that is looking for you to repent and turn from sin, judge no one, love God, love your neighbor, endure to the end and enjoy everlasting life. This gospel of Love message was brought to this earth by the prophets.

Religious sectarianism is dead. Too many people have been hated and killed because of perceived religious differences at the hands of infidels driven by one witness/prophet testimony.

God made it clear that you will know the truth out of the mouth of two or three witnesses.

1 Corinthians 14:29 - Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge.

Infidels are not rewarded by God.

- *Sharia law is dead.*
- *Christian laws are dead.*
- *Religious laws are dead.*

Anyone who treats others as anything less than a child of God will be judged by God. When you are judged by God, the gift of everlasting life, awaiting you when you leave this earth, is at risk. The message sent through Muhammed was clear.

“Serve God, and join not any partners with Him; and do good – to parents, kinsfolk, orphans, those in need, neighbors who are near, neighbors who are strangers, the companion by your side, the wayfarer (ye meet), and what your right hands possess.” [The Holy Qur’an, al-Nisaa 4:36]

When you love God and love your Neighbor, then thou shalt not kill, period! A fool ignores God’s word and is in danger of hell fire.

Exodus 20:13 - Thou shalt not kill.

Deuteronomy 5:17 - Thou shalt not kill.

Numbers 35:30 - Whoso killeth any person, the murderer shall be put to death by the mouth of witnesses: but one witness shall not testify against any person to cause him to die.

Jeremiah 7:9 - Will ye steal, murder, and commit adultery, and swear falsely, and burn incense unto Baal, and walk after other gods whom ye know not;

Matthew 5:21-22 - Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not kill; and whosoever shall kill shall be in danger of the judgment: But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the

judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire. The preponderance of evidence from the multiple witnesses is clear. Thou shalt not kill, period.

Matthew 15:19-20 - For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies: These are the things which defile a man: but to eat with unwashen hands defileth not a man.

Matthew 19:18-19,21 - He saith unto him, Which? Jesus said, Thou shalt do no murder, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Honour thy father and thy mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. Jesus said unto him, If thou wilt be perfect, go and sell that thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come and follow me.

Mark 7:20-23 - And he said, That which cometh out of the man, that defileth the man. For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: All these evil things come from within, and defile the man

Mark 10:19 - Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honor thy father and mother.

John 8:44,47 - Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it. He that is of God heareth God's words: ye therefore hear them not, because ye are not of God.

John 10:10 - The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

John 16:2 - They shall put you out of the synagogues: yea, the time cometh, that whosoever killeth you will think that he doeth God service.

Romans 1:28-32 - And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient; Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, Backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, Without understanding, covenantbreakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful: Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them.

Romans 13:9 - For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself.

Galatians 5:19-21 - Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

1 Timothy 1:9-11 - Knowing this, that the law is not made for a righteous man, but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and for sinners, for unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers, For whoremongers, for them that defile themselves with mankind, for menstealers, for liars, for perjured persons, and if there be any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine; According to the glorious gospel of the blessed God, which was committed to my trust.

James 2:11 - For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill. Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill, thou art become a transgressor of the law

1 Peter 4:15-19 - But let none of you suffer as a murderer, or as a thief, or as an evildoer, or as a busybody in other men's matters. Yet if any man suffer as a Christian, let him not be ashamed; but let him glorify God on this behalf. For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God? And if the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear? Wherefore let them that suffer according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls to him in well doing, as unto a faithful Creator.

Revelation 21:8 - But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.

For you Christians that have been taught that Jesus died on the cross for the forgiveness of you sins and you can continue to live your life to the will of men, beware. Paul made it clear that

when to accept the will of God into your life, your past sins are forgiven. Do not continue to live your life for the devil, as you will blaspheme the Holy Ghost and are in danger of hell fire.

Romans 3:25 - Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;

Mark 3:29 - But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation:

The preponderance of evidence is clear. When you desire God's mercy, love and the gift of everlasting life, then you follow God's commandments by loving God and loving your neighbor. You are to be a good steward and you serve the things of God. Serving not to the laws of men, but in peace to all men serving the will of God.

1 John 3:15,17-18 - Whosoever hateth his brother is a murderer: and ye know that no murderer hath eternal life abiding in him. But whoso hath this world's good, and seeth his brother have need, and shutteth up his bowels of compassion from him, how dwelleth the love of God in him? My little children, let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but indeed and in truth.

James 3:17-18 KJV - But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace.

We are all children of God, brought to this earth to love and do the will of God.

1 John 3:10-11 - In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not

of God, neither he that loveth not his brother. For this is the message that ye heard from the beginning, that we should love one another.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 6: Rightly Dividing the Truth

God tells you twelve times in the Bible that out of the mouth of two or three witnesses you shall know the truth! Twelve is number of divine authority. You first get the truth by comparing the testimonies of the eight witnesses and then ignore the vain babbling of one witness testimony that stands alone. That authority is coming directly from God! God's word is truth from the mouth of two or three witnesses. (See Deuteronomy 17:6; Deuteronomy 19:15; 1 Kings 21:10; 1 Kings 21:13; Matthew 18:16; John 8:17-18; 1 Corinthians 14:29; 2 Corinthians 13:1; Hebrews 6:18; Hebrews 10:28; 1 Timothy 5:19; Revelations 11:3)

2 Timothy 2:15-16 KJV - Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. But shun profane and vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness.

1 Timothy 5:19 - Against an elder receive not an accusation, but before two or three witnesses.

What does the truth out of the mouth of two or three witnesses versus one witness mean? Here are some examples.

No witness spoke on God requiring a tithe of some amount for the New Testament church.

No witness spoke on God sending you to hell if you drank alcohol. Multiple witnesses spoke out against drunkenness and your desire to live one's life by being sober. (See Luke 21:34; Romans 13:13; 1 Peter 1:13; 1 Peter 4:7; 1 Peter 5:8; 1 Thessalonians 5:6-8; Titus 2:2,3,6; Titus 1:8-9; Titus 2:2)

1 Peter 4:7 - But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer.

Titus 2:2 - That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in faith, in charity, in patience.

Only one witness Paul said women should not speak in church in Corinthians and Timothy Ignore that vain babbling as God wants woman to preach in church. (See 1 Corinthians 14:34; 1 Timothy 2:12)

1 Timothy 2:12 - But I suffer not a woman to teach, nor to usurp authority over the man, but to be in silence.

Only one witness Paul in 1 Thessalonians spoke on what people refer to as the rapture....The idea of a rapture as it is defined in dispensational premillennialism is not found in historic Christianity and is a relatively recent doctrine originating from the 1830s. The term is used frequently among fundamentalist theologians in the United States. The origin of the term extends from the First Epistle to the Thessalonians in the Bible, which uses the Greek word harpazo (Ancient Greek: ἁρπάζω), meaning "to snatch away" or "to seize"...The rapture is an idea developed from one witness, one testimony which is considered vain babbling and is not considered the truth in God's word. The rapture isn't truth and is not going to happen.

1 Thessalonians 4:17 - Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

Only one witness, John, spoke on the Word becoming flesh, the Word being before Abraham and the God and the Word and the Holy Ghost as one. Rightly dividing the word is telling you out of the mouth of one witness that Jesus was not around since the beginning when God made heaven and earth, Jesus is not God, Jesus is not equal to God as they are not one as in the Trinity. One witness, one testimony which is considered vain babbling and is not considered the truth in God's word.

John 1:1 - In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

John 1:14 - And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, full of grace and truth.

John 8:58 - Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.

1 John 5:7 - For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.

Only one witness, Paul, spoke of divorce. God does not like divorce.
(See Matthew 19:4-6,8,9; Mark 10:5-12; Luke 16:18; Romans 7:2,3; 1 Corinthians 7:10-15)

Luke 16:18 - Whosoever putteth away his wife, and marrieth another, committeth adultery: and whosoever marrieth her that is put away from her husband committeth adultery.

1 Corinthians 7:10-15 - And unto the married I command, yet not I, but the Lord, Let not the wife depart from her husband: But and if she depart, let her remain unmarried, or be reconciled to her husband: and let not the husband put away his wife. But to the rest speak I, not the Lord: If any brother hath a wife that believeth not, and she be pleased to dwell with him, let him not put her away. And the woman which hath an husband that believeth not, and if he be pleased to dwell with her, let her not leave him. For the unbelieving husband is sanctified by the wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified by the husband: else were your children unclean; but now are they holy. But if the unbelieving depart, let him depart. A brother or a sister is not under bondage in such cases : but God hath called us to peace.

Multiple witnesses say you will be judged by God. (See Matthew 7:21; Luke 18:13; Acts 17:30-31; Hebrews 13:3; 1 Corinthians 5:13; Romans 1:32; Romans 2:2,3,5,6,10; Romans 3:4,6; Romans 3:18-19; Psalm 43:1; Thessalonians 1:5; 1 Peter 4:17; 2 Peter 2:4; Jude 1:15; Revelation 14:7; Revelation 16:7,9; Revelation 20:12)

Romans 3:4,6 - God forbid: yea, let God be true, but every man a liar; as it is written, That thou mightest be justified in thy sayings, and mightest overcome when thou art judged. God forbid: for then how shall God judge the world?

Revelation 20:12 - And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

Rightly dividing the word of God changes the landscape for man's derived doctrine from one witness babbling testimonies. Rightly dividing the truth destroys the sectarianism of religious denomination that have been teaching from one witness testimonies! God does not judge you by works of religion. Water baptism means nothing.

God sent Jesus as a prophet to bring God's gospel of Love. You are to love God and love your Neighbor. God will judge you by your good works and deeds. You will be judged by how you live your life on earth, in your service to God and neighbor. Sin not, stay sober, judge no one, show your love of God and neighbor by good works and endure to the end. Obey God's gospel and God will be waiting for you.

1 Peter 4:17 - For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?

*From the mouth of two or three prophets, you shall know the truth.
Come visit the truth at OneWorldChurch.net*

1 Corinthians 14:29 - Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 7: Undeniable Truth

God's word doesn't mean anything, unless you want to know the truth. Man has found a way to distort God's word into doctrine that is far from the true meaning of God's word. Man has known how to get the truth, but there is no money to be made by teaching the truth. Jesus knew that Peter would deny him when confronted by those that wished Jesus to be put to death. That message is contained in the four gospels. Of those four gospels, Mark reports that Jesus said before the cock crows twice, you shall deny me thrice.

Mark 14:30 - And Jesus saith unto him, Verily I say unto thee, That this day, even in this night, before the cock crow twice, thou shalt deny me thrice.

The other three witnesses reported that Jesus said before the cock crows once, you shall deny me thrice. (See Matthew 26:34; Luke 22:34; John 13:38)

John 13:38 - Jesus answered him, Wilt thou lay down thy life for my sake? Verily, verily, I say unto thee, The cock shall not crow, till thou hast denied me thrice.

You never heard Mark's testimony of Peter denying Jesus twice. In this case, the testimony of two or three witnesses (i.e. Matthew, Luke and John) was used to obtain the truth as commanded by God. Peter denied to three witnesses that he was with Jesus. After his resurrection, Jesus told Peter three times to feed his sheep. God has made it clear that out of the mouth of two or three witnesses you will know the truth. Twelve times in the bible God tells you how to understand the truth in his word. (See Deuteronomy 17:6; Deuteronomy 19:15; 1 Kings 21:10; 1 Kings 21:13; Matthew 18:16; John 8:17; 1 Corinthians 14:29; 2 Corinthians 13:1; Hebrews 6:18; Hebrews 10:28; 1 Timothy 5:19; Revelations 11:3).

Deuteronomy 17:6 - At the mouth of two witnesses, or three witnesses, shall he that is worthy of death be put to death; but at the mouth of one witness he shall not be put to death.

Deuteronomy 19:15 - One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.

1 Kings 21:10 - And set two men, sons of Belial, before him, to bear witness against him, saying, Thou didst blaspheme God and the king. And then carry him out, and stone him, that he may die.

1 Kings 21:13 - And there came in two men, children of Belial, and sat before him: and the men of Belial witnessed against him, even against Naboth, in the presence of the people, saying, Naboth did blaspheme God and the king. Then they carried him forth out of the city, and stoned him with stones, that he died.

Matthew 18:16 - But if he will not hear thee, then take with thee one or two more, that in the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established.

John 8:17 - It is also written in your law, that the testimony of two men is true.

1 Corinthians 14:29 - Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge.

2 Corinthians 13:1 - This is the third time I am coming to you. In the mouth of two or three witnesses shall every word be established.

Hebrews 6:18 - That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation,

who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:

Hebrews 10:28 - He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses:

1 Timothy 5:19 - Against an elder receive not an accusation, but before two or three witnesses.

Revelation 11:3 - And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

Paul was so confident that his messages would be abused that he specifically told Timothy how to get the truth out of God's word.

2 Timothy 3:16 - All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

Let's breakdown this verse:

Scripture - The word is used either in the singular or plural number, to denote the sacred writings or divine oracles, called sacred or holy, as proceeding from God and containing sacred doctrines and precepts.

Inspiration - The infusion of ideas into the mind by the Holy Spirit; the conveying into the minds of men, ideas, notices or monitions by extraordinary or supernatural influence; or the communication of the divine will to the understanding by suggestions or impressions on the mind, which leave no room to doubt the reality of their supernatural origin.

Profitable - Yielding or bringing profit or gain; gainful; lucrative; as a profitable trade; profitable business; a profitable study or profession.

Doctrine - The truths of the gospel in general.

Reproof - To refute; to disprove. Blame expressed to the face; censure for a fault; reprehension.

Correction - The act of correcting; the act of bringing back, from error or deviation, to a just standard, as to truth, rectitude, justice or propriety; as the correction of opinions or manners.

Instruction - The act of teaching or informing the understanding in that of which it was before ignorant; information. Precepts conveying knowledge.

Righteousness - Purity of heart and rectitude of life; conformity of heart and life to the divine law. Righteousness, as used in Scripture and theology, in which it is chiefly used, is nearly equivalent to holiness, comprehending holy principles and affections of heart, and conformity of life to the divine law. It includes all we call justice, honesty and virtue, with holy affections; in short, it is true religion.

Paul tells you that you must know how to read, compare, correct and follow God's word for the truth and instruction on righteousness. The only way to achieve this is by using the preponderance of evidence from the testimony of the witnesses. Do not lean on your own understanding in a single verse from the bible. Do not be afraid to read and compare. God will direct your paths.

Proverbs 3:5-7 - Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths. Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil.

Once you know the truth in God's word, then you don't stop there. Your walk with the Lord God gives him the glory and being fruitful in every good work. You are to keep his commandments and live.

