Preface

They may have the lost perform an act satisfying a tradition of human with a promise eternal life. A man-made message of salvation without repentance of sin and living an unrighteous life is denying God's doctrine of salvation in the New Testament. Thus, perverting God's, day of judgment for those that walk with the devil. No man can play God and deceive God's children with a man-made message of salvation from God's word. Who so ever pulls God's gift of everlasting life out of the bosom of Abraham (i.e. Old Testament heaven) with a false message of salvation for the unrighteous is despicable in the eyes of God. This man is void of wisdom. The eyes of the fool, leads to death. God sent me this verse at Stonelick Lake where God talks to me after my jail ministry.

Proverbs 17:23-24 - A wicked man taketh a gift out of the bosom to pervert the ways of judgment. Wisdom is before him that hath understanding; but the eyes of a fool are in the ends of the earth.

As a servant to God, I pray that you seek wisdom in God's word. You will be able to identify false prophets by understanding God's word in truth. Use the testimony of two or three witnesses as told to you by God. Seek and live a righteous life and then shall the end come.

Matthew 24:11-14 - And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many. And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold. But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved. And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

The Christian bible New Testament is the compiled transcripts of eight witnesses that either walked with Jesus, were brothers of or recruited by him. Seven times, these witnesses state to use two or three witnesses to establish the truth in God's word. God's word is presented in the contract given in the New Testament for the Jew and Gentile. You must use this contract to establish the basics of your belief in God. It is clear that God wanted you to use his word from the mouth of two or three witnesses to gain wisdom. God wants you to study his word to grow in grace, knowledge and righteousness using the example of Jesus. The scripture is not open to private interpretation. A deceiver can't use God's words to impose their own interpretation of the verse for false doctrine, to control man or introduce a religious law or belief that God supposedly wants you to follow. The preponderance of evidence standard must be used to study and establish your life with God. Use all eight witnesses, to establish God's doctrine.

Anyone who doesn't believe in the religion of another's choice and commits violent acts against others is considered an infidel. Infidels have been around since the beginning of man. God was clear when he sent Jesus to present his gospel of love. Jesus told his disciples that if someone doesn't receive you then move on. Three witnesses have given you this testimony. Eleven times in the Christian bible, God says that out of the mouth of two or three witnesses, you shall know the truth.

Matthew 10:14 - And whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear your words, when ye depart out of that house or city, shake off the dust of your feet.

Luke 9:5 - And whosoever will not receive you, when ye go out of that city, shake off the very dust from your feet for a testimony against them.

Mark 6:11 - And whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear you, when ye depart thence, shake off the dust under your feet for a testimony against them. Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrha in the day of judgment, than for that city.

Jesus didn't say, that whosoever doesn't receive you, then murder them! Time and time again, you have seen this murderous behavior coming out of infidels. Jesus was clear when he said that he didn't come to judge the world, but to save the world.

John 12:47 - And if any man hear my words, and believe not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world.

John 3:17 - For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.

Paul says that you may not necessarily understand the civilizations framed by the word of God. You will not totally understand what you see. The fashion of this world will pass away.

Hebrews 11:3 - Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

1 Corinthians 7:29-31 - But this I say, brethren, the time is short: it remaineth, that both they that have wives be as though they had none; And they that weep, as though they wept not; and they that rejoice, as though they rejoiced not; and they that buy, as though they possessed not; And they that use this world, as not abusing it : for the fashion of this world passeth away.

God told Cain to be his best as the alternative is sin. You know that Cain went onto kill his brother.

Genesis 4:6-8 - And the Lord said unto Cain, Why art thou wroth? and why is thy countenance fallen? If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? and if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee shall be his desire, and thou shalt rule over him. And Cain talked with Abel his brother: and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him.

Likewise, Paul tells the Corinthians that when they sin against the brethren, they sin against Christ.

1 Corinthians 8:12 - But when ye sin so against the brethren, and wound their weak conscience, ye sin against Christ.

2 Corinthians 1:12 - For our rejoicing is this, the testimony of our conscience, that in simplicity and godly sincerity, not with fleshly wisdom, but by the grace of God, we have had our conversation in the world, and more abundantly to you-ward.

As a believer in God, you are to be blameless and harmless and to shine as the light of the world.

Philippians 2:15 - That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world;

An infidel takes on the responsibility of judge and jury when they take on the responsibility of not accepting the religious opinion of another. The Jews worshipped God, the creator of the heaven and earth. God sent Jesus to present his gospel of Love. The Jews were looking for a worldly King. The message Jesus brought was not of a worldly king and to worship the things of the flesh. Love of God and love of others is more pleasing in the eyes of God than the love of money and works of religion. Both Jesus and the Jews worshipped the same God, knowing God's commandment of thou shall not kill and yet the Jews had

Jesus crucified for his message. These Jewish leaders that championed the crucifixion of Jesus could be considered infidels.

Jesus's message was simple. Believe in God as the creator of heaven and earth as one God. Repent of your sins and follow his commandments as a light of the world, loving God and loving your neighbor. Not for the love of money or sins of the flesh, but by living a righteous life pleasing to God. Take up your cross and using the skills God has given you, follow the teachings of Jesus, to do good and to be the best you can be. Share his gospel, endure to the end and look forward to being with God in heaven.

1 Peter 1:21-22 - Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God. Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:

1 John 3:18 - My little children, let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in truth.

Romans 13:10 - Love worketh no ill to his neighbor: therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.

James 2:8 - If ye fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself, ye do well:

After Jesus trained and sent his Apostles unto the world, it was clear that selecting Paul the Pharisee and a Roman, that God knew the Apostles needed help to carry his gospel of Love to the Romans. The Romans ruled the area known as Europe and his gospel of Love was needed there. Ignorance of God's gospel of

Love, has led to many infidels being created by the misunderstanding of this gospel.

Years ago, I had read