Colossians 1:10 KJV - That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God;

Proverbs 4:4 - He taught me also, and said unto me, Let thine heart retain my words: keep my commandments, and live.

God hated the robbery of one's sinful life, by living for burnt offerings and constantly being engulfed in your sins.

Isaiah 61:8 - For I the Lord love judgment, I hate robbery for burnt offering; and I will direct their work in truth, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them.

Forget all that you've known or practiced in man's churches. God wanted nothing to do with man's churchianity and the temples giving man the glory and acts of religion. Jesus came with a message of love not just from two or three witnesses, but from all eight witnesses. The preponderance of evidence is overwhelming. In a court of law, the decision would be unanimous. Do all you can do from this point forward to please God, do his will and live his gospel of Love from the heart. Do not look back. God's gospel of Love brought to the earth by Jesus is simple. The "Undeniable truth" starts with the understanding God's word from the testimony of the eight witnesses.

- *Believe in one God*
- *Repent of your sins and surrender to God.*
- *Judge no one*

- *Love God*
- *Love your Neighbor*
- *Keep yourself in the love of God, unto eternal life*

Jude 1:21 - Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 8: You've been Deceived

The gospel doctrine that Jesus brought to this earth is not about you. You've been deceived by the teaching of man's churches and the doctrine established by one witness testimonies. This is exactly why God made it clear that out of the mouth of two or three witnesses you will know the truth. Twelve times in the bible God tells you how to understand the truth in his word. Twelve times is not random. Twelve in the Bible refers to Governmental Perfection or Divine Authority. To write twelve in Hebrew, they wrote two Hebrew letters: yod-beth. These signify the hand of the household in harmony under divine authority. There were 12 sons of Jacob in the Old Testament and 12 apostles in the New Testament. There are 12 foundations in the New Jerusalem (Revelations 21:14). It also has 12 gates and 12 angels at the gates (Revelations 21:12) and 12 pearls at the gates (Revelations 21:21). The city is foursquare at 12,000 furlongs (Revelations 21:16). The wall is 144 cubits high (Revelations 21:17), which is 12 x 12. All of this is to portray the concept of divine government and order. God's perfection and divine authority is to be witnessed by understanding the truth in his word, twelve times in the Bible, that out of the mouth of two or three witnesses you shall know the truth.

Paul's epistles and John's gospel are the witnesses most often quoted using one witness verses to create false doctrine which results in division amongst the Christian denomination. That is exactly why Paul quoted five times and John quoted two times that out of the mouth of two or three witnesses you shall know the truth. If God commands you twelve times, then you listen and obey.

1 Timothy 5:19 - Against an elder receive not an accusation, but before two or three witnesses.

Paul tells you to judge the truth from the testimony of two or three prophets.

1 Corinthians 14:29 - Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge.

Paul tells Timothy to study scripture; you then compare verses for reproof and correction. Exactly how you get the truth.

2 Timothy 3:16 - All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

Paul was trained as a leader of the Jewish religion and all matters of man's churchianity as a Pharisee. Paul was not an apostle of Jesus. He did not spend any time with Jesus to learn God's gospel. Following his conversion to Christianity on the way to Damascus, Paul only spent 15 days with Peter and James, Jesus's brother, learning of Jesus's walk on this earth. Paul was responsible for the persecution of Christians and the stoning of the apostle Stephen, so he heard the stories of Jesus's walk on this earth. Paul had many one witness testimonies that do not align with the teachings of the Matthew, Mark, Luke, John, Peter, James and Jude. That is exactly why Paul told Timothy to study scripture!

Galatians 1:18-19 - Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to see Peter, and abode with him fifteen days. But other of the apostles saw I none, save James the Lord's brother.

Paul was the only witness that said women should be silent in church. God does not women silent in church. If you are a woman and have a desire to serve God as a leader in his kingdom, then do it! Make God proud.

1 Corinthians 14:34 - Let your women keep silence in the churches: for it is not permitted unto them to speak; but they are commanded to be under obedience, as also saith the law.

Paul was also the only witness that declared Jesus as the head of the church. (See Ephesians 1:18,22; Ephesians 2:20; Ephesians 5:23; Colossians 1:18). You all know that God is the judge and head of his people, in the kingdom of God.

Ephesians 5:23 - For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the savior of the body.

And you guessed it. Paul is the only one that said the husband is the head of the wife. Without understanding the truth in God's word, you'll want to judge your self-righteousness against how others are living their life in sin. God does not want you to judge anyone. All God wants is for you to live his gospel of Love. So, as you look at your service to God, your job function is clear. Be a witness for God and manage your daily activities serving God and man in mind and spirit! Your life of love is your witness.

Christian churches love to pick and choose verses from the Old and New Testament and come up with doctrine for you to live by and in so doing you have favor with God and eternal life is yours. A Hindu man asked me this question when I gave him a nondenominational jail ministry lesson on love. He said, "You Christians worship one God and follow the teachings of Jesus. Why is it that I can only go to heaven if I go to your church?"

Some denominations believe that Jesus is God. Others believe that Jesus is a prophet. Using the preponderance of evidence from the testimony of two or three witnesses, you know that Jesus was a prophet sent by God. Jesus called himself a prophet. Jesus as the son of God was not God the Father. (See Matthew

21:11-13; Luke 4:24; Luke 7:16; Luke 13:33; Luke 24:19; Mark 6:4; John 4:19,44; John 6:14)

Matthew 21:11-13 - And the multitude said, This is Jesus the prophet of Nazareth of Galilee.

Mark 6:4 - But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honor, but in his own country, and among his own kin, and in his own house.

Jesus made it clear in his parables that a rich man will have trouble entering the kingdom of God. God made it clear in these three verses that it is impossible for man to save anyone and it is only possible with God. God is the judge! (See Luke 18:25-27; Mark 10:25-27; Matthew 19:24-26)

Luke 18:25-27 - For it is easier for a camel to go through a needle's eye, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God. And they that heard it said, Who then can be saved? And he said, The things which are impossible with men are possible with God.

Jesus was clear in his testimony. Jesus couldn't save that young man. The young man followed the religious laws, but didn't have love for the things of God in his heart. Jesus didn't offer water baptism to save the young man. Jesus didn't say, "believe in me and you will be saved." Jesus didn't say to get baptized in water to be saved. Jesus made it clear that salvation is a gift from God. If you want a relationship with God, then "follow me." To do as Jesus did. (See Matthew 19:16-21,26; Mark 10:17-21; Luke 18:18-22)

Matthew 19:16-21,26 - And, behold, one came and said unto him, Good Master, what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life? And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God: but if thou wilt enter

into life, keep the commandments. He saith unto him, Which? Jesus said, Thou shalt do no murder, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Honour thy father and thy mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. The young man saith unto him, All these things have I kept from my youth up: what lack I yet? Jesus said unto him, If thou wilt be perfect, go and sell that thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come and follow me. But Jesus beheld them, and said unto them, With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible.

All eight witnesses have testified the commandments of the New Testament. Using the preponderance of evidence from their testimonies, the commandments are simply these for the New Testament believer: Do not commit adultery; Do not kill; Do not steal; Do not bear false witness; Honor thy father and thy mother; Love God; Love neighbor. If you break one of these, you break them all. You are told to walk in the light doing the will of God with a pure heart and not serving the lusts of the flesh.

Not once in the New Testament did Jesus tell you to keep the Sabbath holy. God destroyed the man-made churches when the temple veil was rent in two during the death of Jesus on the cross. God wants you to serve him seven days a week in his kingdom of God. Jesus overthrew the tables and chastised them that turned the church into a den of thieves. (See Mark 11:17; Matthew 21:11-13)

Matthew 21:11-13 - And the multitude said, This is Jesus the prophet of Nazareth of Galilee. And Jesus went into the temple of God, and cast out all them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves, And said unto them, It

is written, My house shall be called the house of prayer; but ye have made it a den of thieves.

Not once does Jesus tell you to give a tithe of 10% of your earnings to the church. God knew that man would use the church as a money grab and fail to teach or live the truth out of his word. God doesn't need your money. God wants your heart.

Revelation 17:17 - For God hath put in their hearts to fulfil his will, and to agree, and give their kingdom unto the beast, until the words of God shall be fulfilled.

Performing works of religion does not make you righteous in the eyes of God. Circumcision was a religious work of the Jewish religion. Paul made it clear in Corinthians that circumcision means nothing. He is telling you that religious works means nothing. James warns you that man's religion is vain.

1 Corinthians 7:19 - Circumcision is nothing, and uncircumcision is nothing, but the keeping of the commandments of God.

James 1:26 - If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's religion is vain.

Jesus didn't say to be circumcised to be saved. Only one witness gave that testimony.

Acts 15:1 - And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved.

Baptism by water means nothing and just gets one wet. Only one witness, Peter, gave inference to water baptism saves.

1 Peter 3:20-21 -Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark

was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water. The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:

John the Baptist said that one would come after him that baptize you with the Holy Ghost and fire! Four witnesses have testified that your baptism by the Holy Ghost will be your fire! (See Matthew 3:11; Mark 1:8; Luke 3:16; John 1:33; Acts 1:5; Acts 11:16-18).

God had John the Baptist thrown in jail when Jesus began his ministry. God does not want works of religion to confuse your walk with God.

Luke 3:16 - John answered, saying unto them all, I indeed baptize you with water; but one mightier than I cometh, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire:

By faith and with a converted heart, believe that when you live a life serving the things of God that God will welcome you into his kingdom. Put your past behind you and from this point forward, turn from sin and follow the teachings of the witnesses.

Romans 10:8-10 - But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach; That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

God will deliver you out of sin and darkness. God will judge you in the end. Man can never take away your sins. Only God knows your heart.

Hebrews 10:11 - And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins:

1 Corinthians 14:25 - And thus are the secrets of his heart made manifest; and so falling down on his face he will worship God, and report that God is in you of a truth.

Revelation 17:17 - For God hath put in their hearts to fulfil his will, and to agree, and give their kingdom unto the beast, until the words of God shall be fulfilled.

Murder is a direct assault on God's gospel of Love. It is clear that when you love God and love your neighbor, you exercise a standard of living in the spirit, so as not to become a transgressor of the law. That is to say, when you accept the forgiveness of sins offered by the grace of God, you seek to please God by doing his will. Out of obedience you follow the commandments presented to you in the New Testament. The witnesses are clear in their testimony that thou shalt not kill.

James 2:11 - For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill. Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill, thou art become a transgressor of the law.

Matthew 19:18-19 - He saith unto him, Which? Jesus said, Thou shalt do no murder, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Honour thy father and thy mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

1 Peter 4:15 - But let none of you suffer as a murderer, or as a thief, or as an evildoer, or as a busybody in other men's matters.

Luke 18:16-17,19-20 - But Jesus called them unto him, and said,
Suffer little children to come unto me, and forbid them not: for
of such is the kingdom of God. Verily I say unto you,
Whosoever shall not receive the kingdom of God as a little
child shall in no wise enter therein. And Jesus said unto him,
Why callest thou me good? none is good, save one, that is,
God. Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit
adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness,
Honour thy father and thy mother.

Mark 10:19 - Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit
adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness,
Defraud not, Honour thy father and mother.

*The witnesses are clear that no murderer hath eternal life abiding in
him. If you do these things, then you shall not inherit the
kingdom of God. (See Matthew 5:21-22; 1 John 3:15-17;
Revelations 21:8; Galatians 5:21; Romans 1:28-32)*

Matthew 5:21-22 - Ye have heard that it was said by them of old
time, Thou shalt not kill; and whosoever shall kill shall be in
danger of the judgment: But I say unto you, That whosoever is
angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the
judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall
be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool,
shall be in danger of hell fire.

*When you say you believe and evil emanates from your being, you
defile self. When you hate, murder or even promote murder,
you blaspheme the Holy Ghost. You are in danger of eternal
damnation. When you blaspheme the Holy Ghost, it shall not
be forgiven. (See Mark 7:21-23; Luke 21:10; Matthew 12:31;
Mark 3:28-29)*

Mark 3:28-29 - Verily I say unto you, All sins shall be forgiven unto
the sons of men, and blasphemies wherewith soever they shall

blaspheme: But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation:

God tells you not to be deceived. Do all that you can do, to keep yourself in the love of God. (See Matthew 24:11; Mark 13:5-6; Luke 21:8; John 7:12; Romans 7:11; Romans 16:18; 1 Corinthians 3:18; 1 Corinthians 6:9; Galatians 6:3,7; Ephesians 5:6; James 1:22,26; 1 John 3:7; Revelation 20:10)

Galatians 6:7-8 - Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.

1 John 3:7,9 - Little children, let no man deceive you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous. Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.

Take caution and beware of those simpletons that demand tithes and promise you salvation and being saved with the use of one-off bible verses. Do not be deceived.

Romans 16:18 - For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches deceive the hearts of the simple.

Do all you can do from this point forward to please God, do his will and live his gospel of Love. God's gospel of Love brought to the earth by Jesus is simple. The truth starts with the understanding the truth in God's word from the testimony of the eight witnesses.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 9: Contradictions

If you have ever made a major purchase (i.e. car, house or boat, etc.), then you'll often go back two or three times before you'll make an offer for that purchase. You'll want to make sure that you fully understand the product and that it is worth the price. You've been trained. The first thing you ask yourself, if the deal sounds too good to be true? You then ask yourself if you trust that salesman. I often ask myself, if I would buy a used car from that guy. Do I trust that guy? First impressions mean a lot.

God has helped you out in his word. The only reason to seek a relationship with God, is to understand his blessings and what God has waiting for you after death on this earth. You'll understand why God has told you twelve times that out of the mouth of two or three witnesses you shall know the truth. You'll have discernment with the testimony on the witnesses. You must understand these witnesses. John was a young man when he walked with Jesus. Paul was a Pharisee trained in all manners of churchianity. Paul realizes that he may not be 100% correct in all manners of the doctrine that Jesus brought to this earth, when he says five times that out of the mouth of two or three witnesses every word shall be established. DO NOT BELIEVE ONE WITNESS TESTIMONY, PERIOD.

2 Corinthians 13:1 – This is the third time I am coming to you. In the mouth of two or three witnesses shall every word be established.

The pluck and choose of verses from the testimony of the eight witnesses creates many contradictions. This has created confusion and false doctrine that is followed religiously by many Christian denominations. I talked to a man this week that said he is going to heaven because Jesus died on the cross.

*He told me that he didn't have to do any good deeds or works,
because Jesus did it all.*

*Many Christian churches will take these verses to claim eternal
salvation or saved without works. Just believe in Jesus as God.
Your past present and future sins are forgiven.*

John 1:1 - In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with
God, and the Word was God.

John 1:14 - And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us,
(and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of
the Father,) full of grace and truth.

Revelation 19:13 - And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in
blood: and his name is called The Word of God

John 8:58 - Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you,
Before Abraham was, I am.

John 10:28 - And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never
perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.

John 14:6 - Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the
life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

1 John 5:7-8 - For there are three that bear record in heaven, the
Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are
one. And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit,
and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one.

Matthew 28:19 - Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing
them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the
Holy Ghost:

Acts 16:31 - And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and
thou shalt be saved, and thy house.

Hebrews 9:12 - Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.

Romans 5:12,21 - Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned: That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord.

Ephesians 2:8-9 - For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.

2 Timothy 1:9-10 - Who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began, But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath abolished death, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel:

1 John 5: 11 - And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son.

The Jews declared Jesus to be equal with God!

John 5:18 - Therefore the Jews sought the more to kill him, because he not only had broken the sabbath, but said also that God was his Father, making himself equal with God.

These verses by four witnesses sound pretty convincing. You can say you believe, maybe even get baptized in water and then just sit back and wait for heavens doors to open. This is the gospel presented taught by Howard Pittman, who when he died did not walk through heavens doors. MK McDaniels died and did not see nor talk to Jesus at the right hand of the Father.

Everything she thought she understood from the bible and religion did not happen at heavens doors.

The books of the bible and the verses were numbered in the 1600's. I'm convinced this was at the hand of the devil. One can now take verses out of context and state a meaning that is not support by the testimony of the witnesses. For instance, John's testimony said the sheep followed Jesus. Thus, they are following his teachings and living God's gospel. With the Holy Ghost directing your steps, you are no longer going to walk with the devil! You will not let anyone take you back to your sinful life.

John 10:27-28 - My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.

You decide to live God's gospel of Love and walk in righteousness. You can turn from God at any point and return to your walk with the devil.

John 6:66 - From that time many of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him.

Over two hundred verses from the eight witnesses, declared God the Father as God or the Lord thy God. Only the Lord thy God should you worship.

Luke 4:8 - And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.

1 John 5:21 - Little children, keep yourselves from idols. Amen

Paul made it clear that your past sins are forgiven when you walk as directed by God, as Jesus walked. You are to repent and turn

from sin, as presented from the testimony of the witnesses. Be careful not to blaspheme the Holy Ghost for you'll be in danger of eternal damnation. When you say you believe in Jesus and his teachings and continue your life in sin, you blaspheme the Holy Ghost.

Romans 3:25 - Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;

Hebrews 6:4-6 - For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost, And have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come, If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put him to an open shame.

Hebrews 10:26 - For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins

Luke 12:10 - And whosoever shall speak a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but unto him that blasphemeth against the Holy Ghost it shall not be forgiven.

Mark 3:29 - But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation:

Do not take the one witness testimony of John and declare Jesus as God. No other witness referred to Jesus as the Word. No other witness declared that the Father, Son and Holy Ghost were three in one God. There are many witnesses, where Jesus declared himself a prophet. Paul even referred to Jesus as an Apostle and a High Priest. Jesus declared himself a prophet.

Matthew 13:57 - And they were offended in him. But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, save in his own country, and in his own house.

Matthew 21:11 - And the multitude said, This is Jesus the prophet of Nazareth of Galilee.

Mark 6:4 - But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, but in his own country, and among his own kin, and in his own house.

Luke 4:24 - And he said, Verily I say unto you, No prophet is accepted in his own country.

Luke 13:32-33 - And he said unto them, Go ye, and tell that fox, Behold, I cast out devils, and I do cures today and tomorrow, and the third day I shall be perfected. Nevertheless I must walk to day, and tomorrow, and the day following: for it cannot be that a prophet perish out of Jerusalem.

Luke 24:19 - And he said unto them, What things? And they said unto him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, which was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people:

John 4:19,21,23-24,44 - The woman saith unto him, Sir, I perceive that thou art a prophet. Jesus saith unto her, Woman, believe me, the hour cometh, when ye shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father. But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth. For Jesus himself testified, that a prophet hath no honour in his own country.

John 6:14 - Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said, This is of a truth that prophet that should come into the world.

John 9:17 - They say unto the blind man again, What sayest thou of him, that he hath opened thine eyes? He said, He is a prophet.

Acts 3:18,20-23 - But those things, which God before had shewed by the mouth of all his prophets, that Christ should suffer, he hath so fulfilled. And he shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you: Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began. For Moses truly said unto the fathers, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you. And it shall come to pass, that every soul, which will not hear that prophet, shall be destroyed from among the people.

Hebrews 3:1 - Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus.

Hebrews 5:5,9-10 - So also Christ glorified not himself to be made an high priest; but he that said unto him, Thou art my Son, to day have I begotten thee. And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him; Called of God an high priest after the order of Melchisedec.

Hebrews 6:20 - Whither the forerunner is for us entered, even Jesus, made an high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.

All eight witnesses testified on God's gospel of Love brought to this earth by Jesus. The truth in God's word brought to the earth out of the mouth of all eight witnesses and the prophets is God's gospel of Love. Nothing else matters when you believe in God and his gospel. There is irrefutable evidence that God's only desire is for you to live his gospel of Love. Not part time on Sunday, but seven days a week. For the living, God has the

promise waiting for you! A promise not for the dead consumed in self-love and sin, but for those that live Gods gospel of Love. For those that love God and love others, living a life unto righteousness doing good works. You know the doctrine. When you disobey, you blaspheme the work of the Holy Ghost or God working in you, for that God offers no forgiveness. This gospel begins believing in God and repenting of your sins. Follow the commandments of loving God and loving your neighbor. Endure to the end with the hope of everlasting life. My two witnesses that died and went to heaven, talked to God in the spirit and had lived his gospel of Love.

Start you walk with God today, by repenting and turning from your sins. God will judge the world.

Matthew 4:17 - From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Mark 1:15 - And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.

Luke 13:3 - I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.

Acts 3:19 -Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord;

Acts 8:22 - Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee.

Acts 17:30-31 - And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent: Because he hath appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom he hath ordained; whereof

he hath given assurance unto all men, in that he hath raised him from the dead.

2 Peter 3:9 - The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

1 John 3:7-9,15,18-20 - Little children, let no man deceive you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous. He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil. Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God. Whosoever hateth his brother is a murderer: and ye know that no murderer hath eternal life abiding in him. My little children, let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in truth. And hereby we know that we are of the truth, and shall assure our hearts before him. For if our heart condemn us, God is greater than our heart, and knoweth all things.

Now, go forth and live God's gospel of Love. Love God. Love your neighbor. Do good, make peace and make God proud. Spread his gospel of Love.

Luke 6:35-36 - But love ye your enemies, and do good, and lend, hoping for nothing again; and your reward shall be great, and ye shall be the children of the Highest: for he is kind unto the unthankful and to the evil. Be ye therefore merciful, as your Father also is merciful.

3 John 1:11 - Beloved, follow not that which is evil, but that which is good. He that doeth good is of God: but he that doeth evil hath not seen God.

James 3:17-18 - But the wisdom that is from above is first pure,
then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy
and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. And
the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make
peace.

Hebrews 10:22-24 - Let us hold fast the profession of our faith
without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;) And let us
consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

Hebrews 13:16 - But to do good and to communicate forget not:
for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.

Galatians 6:10 - As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good
unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household
of faith.

Titus 1:16 KJV - They profess that they know God; but in works they
deny him, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every
good work reprobate.

Titus 3:8 - This is a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou
affirm constantly, that they which have believed in God might
be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and
profitable unto men.

James 4:17 - Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth
it not, to him it is sin.

James 2:8 - If ye fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, Thou
shalt love thy neighbour as thyself, ye do well:

1 Timothy 6:18 - That they do good, that they be rich in good
works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate;

1 Peter 3:11 - Let him eschew evil, and do good; let him seek peace,
and ensue it.

John 5:29 - And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

And after you have done the will of God, endure to the end and ye might receive the promise.

John 8:51 - Verily, verily, I say unto you, If a man keep my saying, he shall never see death.

Hebrews 10:36 - For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.

Matthew 24:13 - But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.

Mark 13:13 - And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.

Acts 14:22 - Confirming the souls of the disciples, and exhorting them to continue in the faith, and that we must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom of God.

2 Timothy 2:10 - Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory.

1 John 2:17 - And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever

James 1:12 - Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him.

Jude 1:21 - Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 10: Gospel of Love

God's gospel of Love was launched on 7/20/25. In bible numbers:

7 – Spiritual Perfection

20 – Redemption

25 – Blessing

The gospel of Love is spiritual perfection out of the testimony of the eight witnesses. By living this gospel of Love, your redemption will be secured as a blessing received from God.

The God of Love, sent Jesus with a message of love. Love for God and love for one another. Twelve times in the bible God tells you how to understand the truth in his word. (See Deuteronomy 17:6; Deuteronomy 19:15; 1 Kings 21:10; 1 Kings 21:13; Matthew 18:16; John 8:17-18; 1 Corinthians 14:29; 2 Corinthians 13:1; Hebrews 6:18; Hebrews 10:28; 1 Timothy 5:19; Revelations 11:3).

Paul's epistles and John's gospel are the witnesses most often quoted using one witness verses to create false doctrine which results in division amongst the Christian denomination. That is exactly why Paul quoted five times and John quoted two times that out of the mouth of two or three witnesses you shall know the truth. If God tells you something twelve times, then you listen and obey.

1 Timothy 5:19 - Against an elder receive not an accusation, but before two or three witnesses.

Paul tells you to judge the truth from the testimony of two or three prophets.

1 Corinthians 14:29 - Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge.

Jesus was not the only prophet that brought a message of love.

Muhammed was sent to the Middle East by God to deliver his gospel of love. Commanded all to repent of their sins, surrender to God, love God and to love your neighbor. Your neighbor may even be strangers.

“Serve God, and join not any partners with Him; and do good – to parents, kinsfolk, orphans, those in need, neighbors who are near, neighbors who are strangers, the companion by your side, the wayfarer (ye meet), and what your right hands possess.” [The Holy Qur’an, al-Nisaa 4:36]

The prophet Noah and the descendants of Shem and Ham understood the message of love that was taught by Noah. The flood experienced by Noah is similar to the flood experienced by Manu in Hindu. Descendants of Shem and Ham are known to have migrated to India. The love of God and the love towards others is the key teaching in the Hindu religion as, “Love alone is the eternal law.” It is the gospel of love given to you by God. Love in Hinduism is not limited to romantic or personal relationships. It extends to all aspects of life and includes love for family, friends, community, and even enemies. Hinduism teaches that love should be unconditional and free from expectations or selfish motives. It emphasizes the concept of “love for love’s sake” rather than seeking personal gain.

The truth in God’s word requiring you to live the gospel of Love was sent by God with the same message of Love. Three prophets with the same message. Jesus gave a parable that love of your neighbor includes strangers!

Luke 10:31,33,35-36 - And by chance there came down a certain priest that way: and when he saw him, he passed by on the other side. But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was: and when he saw him, he had compassion on

him, and on the morrow when he departed, he took out two pence, and gave them to the host, and said unto him, Take care of him; and whatsoever thou spendest more, when I come again, I will repay thee. Which now of these three, thinkest thou, was neighbor unto him that fell among the thieves?

Do not be fooled by man's acts of religion to provide righteousness in the eyes of God. Don't be fooled into thinking that you are saved by grace and God doesn't want your service. Works in this verse are acts of religion (i.e. Animal and blood sacrifice, water baptism, works of the law, etc.) God is looking for you to do the will of God unto good works out of love for your neighbor.

Ephesians 2:9,10 - Not of works, lest any man should boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

Galatians 2:16 - Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

When you love God, you succumb to good works. You will be judged by your works. Not the works of religion, but works of love.

Revelation 3:15-17 - I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot. So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth. Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:

Hebrews 10:24 - And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

James 2:18-26 - Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works. Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble. But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead? Was not Abraham our father justified by works, when he had offered Isaac his son upon the altar? Seest thou how faith wrought with his works, and by works was faith made perfect? And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God. Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only. Likewise also was not Rahab the harlot justified by works, when she had received the messengers, and had sent them out another way? For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

Matthew 5:12,16 - Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

Matthew 16:27 - For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with his angels; and then he shall reward every man according to his works.

2 Timothy 3:17 - That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

Revelation 18:6 - Reward her even as she rewarded you, and double unto her double according to her works: in the cup which she hath filled fill to her double.

Revelation 20:12-13 - And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.

Do not deny God. When you follow Jesus, you work as he worked.

Titus 1:16 - They profess that they know God; but in works they deny him, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate.

John 9:4-5 - I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work. As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.

God is looking for your change of heart. Do all you can do from this point forward to please God and live his gospel of Love. The truth starts with the understanding God's word from the testimony of the witnesses.

- *Believe in one God*
- *Repent of your sins and surrender to God.*
- *Judge no one*
- *Love God*
- *Love your Neighbor*
- *Keep yourself in the love of God, unto eternal life.*

Jude 1:21 - Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

Believe that God has a plan for you. Have faith, worship only God and go live his gospel of Love. God rewards those that diligently seek him

Hebrews 11:6 - But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 11: God the Father

There is but one God, God the Father, creator of heaven and earth. Creator of all that you see and don't see. When you put your trust in God, he will lead you out of darkness and into the light. To open your eyes, turn from darkness and born of the spirit, walking in the light of righteousness. One God and Father of all.

Genesis 1:1-4 - In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. And God said, Let there be light: and there was light. And God saw the light, that it was good: and God divided the light from the darkness.

John 20:17 - Jesus saith unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father: but go to my brethren, and say unto them, I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; and to my God, and your God.

Acts 17:24 - God that made the world and all things therein, seeing that he is Lord of heaven and earth, dwelleth not in temples made with hands;

Acts 26:18 - To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.

Ephesians 4:6 - One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.

God is a spirit, that no one has seen at any time. Jesus brought God's gospel of Love to this earth, to be lived by all. May your love be perfect with boldness in the day of judgement. Out of

the mouth of all eight witnesses, when you love God, then you love your brother.

1 John 4:11-12,16-17,21 - Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another. No man hath seen God at any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and his love is perfected in us. And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him. Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world. And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also.

Jesus knew to worship, the one and only God the Father. Only the Lord thy God shall you serve.

Luke 4:8 - And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.

Matthew 4:10 - Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.

In the ninth hour, whilst dying on the cross, Jesus called on God the Father. The truth often comes out to a man in distress. Jesus worshipped God as the Father. He walked the earth as commanded by God. He did the will of God. If this is your ninth hour, then it is never too late to accept the power of God into your life.

Luke 23:34,46 - Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots. And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said,

Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost.

Mark 15:34 - And at the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani? which is, being interpreted, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?

Matthew 27:46 - And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?

Out of the mouth of all eight witness, the testimony declares the truth that God as the Father. When you believe on Jesus, then you believe on the gospel of Love, that Jesus delivered for God to the Gentiles and the Jews. When you believe on Jesus, you work the works of God. It all starts with faith. There is but one God.

John 6:27-29 - Labor not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath God the Father sealed. Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of God? Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.

1 Corinthians 8:3-4,6 - But if any man love God, the same is known of him. As concerning therefore the eating of those things that are offered in sacrifice unto idols, we know that an idol is nothing in the world, and that there is none other God but one. But to us there is but one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him.

You must have faith in the message that Jesus brought to this earth. You must believe that God raised Jesus from the dead.

Galatians 1:1-5 - Paul, an apostle, (not of men, neither by man, but by Jesus Christ, and God the Father, who raised him from the dead;) And all the brethren which are with me, unto the churches of Galatia: Grace be to you and peace from God the Father, and from our Lord Jesus Christ, Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father: To whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

Ephesians 6:23 - Peace be to the brethren, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

1 Peter 1:2-5 - Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied. Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, To an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you, Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

Acts 3:15 - And killed the Prince of life, whom God hath raised from the dead; whereof we are witnesses

Acts 4:10 KJV – Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole.

When you do the will of God, you believe and follow the teachings of the prophets. Your only desire is to serve and bring forth fruit unto God. May your love, hope and peace be in God.

Romans 7:4 - Wherefore, my brethren, ye also are become dead to the law by the body of Christ; that ye should be married to another, even to him who is raised from the dead, that we should bring forth fruit unto God.

Hebrews 12:28 - Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear.

James 1:27 - Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world.

Jude 1:1 - Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, and called:

Romans 1:7 - To all that be in Rome, beloved of God, called to be saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 12: You must First Believe

The devil wants you to believe that for everlasting life, all you need to do is to believe to be saved. Don't be fooled by verses that claim all you need is to believe to be saved. The devil believes and trembles.

James 2:19 - Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.

It is clear that you must believe in the one true God. You must carry God's word in your heart and with a pure walk you shall see God. Do not let the devil steal your walk with God.

Luke 8:12 - Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.

You must believe in one God in spirit and creator of all.

Genesis 1:1-3,6,9,14,20,24,27,31 - In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. And God said, Let there be light: and there was light. And God said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters. And God said, Let the waters under the heaven be gathered together unto one place, and let the dry land appear: and it was so. And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years: And God said, Let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creature that hath life, and fowl that may fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven. And God said, Let the earth bring forth the living creature after his kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after

his kind: and it was so. So, God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. And God saw everything that he had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.

The most fundamental belief that a Muslim has is that "There is only One God," the Creator, the Sustainer -- known in the Arabic language and by Muslims as Allah. Allah is not a foreign god, nor is he an idol. Arabic-speaking Christians use the same word for the Almighty. The fundamental pillar of faith in Islam is to declare that "there is no deity worthy of worship except the One True Almighty God" (in Arabic: "La ilaha ill Allah").

God's Nature - In the Quran, you read that Allah is Compassionate and Merciful. He is Kind, Loving and Wise. He is the Creator, the Sustainer, the Healer. He is the One who Guides, the One who Protects, the One Who Forgives. There are traditionally 99 names, or attributes, that Muslims use to describe Allah's nature.

Hinduism perceives the whole creation and its cosmic activity as the work of three fundamental forces symbolized by three gods, which constitutes the Hindu Trinity or 'Trimurti': Brahma — the creator, Vishnu — the sustainer, and Shiva — the destroyer.

Brahma, the Creator - Brahma is the creator of the universe and of all beings, as depicted in the Hindu cosmology. The Vedas, the oldest and the holiest of Hindu scriptures, are attributed to Brahma, and thus Brahma is regarded as the father of dharma. He is not to be confused with Brahman which is a general term for the Supreme Being or Almighty God. Although Brahma is one of the Trinity, his popularity is no match to that of Vishnu and Shiva. Brahma is to be found to exist more in scriptures than in homes and temples. In fact, it is hard to find a temple

dedicated to Brahma. One such temple is located in Pushkar in Rajasthan.

God's word was clear when he said to judge no one to inherit God's blessing!

1 Peter 3:9 - Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but contrariwise blessing; knowing that ye are thereunto called, that ye should inherit a blessing.

God will send you witnesses to help you to know the truth in his word.

Howard Pittman was a Baptist preacher that taught all you need to do is believe to be saved.

Acts 16:31 – And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.

He died and visited hell. If he was saved, then why didn't he high five the inhabitants of heaven as he walked in. He knew he was in judgement, when this verse spiraled down from above.

Hebrews 9:27 - And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

God said his works were an abomination. It is not known if Howard ever found the truth in God's word.

James 2:5 - Hearken, my beloved brethren, Hath not God chosen the poor of this world rich in faith, and heirs of the kingdom which he hath promised to them that love him?

1 Peter 3:15,17 - But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear: For it is better, if the will of God be so, that ye suffer for well doing, than for evil doing.

2 Thessalonians 2:16-17 - Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given us everlasting consolation and good hope through grace, Comfort your hearts, and stablish you in every good word and work.

America is the reflection of all households. All for me and the hell with you and no love of God nor neighbor. Zero effort is spent on doing the things of the Lord. Nothing will change until your heart changes.

I was passing out gospel tracts titled "A Child of God" at a polling location while a County Commissioner was touting his record and passing out voting literature. Although claiming to be a Christian, he didn't want to stand too close to the guy handing out bible messages for God!

Funny! More people took bible messages from a nobody telling people about God's children than from a puffed-up politician bragging on himself!

Wish all you want. God wants action. God wants your good works. God wants your love of neighbor.

James 2:8 - If ye fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself, ye do well:

God is real. He will use you if you let him. Do not be deceived.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 13: Born of the Spirit

Up to this point, you have lived your life in the flesh. Everything you have done in this life has been to serve yourself. If you are an addict, then your actions have been 100% self-serving. Your constitution is like that of the rich man. He had many possessions and it was too inconvenient to follow the teachings of Jesus. The rich man was following the ten commandments and he asked Jesus what does it take to have everlasting life. Jesus told him to sell everything and give it to the poor. For this rich man, this change of heart is not what he wanted. He walked away from Jesus.

Matthew 19:21-22 - Jesus said unto him, If thou wilt be perfect, go and sell that thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come and follow me. But when the young man heard that saying, he went away sorrowful: for he had great possessions.

To understand God's gospel of Love, you must undergo a transformation from lover of self to a lover and servant of God. This may or may not be easy. One thing for sure is that an act of man's religion can never perform this transformation. Man's religious act of baptism by water is often confused with performing this transformation. To that young man in jail at twenty-four, he confirmed that baptism by water did nothing for him. Being baptized as a baby and then again at fourteen years old did nothing, he realized that for the last ten years he was living his life for the devil. He requested that Chapter 2 of God's third book, "Put God First" needed to be on Baptism.

God hates those that push religious acts onto the children of God.

Revelation 2:6 - But this thou hast, that thou hatest the deeds of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate.

John the Baptist made it clear that this transformation goes beyond his water baptism for repentance. God's word will baptize you with the Holy Ghost and fire. Your transformation will be evident by your fire! (See Matthew 3:11; Mark 1:8; Luke 3:16; John 1:33; Acts 1:5; Acts 11:16-18)

Luke 3:16 - John answered, saying unto them all, I indeed baptize you with water; but one mightier than I cometh, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire:

Your transformation is the result of being Born of the Spirit. Born in the Spirit, starts by believing in the one true God, maker of heaven and earth, that judges all.

1 Peter 4:17 - For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?

Revelation 14:7 - Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.

Being born of the Spirit continues by repenting of your sins. To confess your sins to God and then turn from your sins to a life unto God. To go and sin no more.

Acts 3:19 - Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord;

Acts 17:30 - And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:

John 5:14 - Afterward Jesus findeth him in the temple, and said unto him, Behold, thou art made whole: sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee.

John 8:11 - She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.

The king of Nineveh recognized the sincerity of Jonah bringing the message of repentance unto the people of Nineveh. The king fell to worship God.

Jonah 3:4-6 - And Jonah began to enter into the city a day's journey, and he cried, and said, Yet forty days, and Nineveh shall be overthrown. So the people of Nineveh believed God, and proclaimed a fast, and put on sackcloth, from the greatest of them even to the least of them. For word came unto the king of Nineveh, and he arose from his throne, and he laid his robe from him, and covered him with sackcloth, and sat in ashes.

Simon Peter repented of his sins and fell down on his knees.

Luke 5:8 - When Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, Depart from me; for I am a sinful man, O Lord.

After Jesus cleansed ten lepers, only one a Samaritan, turned back to give glory to God.

Luke 17:15-18 - And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, and with a loud voice glorified God, And fell down on his face at his feet, giving him thanks: and he was a Samaritan. And Jesus answering said, Were there not ten cleansed? but where are the nine? There are not found that returned to give glory to God, save this stranger.

Being born again in the Spirit to the keeping of your soul in well doing unto a faithful Creator.

1 Peter 4:18, 19 - And if the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear? Wherefore let them that suffer according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls to him in well doing, as unto a faithful Creator.

1 Peter 5:10-11 - But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle you. To him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen

Romans 12:2 - And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Being born again of the Spirit by understanding the word of God.

1 Peter 1:21-23 - Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God. Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently: Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

Being Born of the Spirit, by overcoming the wicked one. You have overcome the lusts thereof by doing the will of God. God has commanded that your light shine out of darkness by doing the will of God.

John 3:20,21 - For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved. But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.

2 Corinthians 4:6 - For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

1 John 2:14-17 – I have written unto you, fathers, because ye have known him that is from the beginning. I have written unto you, young men, because ye are strong, and the word of God abideth in you, and ye have overcome the wicked one. Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever

Jesus was clear in his instruction that one must be converted and born again in the Spirit. This is mandatory to see the kingdom of God.

John 3:3 - Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

Matthew 18:3-4 - And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven. Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

Hebrews 10:36 - For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.

Being born again in the Spirit with power, love and a sound mind. To the spirits of just men made perfect and converted from a lover of self to a lover of God.

2 Timothy 1:7 - For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

*Lay aside the sins of the flesh in exchange for doing the will of God.
Serving God by being a doer of his word and living God's gospel of Love.*

2 Corinthians 11:15 - Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.

James 1:18-22 - Of his own will begat he us with the word of truth, that we should be a kind of first fruits of his creatures.
Wherefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath: For the wrath of man worketh not the righteousness of God. Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls. But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.

1 Peter 3:17 - For it is better, if the will of God be so, that ye suffer for well doing, than for evil doing

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 14: Judge No One

God made it clear from the testimonies of the witnesses and prophets that you will be judged by the one true God, the Lord God. (See Matthew 7:21; Luke 18:13; Acts 17:30-31; Hebrews 13:3; 1 Corinthians 5:13; Romans 1:32; Romans 2:2,3,5,6,10; Romans 3:4,6; Romans 3:18-19; Psalm 43:1; Ecclesiastes 3:17; 2 Thessalonians 1:5; 1 Peter 4:17; 2 Peter 2:4; Jude 1:15; Revelation 14:7; Revelation 16:7,9; Revelations 20:12)

Romans 3:4,6 - God forbid: yea, let God be true, but every man a liar; as it is written, That thou mightest be justified in thy sayings, and mightest overcome when thou art judged. God forbid: for then how shall God judge the world?

Ecclesiastes 3:17 - I said in mine heart, God shall judge the righteous and the wicked: for there is a time there for every purpose and for every work.

1 Peter 4:17 - For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?

Jude 1:15 - To execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard speeches which ungodly sinners have spoken against him.

Revelation 14:7 - Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.

When you love God, you put no false gods before him. When you love God, you don't rely on your acts of righteousness to be acceptable to man or in comparison to another man's love of God. Your belief in God will be judged by God according to

your works. You must understand the truth in God's word according to the testimony of the witnesses. Humble yourself and put away your pride and arrogance and serve a living God. (See Revelation 20:12; 1 Peter 1:17; James 4:10-12; Hebrews 10:30, Romans 2:10)

1 Peter 1:17 - And if ye call on the Father, who without respect of persons judgeth according to every man's work, pass the time of your sojourning here in fear:

Hebrews 10:30 - For we know him that hath said, Vengeance belongeth unto me, I will recompense, saith the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge his people.

Romans 2:10 - But glory, honour, and peace, to every man that worketh good, to the Jew first, and also to the Gentile:

Do not be deceived by judging you works and deeds against others. These may be busy bodies, leading you astray. He that does righteousness is righteous.

2 Thessalonians 3:11 - For we hear that there are some which walk among you disorderly, working not at all, but are busybodies.

Romans 14:11-13 - For it is written, As I live, saith the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God. So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God. Let us not therefore judge one another any more: but judge this rather, that no man put a stumbling block or an occasion to fall in his brother's way.

1 John 3:7 - Little children, let no man deceive you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous.

Peter worried about the righteousness of John. After Jesus's resurrection, Jesus ask Peter three times if Peter loved him. Three times Jesus told Peter to follow him. After that Peter saw

John laying his head on the lap of Jesus. Peter asked Jesus what shall this man do. Jesus told Peter not to worry and follow thou me! Jesus made it clear to Peter to judge no one and just do the will of God.

John 21:21-22 - Peter seeing him saith to Jesus, Lord, and what shall this man do? Jesus saith unto him, If I will that he tarry till I come, what is that to thee? follow thou me.

Decide today to be converted and surrender to God, repent of your sins, love God and love your neighbor. To accept the kingdom of God as a little child. (See Matthew 18:3-4; Mark 10:15; Luke 18:17; 1 John 4:4,6-7)

Matthew 18:3-4 - And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven.

Mark 10:15 - Verily I say unto you, Whosoever shall not receive the kingdom of God as a little child, he shall not enter therein.

Luke 18:17 - Verily I say unto you, Whosoever shall not receive the kingdom of God as a little child shall in no wise enter therein.

1 John 4:4,6-7 - Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world. We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error. Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God.

When you comply with God's commandments and live his gospel of Love, then all that matters is walking in God's light by doing his will. Let no man judge you against his church customs or acts of religion. Do not let man tell you, as a woman, that God does not want you serving in his church. Do not let man tell you that

your only responsibility on the Sabbath is to go to church and give a tithe to church. God doesn't want your money. God wants your heart. Do not judge your walk against the walk of another man's belief in doing or not doing the will of God. When you walk in God's light, then the opinions of man doesn't matter. Be not wise in your own conceits. Do not judge after the flesh. Period!

Romans 12:16-18 - Be of the same mind one toward another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits. Recompense to no man evil for evil. Provide things honest in the sight of all men. If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men

Colossians 2:16 - Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days:

1 Corinthians 6:2,5 - Do ye not know that the saints shall judge the world? and if the world shall be judged by you, are ye unworthy to judge the smallest matters? I speak to your shame. Is it so, that there is not a wise man among you? no, not one that shall be able to judge between his brethren?

John 8:15 - Ye judge after the flesh; I judge no man

From the point forward, judge no one and spread the truth in God's word from the mouth of two or three witnesses. Focus on keeping yourself in the love of God.

Jude 1:21 - Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

Now, go forth and live God's gospel of Love. Love God. Love your neighbor. Go do the will of the Father. (See Matthew 7:21; Mark 14:36; Luke 11:2; John 5:30; Hebrews 10:36)

Matthew 7:21 - Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

Hebrews 10:36 - For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 15: Undeniable Love - God

Jesus was sent by God with a message of love. You understand the truth in God's word from the testimony of the witnesses. The testimonies of all eight witnesses were that one should have undeniable love for God. A message of love for God, the creator of heaven and earth! No where does God tells you to love yourself. Addiction, drunkenness, fornication and sin is all about love of self. That is exactly why the preponderance of evidence coming out of the testimony of the witnesses, is about love of God. When you love God, you repent and turn from sin and follow his commandments. Loving your neighbor as yourself.

John 5:2 - By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.

Your worship of God is shown by keeping his words! Worshipping him in spirit and truth.

Revelation 22:9 - Then saith he unto me, See thou do it not: for I am thy fellow servant, and of thy brethren the prophets, and of them which keep the sayings of this book: worship God.

John 4:24 - God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

The worship of God has been since the beginning.

Deuteronomy 6:5 - And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.

Joshua 23:11 - Take good heed therefore unto yourselves, that ye love the Lord your God.

Daniel 9:4 - And I prayed unto the Lord my God, and made my confession, and said, O Lord, the great and dreadful God,

keeping the covenant and mercy to them that love him, and to them that keep his commandments;

When you love God, you listen to his words and turn from your evil ways. Within a couple of generations after the great flood of Noah, the people of Nineveh turned to their evil ways. God sent Jonah to deliver a message of repentance to the people. He did not go right away, but he went! The sailors saw the power of God and offered a sacrifice unto the Lord God.

Jonah 1:1-3,15-16 - Now the word of the Lord came unto Jonah the son of Amittai, saying, Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and cry against it; for their wickedness is come up before me. But Jonah rose up to flee unto Tarshish from the presence of the Lord, and went down to Joppa; and he found a ship going to Tarshish: so he paid the fare thereof, and went down into it, to go with them unto Tarshish from the presence of the Lord. So they took up Jonah, and cast him forth into the sea: and the sea ceased from her raging. Then the men feared the Lord exceedingly, and offered a sacrifice unto the Lord, and made vows.

The king took heed to Jonah's message from God. The people turned from their wickedness. God made them a great city.

Jonah 3:5-6,8,10 - So the people of Nineveh believed God, and proclaimed a fast, and put on sackcloth, from the greatest of them even to the least of them. For word came unto the king of Nineveh, and he arose from his throne, and he laid his robe from him, and covered him with sackcloth, and sat in ashes. But let man and beast be covered with sackcloth, and cry mightily unto God: yea, let them turn every one from his evil way, and from the violence that is in their hands. And God saw their works, that they turned from their evil way; and God

repented of the evil, that he had said that he would do unto them; and he did it not.

When you love God, you repent and turn from your evil ways. Like the young man at the jail that was raised in a Christian home and went thru twelve years of Christian schooling, who said he didn't feel the love and glory of God! He spent every night in a bar, spinning records and drinking alcohol. Nothing he did in his life gave glory to God and no love of neighbor. Many people that know of God are stuck in the flesh of this world, failing to give the God the glory. To realize the glory of God, turn from the sins of the flesh, repent and follow God's commandments. Parable after parable was delivered to the people of growing in the glory of God. God's word is the seed. Don't let the devil destroy your walk with God. Get in a good place and grow God's word in your heart. When you love God, you hear his word and do it! Never turn from your walk with God. Walk with the righteous and endure to the end.

Luke 8:11-17,19,21 - Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God. Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved. They on the rock are they, which, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have no root, which for a while believe, and in time of temptation fall away. And that which fell among thorns are they, which, when they have heard, go forth, and are choked with cares and riches and pleasures of this life, and bring no fruit to perfection. But that on the good ground are they, which in an honest and good heart, having heard the word, keep it, and bring forth fruit with patience. No man, when he hath lighted a candle, covereth it with a vessel, or putteth it under a bed; but setteth it on a candlestick, that they which enter in may see the light. For nothing is secret, that shall not be made manifest; neither any thing hid, that shall not be

known and come abroad. Then came to him his mother and his brethren, and could not come at him for the press. And he answered and said unto them, My mother and my brethren are these which hear the word of God, and do it.

Jesus delivered God's commandments of Love. Love God and Love your neighbor.

Matthew 22:37 - Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.

Luke 10:27 - And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself.

Mark 12:30 - And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment.

1 John 4:21 - And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also.

When you love God, then you love your neighbor.

1 John 4:8,11 - He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love. Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another.

God has called you for a purpose. Walk with the Lord God to know his word. God will deliver.

1 Corinthians 2:9 - But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.

Romans 8:28 - And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

James 2:5 - Hearken, my beloved brethren, Hath not God chosen the poor of this world rich in faith, and heirs of the kingdom which he hath promised to them that love him?

Keep your walk with God, pure.

2 John 1:6 - And this is love, that we walk after his commandments. This is the commandment, That, as ye have heard from the beginning, ye should walk in it.

3 John 1:11 - Beloved, follow not that which is evil, but that which is good. He that doeth good is of God: but he that doeth evil hath not seen God.

Jude 1:21 - Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 16: Undeniable Love - Neighbor

Jesus was sent by God with a message of love. You understand the truth in God's word from the testimony of the witnesses. The testimonies of all eight witnesses were that one should have undeniable love for God and for one another. A message of love for others! No where does God tells you to love yourself. Addiction, drunkenness, fornication and sin is all about love of self. That is exactly why the preponderance of evidence coming out of the testimony of the witnesses, is about love of one another. Love that is fed by good works serving others.

Hebrews 10:24 - And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

Galatians 5:13 - For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another.

Love is a commandment given by God. Serving out of love is the fulfilment of the law.

Romans 13:8-10 - Owe no man anything, but to love one another: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law. For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. Love worketh no ill to his neighbour: therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.

1 John 3:11 - For this is the message that ye heard from the beginning, that we should love one another.

1 John 4:11-13,16,19-21 - Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another. No man hath seen God at any time.

If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and his love is perfected in us. Hereby know we that we dwell in him, and he in us, because he hath given us of his Spirit. And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him. We love him, because he first loved us. If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen? And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also.

Galatians 5:14 - For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this;
Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

John 15:17 - These things I command you, that ye love one another.

John 13:34 - A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.

Luke 10:27 - And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself.

Mark 12:31 - And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.

Matthew 19:19 - Honour thy father and thy mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

1 Thessalonians 4:9 - But as touching brotherly love ye need not that I write unto you: for ye yourselves are taught of God to love one another.

James 2:8 - If ye fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself, ye do well:

When you love one another with a pure heart, you are born again in the spirit, with a pure heart serving as directed by God.

1 Peter 1:22 - Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:

1 John 4:7,11-12 - Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God. Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another. No man hath seen God at any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and his love is perfected in us.

In the eyes of God, all that matters is love unto eternal life.

Ephesians 4:2 - With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love;

Jude 1:2,21 - Mercy unto you, and peace, and love, be multiplied. Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

The preponderance of evidence concerning the commandment of love for one another is overwhelming. All eight witnesses, spoke of it extensively. There is no other subject matter spoken of consistently by all eight witnesses. When you believe in God, then you live your life in his glory by loving and serving one another by doing good works.

Many of the lost have been deceived by the devil with this one verse:

Ephesians 2:8-9 - For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.

You will sit back on your laurels and as a proud fool, convince yourself that you are saved by grace and you don't have to do any works! Jesus did it all.

God wants you to know the truth in his word. Works in this verse is referring to religious works and the offering of blood sacrifices for the forgiveness of sins.

Never rely on the testimony of one witness to understand the truth in God's word. Avoid vain babbling. God wants you to serve him, by serving one another in love. Rely on the understanding of the truth in God's word from the mouth of two or three witnesses. When the testimony of all eight witnesses is in agreement, then you listen and obey God's word in truth.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 17: God's Promise

God's promise is eternal life!

Titus 1:2 - In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;

1 John 2:25 - And this is the promise that he hath promised us, even eternal life.

God's promise is made available for those that do the will of God.

Hebrews 10:36 - For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.

Your walk begins by doing the will of God. You recognize that only God can change your life by serving him. Serving him by living his gospel of Love. God's message is clear. If you love him, then keep his commandments.

John 14:15 - If ye love me, keep my commandments.

Do all you can do from this point forward to please God, do his will and live his gospel of Love. God's gospel of Love is simple. The truth starts with the understanding the truth in God's word from the testimony of the eight witnesses and prophets.

- *Believe in one God*
- *Repent of your sins and surrender to God.*
- *Judge no one*
- *Love God*
- *Love your Neighbor*
- *Keep yourself in the love of God, unto eternal life.*

Jude 1:21 - Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

All eight witnesses have testified of the commandments of God. Using the preponderance of evidence from their testimonies, the commandments are these: Do not commit adultery; Do not kill; Do not steal; Do not bear false witness; Honor thy father and thy mother; Love God; Love neighbor. Refrain from drunkenness. If you break one of these, then you break them all. You are told to walk in the light doing the will of God with a pure heart and not serving the lusts of the flesh.

1 Thessalonians 4:3-4 - For this is the will of God, even your sanctification, that ye should abstain from fornication: That every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honour;

Luke 21:34 - And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares.

Your work is to be directed in truth.

Isaiah 61:8 - For I the Lord love judgment, I hate robbery for burnt offering; and I will direct their work in truth, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them.

Being transformed into a child of God by doing the will of God from the heart.

Romans 12:2 - And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Ephesians 6:6 - Not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but as the servants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart;

1 John 2:17 - And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.

1 Peter 4:2 - That he no longer should live the rest of his time in the flesh to the lusts of men, but to the will of God.

God's promise starts with belief. Belief that God is real. Belief in the one true God. Belief in God's gospel of Love. Belief in serving God and man for entering into the kingdom of God.

Matthew 5:20 - For I say unto you, That except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven.

Your righteousness is your do by living God's gospel of Love. Belief that you can be saved by doing the will of God and bringing fruit to perfection.

Luke 8:11-16 - Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God. Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved. They on the rock are they, which, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have no root, which for a while believe, and in time of temptation fall away. And that which fell among thorns are they, which, when they have heard, go forth, and are choked with cares and riches and pleasures of this life, and bring no fruit to perfection. But that on the good ground are they, which in an honest and good heart, having heard the word, keep it, and bring forth fruit with patience. No man, when he hath lighted a candle, covereth it with a vessel, or putteth it under a bed; but setteth it on a candlestick, that they which enter in may see the light.

1 Corinthians 15:1-2 - Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received,

and wherein ye stand; By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.

To believe is to serve by baptism by fire of the Holy Spirit. To love like God loves. To preach God's gospel of Love throughout the world.

Mark 16:14-16 - Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen. And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

To a God that loves you so much that he sends prophets to the earth, to make sure that you understand and believe on his power in the gospel of Love, so that the earth might be saved. Saving the earth follows your recognition of God's ability to save you.

Acts 15:7-11 - And when there had been much disputing, Peter rose up, and said unto them, Men and brethren, ye know how that a good while ago God made choice among us, that the Gentiles by my mouth should hear the word of the gospel, and believe. And God, which knoweth the hearts, bare them witness, giving them the Holy Ghost, even as he did unto us; And put no difference between us and them, purifying their hearts by faith. Now therefore why tempt ye God, to put a yoke upon the neck of the disciples, which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear? But we believe that through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved, even as they.

Acts 16:30-32 - And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus

Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house. And they spake unto him the word of the Lord, and to all that were in his house.

John 12:47 - And if any man hear my words, and believe not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world.

May your deeds be found worthy of the blessings of God.

John 3:16-17,19-21 - For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved. But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.

May your heart be stabilized by the truth in God's word and your works of love, pleasing him.

2 Thessalonians 2:13-14,16-17 - But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth: Whereunto he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given us everlasting consolation and good hope through grace, Comfort your hearts, and stablish you in every good word and work.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 18: Baptism with Fire

God made it clear that out of the mouth of two or three witnesses you will know the truth. Twelve times in the bible God tells you how to understand the truth in his word.

What Jesus said is of his Father. The testimony of two men is true.

John 8:17-18 - It is also written in your law, that the testimony of two men is true. I am one that bear witness of myself, and the Father that sent me beareth witness of me.

The preponderance of evidence standard from the testimony of two or three witnesses will be used to confirm if God requires water baptism for salvation.

Case Testimony:

John the Baptist testimony was clear. God's word will baptize you with the Holy Ghost and fire. Your testimony will be your fire!
(See Matthew 3:11, Mark 1:8, Luke 3:16, John 1:33, Acts 1:5, Acts 11:16-18)

Luke 3:16 - John answered, saying unto them all, I indeed baptize you with water; but one mightier than I cometh, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire:

John made it clear that you must repent of your sins.

Matthew 3:1-2 - In those days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness of Judaea, And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Remember that when Jesus's ministry started, John the Baptist was thrown in jail. Immediately, that should tell you that God did not want any act of man or religion to confuse the meaning of

God's gospel of Love brought to earth by Jesus. John confirmed that any gift from God, comes from heaven.

Matthew 4:1-2,11-12 - Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil. [2] And when he had fasted forty days and forty nights, he was afterward an hungred. Then the devil leaveth him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto him. Now when Jesus had heard that John was cast into prison, he departed into Galilee;

Mark 1:14 - Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God,

John 3:24,27 - For John was not yet cast into prison. John answered and said, A man can receive nothing, except it be given him from heaven.

Paul, Barnabas and Peter made it clear that an act of man or religion is not required to receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. The Holy Ghost is given by God to those that hear the gospel and whose heart is right with him.

Acts 15:1,5-8 - And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved. When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question. But there rose up certain of the sect of the Pharisees which believed, saying, That it was needful to circumcise them, and to command them to keep the law of Moses. And the apostles and elders came together for to consider of this matter. And when there had been much disputing, Peter rose up, and said unto them, Men and brethren, ye know how that a good while ago God made choice among us, that the Gentiles by my mouth should hear

the word of the gospel, and believe. And God, which knoweth the hearts, bare them witness, giving them the Holy Ghost, even as he did unto us;

Paul informed the Corinthians that he was not sent to baptize, but to preach the gospel. Only by understanding the power of God's word will you be able to have fire in your testimony.

1 Corinthians 1:17-18 - For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect. For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.

Both Luke and Peter inform you that water baptism is but a sign of an answer of good conscience toward God. You are only offered salvation by living God's gospel of Love. No where in the New Testament did God command you to get baptized in water.

1 Peter 3:21 - The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:

Acts 10:42-44 - And he commanded us to preach unto the people, and to testify that it is he which was ordained of God to be the Judge of quick and dead. To him give all the prophets witness, that through his name whosoever believeth in him shall receive remission of sins. While Peter yet spake these words, the Holy Ghost fell on all them which heard the word.

All Jewish apostles likely received water baptism during the ministry of Jesus. It wasn't until after Jesus ascended into heaven did the baptism of the Holy Ghost fall on those believers assembled into the upper room on the day of the Pentecost. The

conviction of the Holy Ghost fell on those whose heart was right with God. This baptism of the Holy Ghost or circumcision of the heart resulted in the conversion of their heart from a lover of self to a lover of God. They were born again as a child of God. The Holy Ghost gave them the power of tongues and fulfilled Jesus's prophesy that they shall go into all the world and preach the gospel.

Acts 1:13-14 - And when they were come in, they went up into an upper room, where abode both Peter, and James, and John, and Andrew, Philip, and Thomas, Bartholomew, and Matthew, James the son of Alphaeus, and Simon Zelotes, and Judas the brother of James. These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brethren.

Acts 2:1-4 - And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

The power of the Holy Ghost was received without water baptism! Just as John the Baptist told you.

Acts 4:19-20,31-33 - But Peter and John answered and said unto them, Whether it be right in the sight of God to hearken unto you more than unto God, judge ye. For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard. And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness. And the multitude of

them that believed were of one heart and of one soul: neither said any of them that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things common. And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all.

This gift and power of the Holy Ghost cannot be bought. It is only available when your heart is right with God.

Acts 8:15,19-21 - Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Ghost: Saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost. But Peter said unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou hast thought that the gift of God may be purchased with money. Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God.

You are told that Jesus did not baptize anyone in water. Jesus performed many miracles with power from God above. The Jewish people and Pharisees took John the Baptist to be a prophet and that his power was from above. Sarcastically, Jesus made it clear that his power was from above and John's baptism with water was of man. Thus, man nor water baptism can never take away sin.

Matthew 21:24-25,27 - And Jesus answered and said unto them, I also will ask you one thing, which if ye tell me, I in like wise will tell you by what authority I do these things. The baptism of John, whence was it? from heaven, or of men? And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say unto us, Why did ye not then believe him? And they answered Jesus, and said, We cannot tell. And he said unto them, Neither tell I you by what authority I do these things.

Mark 11:29-31,33 - And Jesus answered and said unto them, I will also ask of you one question, and answer me, and I will tell you by what authority I do these things. The baptism of John, was it from heaven, or of men? answer me. And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say, Why then did ye not believe him? And they answered and said unto Jesus, We cannot tell. And Jesus answering saith unto them, Neither do I tell you by what authority I do these things.

Luke 20:3-4,8 - And he answered and said unto them, I will also ask you one thing; and answer me: The baptism of John, was it from heaven, or of men? And Jesus said unto them, Neither tell I you by what authority I do these things.

Hebrews 10:11 - And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins:

Decision: The decision is clear. The power of the Holy Ghost is the result of spiritual Baptism by the God for those whose heart is right with God. A converted and repented heart that has asked for forgiveness of sins. A converted and repented heart that loves God and loves your neighbor. God gives the gift of the Holy Ghost is sent by spiritual Baptism. Water baptism is but a sign performed by man. When you lead someone to God, you must take this responsibility personally and make sure they understand God's word! Some churches may require water baptism as a sign of your personal commitment to the Gospel. This water baptism will not likely result in a converted heart, as required by God, for the baptism of the Holy Ghost. Your testimony will be your fire and a sign of your spiritual baptism by the Holy Ghost!

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 19: The Judge

The preponderance of evidence testimonies in the New Testament, make it clear that you will be judged by God. When you love God, you put no false gods before him. A false god is anything or anyone you put before him and worship. It is clear that the love of money, sports, alcohol, drugs, addictions and the serving of self in the flesh are all false gods. Ignorance of God's word is unacceptable to God. Do not rely on any religious act of man to gain favor or be considered righteous in the eyes of God. You walk starts when you surrender to God's will and repent of your sins. Put away that wicked person and God will raise you from the dead.

Acts 17:30-31 - And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent: Because he hath appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom he hath ordained; whereof he hath given assurance unto all men, in that he hath raised him from the dead.

Hebrews 13:4 - Marriage is honourable in all, and the bed undefiled: but whoremongers and adulterers God will judge.

1 Corinthians 5:13 - But them that are without God judgeth. Therefore put away from among yourselves that wicked person.

Romans 2:2,3,5 - But we are sure that the judgment of God is according to truth against them which commit such things. And thinkest thou this, O man, that judgest them which do such things, and doest the same, that thou shalt escape the judgment of God? But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God;

Psalms 43:1 - Judge me, O God, and plead my cause against an ungodly nation: O deliver me from the deceitful and unjust man.

Ecclesiastes 3:17 - I said in mine heart, God shall judge the righteous and the wicked: for there is a time there for every purpose and for every work.

Peter made it clear that God did not spare the angels that sinned.

2 Peter 2:4 - For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;

Do not blaspheme the name of God and believe that there is any other way to be with God than living his gospel of Love.

Revelation 16:7,9 - And I heard another out of the altar say, Even so, Lord God Almighty, true and righteous are thy judgments. And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God, which hath power over these plagues: and they repented not to give him glory.

Your time on this earth is but a vapor. Your belief in God will be judged according to your works. You must understand the truth in God's word according to the testimony of the witnesses. Humble yourself and put away your pride and arrogance and serve a living God. Your works matter.

Revelation 20:12 - And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

1 Peter 1:17 - And if ye call on the Father, who without respect of persons judgeth according to every man's work, pass the time of your sojourning here in fear:

James 4:10-12,14-15 - Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up. Speak not evil one of another, brethren. He that speaketh evil of his brother, and judgeth his brother, speaketh evil of the law, and judgeth the law: but if thou judge the law, thou art not a doer of the law, but a judge. There is one lawgiver, who is able to save and to destroy: who art thou that judgest another? Whereas ye know not what shall be on the morrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapour, that appeareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away. For that ye ought to say, If the Lord will, we shall live, and do this, or that.

Acts 7:7 - And the nation to whom they shall be in bondage will I judge, said God: and after that shall they come forth, and serve me in this place.

Two of the witnesses God sent me, had said that they died, went to heaven, talked to God and God sent them back to earth. God told them that he was not done with them. God has been patiently waiting for your works.

You can choose to ignore the testimony of the witnesses. God will not ignore the testimony of the witnesses. Moses ignored the testimonies of Caleb and Joshua. Moses did not make it to the promised land. Caleb and Joshua made it to the promise land.

Only one witness gave testimony that you will be judged by Jesus. Avoid vain babbling.

John 5:22,26-27 - For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son: For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in

himself; And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man.

That same witness, gave testimony that God is the Judge.

Revelation 20:12 - And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

Decide today to surrender to God, repent of your sins, love God and love your neighbor. Walk in God's light by doing his will.

Looking forward to being judged by God, after doing his will .

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 20: Idols

All that has been made known to you from the preponderance of evidence from the testimony of the witnesses reveals that God is King. Now, if God is King then is there any reason why you would be worshipping the persons, places or things of man and religion. Stone statues, molten images, persons, money, precious metals or high places are all considered idols in the word of God. One hundred and nineteen times in the Bible, God tells you not to worship idols. When you focus your worship on the works of religion and the things of man, it distracts from the commandments of love that God has given you.

The worship of idols turns your attention from the love of God to the love of stuff. Idols deceive and are considered unrighteous in the eyes of God.

1 Corinthians 6:9 - Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind,

Jesus knew that God is King. He told his followers how to pray. When you pray, you pray to God the Father. Period.

Matthew 6:9: After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.

Luke 11:2 - And he said unto them, When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth.

Man's religion will have you praying to everyone, but God. It is time to turn from the idols and focus your being on God. No longer serving idols and sin, but only serving God.

Exodus 20:1-3 - And God spake all these words, saying, I am the Lord thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

Leviticus 19:4 - Turn ye not unto idols, nor make to yourselves molten gods: I am the Lord your God.

Leviticus 26:1 - Ye shall make you no idols nor graven image, neither rear you up a standing image, neither shall ye set up any image of stone in your land, to bow down unto it: for I am the Lord your God.

2 Kings 17:12 - For they served idols, whereof the Lord had said unto them, Ye shall not do this thing.

As the apostles preached unto the Gentiles, idols were found to rule the daily lives of the lost.

Acts 19:35 - And when the townclerk had appeased the people, he said, Ye men of Ephesus, what man is there that knoweth not how that the city of the Ephesians is a worshipper of the great goddess Diana, and of the image which fell down from Jupiter?

1 Corinthians 8:1 - Now as touching things offered unto idols, we know that we all have knowledge. Knowledge puffeth up, but charity edifieth.

An idol is nothing in the world, but a distraction, keeping you from serving God and living God's gospel of Love.

1 Corinthians 8:4,6 - As concerning therefore the eating of those things that are offered in sacrifice unto idols, we know that an idol is nothing in the world, and that there is none other God but one.

John could not have made God's direction anymore clear.

1 John 5:21 - Little children, keep yourselves from idols. Amen.

When you believe in God and his gospel of Love, you'll recognize the unrighteousness that God hates. Once you recognize and acknowledge God in the Spirit as being the Almighty and creator of heaven and earth, you repent and turn from your earthly idols and sin to the things of God.

Revelation 9:20-21 - And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk: Neither repented they of their murders, nor of their sorceries, nor of their fornication, nor of their thefts.

Idols, acts of religion and the religious works of man mean nothing in the eyes of God. If by faith your sinful life and idol worship doesn't change, then God is still waiting for you to be converted and born again as a child of God. Prior to Jesus's ministry on this earth, God sent John the Baptist to preach a gospel of repentance. No longer advocating the works of religion and the continuous offering of animal sacrifice for sin, but for the Jews to repent and turn from sin. God knew exactly what would happen if John's gospel of repentance and water baptism was included in his gospel of Love. People would assume self-proclaimed righteousness in the eyes of God by water baptism and acts of religion and then worship these as idols. That is why John the Baptist was thrown into prison at the start of Jesus's ministry. (See Mark 1:14; Matthew 4:12; Luke 3:20; John 3:24)

Mark 1:14 - Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God,

Do not be fooled by man's acts of religion to provide righteousness in the eyes of God. God is looking for your change of heart. Do all you can do from this point forward to please God and live his gospel of Love. The truth starts with the understanding God's word and the testimony of the eight witnesses.

- *Believe in one God*
- *Repent of your sins and surrender to God.*
- *Judge no one*
- *Love God*
- *Love your Neighbor*
- *Keep yourself in the love of God, unto eternal life.*

Jude 1:21 - Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

Decide today, to walk like Enoch walked. Enoch had a testimony that pleased God.

Hebrews 11:1,5-6 - Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God. But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

Believe that God has a plan for you. Have faith, worship only God and go live his gospel of Love. God rewards those that diligently seek him.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 21: Sober

In the early days of the jail ministry there was one young man that finished all the jail ministry workbooks. Following his release, he came to the recovery program at church a couple of times. When he failed to show up for a couple of weeks, another minister and I decided to visit him at his home only to find him stoned and his younger brother was in distress. They were living at grandma's and the roof leaked above the sink. They were supposed to fix it and his older brother was stoned. That young man said that it is not a sin in the bible to smoke weed. If God didn't want you to smoke weed, then he wouldn't have created it! That young man loved no one but himself. He did not love God nor did he love his grandma and brother. Being high on weed in a state of drunkenness offends God.

In this state of sin, he will never come to realize the glory of following God's gospel of Love. God knew that you could not serve him, nor serve your neighbor by being high on drugs or drunk on alcohol. Jesus knew that he could not serve God by being drunk on wine. Out of the mouth of three witnesses, Jesus promised to abstain from fruit of the vine until he is with God in heaven.

Matthew 26:29 - But I say unto you, I will not drink henceforth of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom.

Mark 14:25 - Verily I say unto you, I will drink no more of the fruit of the vine, until that day that I drink it new in the kingdom of God.

Luke 22:18 - For I say unto you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine, until the kingdom of God shall come.

For that young man that chose to be high, Jesus not wanting wine would not apply to him, except that multiple witnesses have testified that Jesus told his apostles and followers to follow him.

Matthew 16:24 - Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.

Mark 8:34 - And when he had called the people unto him with his disciples also, he said unto them, Whosoever will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.

Mark 10:21-22 - Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow me.

Luke 5:27 - And after these things he went forth, and saw a publican, named Levi, sitting at the receipt of custom: and he said unto him, Follow me.

Luke 9:23 - And he said to them all, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me.

John 10:27 - My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

John 12:26 - If any man serve me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will my Father honour.

John 21:19 - This spake he, signifying by what death he should glorify God. And when he had spoken this, he saith unto him, Follow me.

Acts 12:8 - And the angel said unto him, Gird thyself, and bind on thy sandals. And so he did. And he saith unto him, Cast thy garment about thee, and follow me.

The preponderance of evidence from the testimony of the witnesses, is that your walk with the Lord should be sober, serving God and neighbor and not in a state of drunkenness. The Lord will come when you least expect it.

Matthew 24:48-50 - But and if that evil servant shall say in his heart, My lord delayeth his coming; And shall begin to smite his fellowservants, and to eat and drink with the drunken; The lord of that servant shall come in a day when he looketh not for him, and in an hour that he is not aware of,

Luke 21:34 - And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares

Romans 12:1-3 - I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith

Romans 13:13 KJV - Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying.

1 Thessalonians 5:6-8 - Therefore let us not sleep, as do others; but let us watch and be sober. For they that sleep sleep in the

night; and they that be drunken are drunken in the night. But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation.

Titus 2:2-4 - That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in faith, in charity, in patience. The aged women likewise, that they be in behaviour as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things; That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children, Young men likewise exhort to be sober minded.

1 Peter 1:13 - Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ;

Galatians 5:21 - Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

1 Peter 4:7 - But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer.

1 Peter 5:8 - Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour

1 Corinthians 6:10 - Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.

When you decide to love from the heart, you will follow the teachings of the prophets. Your life, is not your old life, but born again in the Spirit, into a new life serving God and neighbor.

Ephesians 5:17-18,21 - Wherefore be ye not unwise, but understanding what the will of the Lord is. And be not drunk

with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit;
Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.

Matthew 16:25 - For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: and
whosoever will lose his life for my sake shall find it.

Luke 12:45-46 - But and if that servant say in his heart, My lord
delayeth his coming; and shall begin to beat the menservants
and maidens, and to eat and drink, and to be drunken; The lord
of that servant will come in a day when he looketh not for him,
and at an hour when he is not aware, and will cut him in
sunder, and will appoint him his portion with the unbelievers.

1 Peter 2:1-3 - Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and
hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings, As newborn
babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow
thereby: If so be ye have tasted that the Lord is gracious

1 Peter 3:8-11 -Finally, be ye all of one mind, having compassion
one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous: Not
rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but contrariwise
blessing; knowing that ye are thereunto called, that ye should
inherit a blessing. For he that will love life, and see good days,
let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak
no guile: Let him eschew evil, and do good; let him seek peace,
and ensue it.

1 Peter 3:17 - For it is better, if the will of God be so, that ye suffer
for well doing, than for evil doing.

James 4:2-4 - Ye lust, and have not: ye kill, and desire to have, and
cannot obtain: ye fight and war, yet ye have not, because ye
ask not. Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye
may consume it upon your lusts. Ye adulterers and
adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is

enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.

The preponderance of evidence is clear. When you desire God's gift of everlasting life, then you refrain from drunkenness. You are a good steward and you serve the things of God. Serving not to the lusts of men, but to the will of God.

1 Peter 4:2 - That he no longer should live the rest of his time in the flesh to the lusts of men, but to the will of God

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 22: Kingdom of God

The kingdom of God, is ruled by God the King. It is NOT a kingdom of churches ruled by men, but a kingdom in the spirit of righteousness, love, peace and charity.

Romans 14:16-17 - Let not then your good be evil spoken of: For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.

Matthew 7:21 - Not everyone that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

God is a Spirit that desires your worship in spirit and truth.

John 4:23-24 - But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

Do not continue in the sins of the flesh and self-love.

1 Corinthians 15:50 - Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.

Jesus came preaching God's gospel of love. Repent and turn from sin then believe the gospel.

Mark 1:14-15 - Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.

Seek the kingdom of God and all these things shall be added unto you.

Matthew 6:33 - But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

Luke 12:30-32 - For all these things do the nations of the world seek after: and your Father knoweth that ye have need of these things. But rather seek ye the kingdom of God; and all these things shall be added unto you. Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

Casting out the devils and your sinful life by the Spirit of God, thus being born again then the kingdom of God will come upon you.

Matthew 12:28 - But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.

John 3:3 - Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

The kingdom of God will come with a change in your life. Jesus declared that he would drink no more wine until the kingdom of God comes. (See Matthew 26:29. Mark 14:25, Luke 22:18)

Luke 22:18 - For I say unto you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine, until the kingdom of God shall come.

When you follow Jesus, you turn from drunkenness. Continue in the faith. With love and much tribulation, your reward will be great!

Acts 14:22 - Confirming the souls of the disciples, and exhorting them to continue in the faith, and that we must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom of God.

James 2:5 - Hearken, my beloved brethren, Hath not God chosen the poor of this world rich in faith, and heirs of the kingdom which he hath promised to them that love him?

2 Thessalonians 1:5 - Which is a manifest token of the righteous judgment of God, that ye may be counted worthy of the kingdom of God, for which ye also suffer:

Seek the word of God in truth and believe. Do the will of God.

1 Thessalonians 2:12-13 - That ye would walk worthy of God, who hath called you unto his kingdom and glory. For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that believe.

There is no greater love for your neighbor, than sharing God's word. You can't say you love God if there is no love for your neighbor. There can be no charity shown, unless you are a doer of his word. Faith without works is dead. Your love of God is shown by faith, hope and charity with the greatest of these is charity. Your faith is shown by your charity.

1 Timothy 1:4-5 - Neither give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which minister questions, rather than godly edifying which is in faith: so do. Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart, and of a good conscience, and of faith unfeigned:

1 John 3:11 - For this is the message that ye heard from the beginning, that we should love one another.

Jude is but one chapter in the New Testament. He even knew your faith is shown by acts of charity.

Jude 1:12-13 - These are spots in your feasts of charity, when they feast with you, feeding themselves without fear: clouds they are without water, carried about of winds; trees whose fruit withereth, without fruit, twice dead, plucked up by the roots; Raging waves of the sea, foaming out their own shame;

wandering stars, to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness for ever.

You are to have charity. According to Peter, he says to have fervent charity.

Titus 2:2 - That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in faith, in charity, in patience.

1 Peter 4:7-8 - But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer. And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins.

God doesn't need a physical church here on earth. The earth is his kingdom! The earth is his church. The will of God demands that we live here, hand in hand, in the spirit of peace, love and charity. To live his gospel of love.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 23: Give God Your Do

Jesus was sent by God with a message of love. The preponderance of evidence coming out of the testimony of the witnesses, is about love and good works by serving others. Do not be fooled into thinking that man's acts of religion will provide righteousness in the eyes of God. God does not want your works of religion. (i.e. Animal and blood sacrifice, water baptism, works of the law, etc.) Paul, Barnabas and Peter spoke out against works of religion and the law of Moses being required for the gift of everlasting life.

Acts 15:1,5-11 - And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved. But there rose up certain of the sect of the Pharisees which believed, saying, That it was needful to circumcise them, and to command them to keep the law of Moses. And the apostles and elders came together for to consider of this matter. And when there had been much disputing, Peter rose up, and said unto them, Men and brethren, ye know how that a good while ago God made choice among us, that the Gentiles by my mouth should hear the word of the gospel, and believe. And God, which knoweth the hearts, bare them witness, giving them the Holy Ghost, even as he did unto us; And put no difference between us and them, purifying their hearts by faith. Now therefore why tempt ye God, to put a yoke upon the neck of the disciples, which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear? But we believe that through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved, even as they.

Don't be fooled into thinking that you are saved by grace and God doesn't want your service. God is looking for you to do the will of God unto good works out of love for your neighbor.

Ephesians 2:10 - For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

Galatians 2:16 - Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

When you love God, you succumb to good works. You will be judged by your works. Not the works of religion, but works of love.

Revelation 3:15-17 - I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot. So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth. Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:

Hebrews 10:24 - And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

James 2:18-26 - Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works. Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble. But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead? Was not Abraham our father justified by works, when he had offered Isaac his son upon the altar? Seest thou how faith wrought with his works, and by works was faith made perfect? And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God. Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only. Likewise also was not

Rahab the harlot justified by works, when she had received the messengers, and had sent them out another way? For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

Matthew 5:12,16 - Rejoice, and be exceedingly glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

Matthew 16:27 - For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with his angels; and then he shall reward every man according to his works.

2 Timothy 3:17 - That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

Timothy 6:18 - That they do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate;

1 Peter 2:12 - Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by your good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation.

Revelation 18:6 - Reward her even as she rewarded you, and double unto her double according to her works: in the cup which she hath filled fill to her double.

Revelation 20:12-13 - And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which

were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.

Your works are evidence of walking in the light and your deeds wrought in God.

John 3:19-21 - And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved. But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.

Never rely on the testimony of one witness to understand the truth in God's word. God wants your good works. Rely on the understanding of the truth in God's word from the mouth of two or three witnesses. When the testimony of all eight witnesses are in agreement, then you listen and obey God's word in truth, always looking to do good works.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 24: Pride

Pride will keep you from knowing and understanding the truth in God's word from the mouth of two or three witnesses. Most modern-day religious people feel comfortable in their numb state of following religion. If these prior sentences offended you, then that is your pride getting in the way of your walk with the Lord.

Pride will prevent you from having a relationship and walking in the light of our Lord God. Pride will prevent you from having a glorious life with God in heaven. Pride comes in all shapes, sizes and financial levels. Modern day religions do not focus on your pride which is keeping you from having a glorious life with God. Instead, they focus on the works of religion, building the physical church and presenting you a set of spiritual verses with a promise of salvation or being saved. Pride has put more souls in hell, than the devil himself!

Jesus made it clear in his parables that a rich man will have trouble entering the kingdom of God. God made it clear in these three verses that it is impossible for man to save anyone and it is only possible with God. (See Luke 18:25-27; Mark 10:25-27; Matthew 19:24-26)

Luke 18:25-27 - For it is easier for a camel to go through a needle's eye, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God. And they that heard it said, Who then can be saved? And he said, The things which are impossible with men are possible with God.

It was clear in the 50+ church witnesses that I performed from September of 2023 to April of 2024, that rich men were welcome into the churches. Promises of salvation or being saved were made by your participation in water baptism, knowledge of a couple of bible verses and the offering of tithes

and offerings to the church. Modern day salvation message per men's religion is easy! Love yourself and you can have it all. This is an oxymoron to God's salvation message brought to the earth by Jesus.

God wants one thing. Your heart! If your heart desires the self-serving love of money, alcohol, drugs or idols, then there is no room in your heart for the love of God and the love of your neighbor. God is looking for your heart and your walk to be pure by following after righteousness, peace and holiness.

1 Timothy 6:10-12 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows. But thou, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness. Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses.

Hebrews 12:14 - Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:

Jesus was clear in his testimony. If you want a relationship with God, then "follow me." (See Matthew 19:16-21; Mark 10:17-21; Luke 18:18-22)

Matthew 19:16-21 - And, behold, one came and said unto him, Good Master, what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life? And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments. He saith unto him, Which? Jesus said, Thou shalt do no murder, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Honour thy father and thy mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. The young man saith unto him,

All these things have I kept from my youth up: what lack I yet?
Jesus said unto him, If thou wilt be perfect, go and sell that
thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in
heaven: and come and follow me.

God's love boils down to three words.

"Love thy Neighbor."

If you say you love God and hate your neighbor, then God's love is not in you. The rich man loved money more than anything else. Jesus knew his heart and said to follow him. He knew the rich man would choose his money. You either have empathy and the love of others or you don't. Being born again is about being born as a new man with a heart that loves others. Saving the world is only possible by loving your neighbor. By you following the gospel of Love and doing the will of God from the heart, is exactly what God is looking for. In this next parable that Jesus taught, who's action was favorable in the eyes of God: the priest, the Levite or the Samaritan.

Luke 10:25-37 - And, behold, a certain lawyer stood up, and tempted him, saying, Master, what shall I do to inherit eternal life? He said unto him, What is written in the law? how readest thou? And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself. And he said unto him, Thou hast answered right: this do, and thou shalt live. But he, willing to justify himself, said unto Jesus, And who is my neighbor? And Jesus answering said, A certain man went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves, which stripped him of his raiment, and wounded him, and departed, leaving him half dead. And by chance there came down a certain priest that way: and when he saw him, he passed by on the other side. And likewise a

Levite, when he was at the place, came and looked on him, and passed by on the other side. But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was: and when he saw him, he had compassion on him, And went to him, and bound up his wounds, pouring in oil and wine, and set him on his own beast, and brought him to an inn, and took care of him. And on the morrow when he departed, he took out two pence, and gave them to the host, and said unto him, Take care of him; and whatsoever thou spendest more, when I come again, I will repay thee. Which now of these three, thinkest thou, was neighbour unto him that fell among the thieves? And he said, He that shewed mercy on him. Then said Jesus unto him, Go, and do thou likewise.

The religious works and worship by the priest and Levite did nothing in changing their heart to loving the things of God! Without expecting anything in return, the Samaritan loved his neighbor from the heart!

James cautions the rich man.

James 5:1-2 Go to now, ye rich men, weep and howl for your miseries that shall come upon you. Your riches are corrupted, and your garments are moth-eaten.

Jesus was clear in his last message to Peter. Jesus told Peter not to worry about how anyone else is serving God. God just wants you to follow the gospel that Jesus brought to this earth.

John 21:20-22 - Then Peter, turning about, seeth the disciple whom Jesus loved following; which also leaned on his breast at supper, and said, Lord, which is he that betrayeth thee? Peter seeing him saith to Jesus, Lord, and what shall this man do? Jesus saith unto him, If I will that he tarry till I come, what is that to thee? follow thou me.

God is looking for the humble and not the proud. A humble man can be taught to live the will of God as taught out of the mouth of two or three witnesses. In this following parable, the proud Pharisee will never stoop to do the will of God.

Luke 18:9-14 - And he spake this parable unto certain which trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others: Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a publican. The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican. I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess. And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner. I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.

God is looking for your heart. Humble yourself and begin your walk as a little child. Do not be fooled by religious acts of man or your religious past. Repent of your sins, surrender and give your heart to God. When your heart is right with God, you look for ways to do works, serving God and neighbor. With a humble spirit, look for ways to serve him, loving your neighbor and spreading the truth in God's word out of the mouth of two or three witnesses.

Proverbs 16:18-19,25 - Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall. Better it is to be of an humble spirit with the lowly, than to divide the spoil with the proud. There is a way that seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death.

What seems right to a man in this single witness testimony on grace is salvation without works.

Ephesians 2:8-9 - For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.

In my 50+ church witnesses, one of the pastor's spoke on being saved. He testified that Mother Theresa was not in heaven because she relied on good works to get her there. Mother Theresa never spoke on being saved. Mother Theresa didn't need to speak on being saved. She lived the life of the Samaritan in Luke 10:25-37. She judged no one and loved everyone, as a perfect example of compliance to the God's gospel of Love, brought to this earth by the prophets. With a humble spirit, following repentance of sin, you are God's workmanship unto good works.

Ephesians 2:10 - For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

Unto good works is a testimony of multiple witnesses. If you love God, then you do good works. When you follow Jesus, you do good works.

Hebrews 10:24 - And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

1 Peter 2:12 - Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by your good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation.

John 10:32,37-38 - Jesus answered them, Many good works have I shewed you from my Father; for which of those works do ye stone me? If I do not the works of my Father, believe me not.

But if I do, though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in me, and I in him.

Matthew 16:27 - For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with his angels; and then he shall reward every man according to his works.

Matthew 5:16 - Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

Faith without works is dead. If you know God, then your works will not deny him.

James 2:19-22,24-26 - Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble. But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead? Was not Abraham our father justified by works, when he had offered Isaac his son upon the altar? Seest thou how faith wrought with his works, and by works was faith made perfect? Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only. Likewise also was not Rahab the harlot justified by works, when she had received the messengers, and had sent them out another way? For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

Titus 1:16 - They profess that they know God; but in works they deny him, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate.

May your walk with God, worship him in deed and truth unto good works!

1 John 3:17-18 - But whoso hath this world's good, and seeth his brother have need, and shutteth up his bowels of compassion from him, how dwelleth the love of God in him? My little

children, let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but indeed and in truth.

2 Timothy 3:17 - That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 25: Called to Serve

The preponderance of evidence testimony from the eight New Testament witnesses tells you that when you accept God as King and his promise of eternal life, then you are Called to Serve. When you are Called to Serve then you are freed from the dead works of the devil, born again in the spirit, with a spirit that is alive following God's gospel of Love in faith and works.

James 2:26 - For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

Twice, Jesus said that you must be born again.

John 3:3,5-8 - Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again. The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

You are born again and Called to Serve only God. Eighty-seven times in the New Testament Jesus's words says to follow. Don't worry about anyone else, but following the teachings that God sent thru Jesus. Time after time, Jesus repeated this verse to Peter. Finally, being fed up and feeling that Jesus was picking on him, Peter said what about this guy as John that was leaning on Jesus. Jesus said, not to worry about him and you just follow me.

John 21:20-22 - Then Peter, turning about, seeth the disciple whom Jesus loved following; which also leaned on his breast at supper, and said, Lord, which is he that betrayeth thee? Peter seeing him saith to Jesus, Lord, and what shall this man do? Jesus saith unto him, If I will that he tarry till I come, what is that to thee? follow thou me.

When you follow, Jesus, you hear his voice. You know the truth in his word from the mouth of the witnesses.

John 10:27 - My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

When his followers asked what it took to be saved, Jesus said to serve and follow me!

Luke 18:22 - Now when Jesus heard these things, he said unto him, Yet lackest thou one thing: sell all that thou hast, and distribute unto the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, follow me.

Luke 9:23 - And he said to them all, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me.

Follow the teachings of Jesus and being Called to Serve is not about lip service. Lip service by saying you believe in God and walk with the devil. You cannot serve God and money or the things of the devil at the same time. You honor God with your works of Love.

Matthew 6:24 - No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

Luke 16:13 - No servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

Mark 7:6-9 - He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth me with their lips, but their heart is far from me. Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men. For laying aside the commandment of God, ye hold the tradition of men, as the washing of pots and cups: and many other such like things ye do. And he said unto them, Full well ye reject the commandment of God, that ye may keep your own tradition.

My witness to the fifty churches found that they all honor God with their lips with no works of Love.

Matthew 15:8-9 - This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their heart is far from me. But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.

Called to Serve is about doing works and serving others. Serving your neighbor in a manner that is pleasing to God. You know and are happy to do works. These are the works that are pleasing to God. These are not the works of religion.

John 13:14-17 - If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet. For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you. Verily, verily, I say unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord; neither he that is sent greater than he that sent him. If ye know these things, happy are ye if ye do them.

The worship of sin and the continual memory thereof with blood sacrifice is finished. Fear God and turn from your sinful life.

Romans 3:10-19 - As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one: There is none that understandeth, there is none that seeketh after God. They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, no, not one. Their throat is an open sepulchre; with their tongues they have used deceit; the poison of asps is under their lips: Whose mouth is full of cursing and bitterness:] Their feet are swift to shed blood: Destruction and misery are in their ways: And the way of peace have they not known: There is no fear of God before their eyes. Now we know that what things soever the law saith, it saith to them who are under the law: that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God.

Matthew 7:26-27 - And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand: And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it.

All that matters now is your faith and works that are pleasing to God.

John 19:30 - When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, It is finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.

1 Peter 3:10-12,15,17 - For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile: Let him eschew evil, and do good; let him seek peace, and ensue it. For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and his ears are open unto their prayers: but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil. But sanctify the Lord God in

your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear: For it is better, if the will of God be so, that ye suffer for well doing, than for evil doing.

2 Peter 3:3-4,13-14 - Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts, And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation. Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness. Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in peace, without spot, and blameless.

Hebrews 13:15 - By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name.

Being Called to Serve, endure to the end, follow God's gospel of Love and God's gift of everlasting life will be waiting.

Matthew 10:22 - And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that endureth to the end shall be saved.

Matthew 24:13 - But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.

Mark 13:13 - And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.

John 6:27 - Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath God the Father sealed.

John 5:34 - But I receive not testimony from man: but these things I say, that ye might be saved.

May your heart be stabilized by the truth in God's word and your works of love, pleasing him. May the world be saved by living God's gospel of Love brought to the earth through the prophets.

John 3:17 - For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 26: Anointed

When you endure a righteous walk in the presence of God and defend his word, you will be anointed. Only God the Father knows when that anointing occurs. Every good and perfect gift is from above.

James 1:16-17 - Do not err, my beloved brethren. Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

Your life will proceed as normal and no one knows when that anointing from God above will occur. I'm not talking about some oil on a thumb rub to your forehead act of man anointing. I'm talking about that anointing from above that changes your life and walk with God.

John 3:7-8- Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again. The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

Acts 1:7-8 - And he said unto them, It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath put in his own power. But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

That walk will most likely not be easy, for you glory in tribulations knowing that God has your back.

Romans 5:3-5 - And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; And patience, experience; and experience, hope: And hope maketh not

ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.

I look back on that day on 9/4/21 being totally in distress when I defended God's word and God texted me "Romans 8:28."

Romans 8:28 - And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

Despite the outcome of what could happen, I immediately sent a message to the pastors and jail ministry team telling them not to send anyone else to the jail and tell the inmates that they are saved with the gift of everlasting life and can never lose it, after a brief 4 verse repeat after me exercise with the inmates. Those three pastors had over 150 years pastoral experience. Within three days, that jail ministry was God's! I look back on that day and glory in the tribulation I went through, knowing that the outcome was already planned by God. He just needed me to trust him. From that day forward, I knew the truth in God's message of salvation was not a four verse repeat after me promise from man.

1 John 2:27 - But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.

During the next two years of jail lessons and seeking the truth in God's word, God had made it clear to me that out of the mouth of two or three witnesses you will know the truth. Twelve times in the bible God tells you how to understand the truth in his word. (See Deuteronomy 17:6; Deuteronomy 19:15; 1 Kings 21:10; 1 Kings 21:13; Matthew 18:16; John 8:17-18; 1 Corinthians 14:29; 2 Corinthians 13:1; Hebrews 6:18; Hebrews

10:28; 1 Timothy 5:19; Revelations 11:3) *God was with me and continued to send me verse after verse to understand his word.*

1 Timothy 5:19 - Against an elder receive not an accusation, but before two or three witnesses.

*Ironic as it may seem, the first lesson that used the preponderance of evidence standard from the mouth of two or three witnesses was Bible Matter 228: Salvation POE. This lesson was published in my sixth gospel book, “**New Beginning**” as a sunrise over Zoar. Like Lot, you are to turn from your city of sin. Six is the number of man. This was man’s new beginning in understanding the truth in God’s doctrine of love brought to the earth by the prophet and Son of God, known as Jesus. God’s salvation message out of the mouth of all eight witnesses is clear. There is but one God, God the Father. Believe in the message that Jesus brought to the earth. Repent of your sins and be converted and born again as a child of God. Live a righteous life by doing the will of God serving him and your neighbor. Do not abide in sin and darkness. Religious acts are not required for God’s gift. Judge no one and keep true to God’s word. God is not looking for Sunday only worship. He is not looking for your money or tithes. God wants your heart. Keep yourself in the love of God by sharing the truth in his word. Show your faith by your works. Do this seven days a week. Endure to the end with the promise of everlasting life in heaven. You will be judged by God.*

To be anointed, God is looking for your whole heart. He is looking for your will to serve him and your neighbor.

Jeremiah 24:7 - And I will give them an heart to know me, that I am the Lord : and they shall be my people, and I will be their God: for they shall return unto me with their whole heart.

When you are anointed, you do what is right in the sight of the Lord. Mary Magdalene knew it was the right thing to do to anoint the body of Jesus on the third day. She was not afraid of those that murdered Jesus. Jesus appeared first to Mary Magdalene. She returned and reported that Jesus was alive and the disciples believed not. Mary was not upset that they did not believe. She saw Jesus and she believed. If after you have read this book and you do not believe, then I will not be upset. I know that God has sent me witness after witness and texted me several times, all in support of this ministry. I believe in God, I know God is real and God just wants you to believe. I can't make you believe, as that is a choice you have to make.

Mark 16:1,9,11 - And when the sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James, and Salome, had bought sweet spices, that they might come and anoint him. Now when Jesus was risen early the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast seven devils. And they, when they had heard that he was alive, and had been seen of her, believed not.

You are anointed by God the Father.

2 Corinthians 1:20-21 - For all the promises of God in him are yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us. Now he which stablisheth us with you in Christ, and hath anointed us, is God;

The love of neighbor is what God is looking for. Anointing is an act of love. God is looking for you to live his gospel of Love seven days a week, period. He is looking for your love without fear. Mary Magdalene was a great servant that had her sins forgiven. She served when others feared for their life. She was anointed by the Holy Ghost to serve in God's kingdom.

Luke 7:44-47,50 - And he turned to the woman, and said unto Simon, Seest thou this woman? I entered into thine house,

thou gavest me no water for my feet: but she hath washed my feet with tears, and wiped them with the hairs of her head. Thou gavest me no kiss: but this woman since the time I came in hath not ceased to kiss my feet. My head with oil thou didst not anoint: but this woman hath anointed my feet with ointment. Wherefore I say unto thee, Her sins, which are many, are forgiven; for she loved much: but to whom little is forgiven, the same loveth little. And he said to the woman, Thy faith hath saved thee; go in peace.

God is looking for you to do good and spread the truth in his word. He is looking for you to do your best. He is not looking for you money. He is looking for you to love all children of God.

Acts 10:38 - How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

God is telling you that your eyes and heart will be opened to the truth in his word, when you do as taught by his word. You do when you believe. This blind man believed and with mud on his eyes made his way to the pool of Siloam where his eyes were open. His do was the walk to Siloam.

John 9:6-7,11 - When he had thus spoken, he spat on the ground, and made clay of the spittle, and he anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay, And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, (which is by interpretation, Sent. He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing. He answered and said, A man that is called Jesus made clay, and anointed mine eyes, and said unto me, Go to the pool of Siloam, and wash: and I went and washed, and I received sight.

When you believe, God is looking for your do. Your do of showing your love of God by repenting and turning from sin and loving your neighbor. God will have your back.

Chapter 27: God Delivers

God the creator of all that you see and don't see has the power to deliver you from darkness. Right now, God may be working in your life and you may not even realize it. God protected his believers and kept them from harm. God was looking for their service and needed them to be at their best.

Daniel 6:16 - Then the king commanded, and they brought Daniel, and cast him into the den of lions. Now the king spake and said unto Daniel, Thy God whom thou servest continually, he will deliver thee.

I met the supervisor of a hotel in Washington DC, Mohamed K., of whom God delivered. He had crashed his vehicle into a brick wall on a dark evening. His neighbor took him home. In the morning Mohamed went to the crash site and his car was still there. It was not clear where the blood came from on the seat, as Mohamed had no cuts or scratches. Mohamed will deliver a copy of the book, One World Church, to his sister, which is a pastor.

After coming home from that trip, I had heard the dehumidifier making an awful noise from the top of the basement steps. God worked a miracle in my life with the “once noisy” dehumidifier. God is working in your life and performing miracle after miracle and you can thank God for those miracles and serve him or ignore God and think you are just a lucky soul.

I look back on my life and I can recall those supernatural experiences where God protected me.

In my early teen years, I flipped over the handle bars of my bicycle, shirtless going 20 mph, landed on the sidewalk and stood up without a scratch.

Early in my career, I designed a compound planetary transmission where the selection of the number of teeth in the pinion and planet gear had to comply with a formula to allow the gear to be assembled. Instead of timing onto the sun gear per the formula, timing the planets allowed for assembly. There was no other combination of gear teeth where this timing would work!

One week prior to COVID, a detailed investigation of an aircraft actuator issue in Spain was troubleshoot and just prior to giving up, we inspected the tubing assembly to the actuator. A cut O-ring was found that with the correct assembly procedure

resolved a long-standing actuator deployment issue. On that trip I had witnessed to over one hundred individuals with the word of God. God delivered a fix. I got home from that trip, several days before the air traffic was shut down due to COVID.

When that statin I was taking was impacting both my memory and physical health, I prayed to God for guidance. God woke me in a dream, told me to stop taking the statin and sent me an article on natural remedies to take. As a result, my memory and physical health have never been better. Three years on this natural remedy and the body aches are gone, the memory is strong and the heart is strong. By faith you must believe that God will guide and care for you like Moses.

When I received the text message on my phone, “Ecclesiastes” and “Romans 8:28”, there was no doubt in my mind that God delivered those messages.

*Those three witnesses that consecutively picked the book, “**Power of God**” out of four books, sight unseen was a message God delivered*

Those three witnesses, of which two went to heaven and returned to tell of God’s power and the one witness lost in sin thinking he has been saved by baptism was a message God delivered.

God gospel of Love was brought to the earth by Jesus with the truth in God’s word delivered out of the mouth of two or three witnesses was delivered by God. As Moses found out with the witness of Caleb and Joshua, all that matters is the witnesses.

The cancelled trip to Taiwan and rescheduled trip to North Carolina where I spent three hours with an Islam man comparing the similarities between the gospel of Love brought by Jesus to the gospel of Love brought by Muhammed was a message delivered by God.

The message to me in a dream on “Ecclesiastes 4:12-15” was delivered by God. My witness to the fifty plus churches was terminated and God churches, Church of Nineveh and then the One World Church, were created. The doctrine for these churches is established out of the mouth of two or three witness, with the belief in God wanting you to live the gospel of Love were launched.

*Without God working in my life, the dreams, the bible verses, the witnesses, the bible matters and the published books from the jail ministry would not have been possible. The doctrine established out of the mouth of two or three witnesses, with lessons first appearing in his sixth book title, “**New Beginning**,” with a photo of the sunrise over Zoar were delivered by God.*

*God’s twelfth book will be published during my twelfth year of walking with the Lord God. I thank God, every day and look for ways to serve and witness for him daily! I’m looking forward to publishing his twelfth, “**God Is King**.”*

My favorite sports jersey number was twelve.

The bible number for twelve is one of government perfection and divine authority.

Twelve times in the bible God tells you that out of the mouth of two or three witnesses, you shall know the truth. God’s divine authority is established out of the mouth of the witnesses and prophets.

The twelfth time Jesus is mentioned in the Matthew, Jesus delivers this message. Jesus told the devil that one should only worship the Lord thy God. You are not to worship man. You are not to worship a church. How you live your life seven days a week gives worship to the Lord thy God.
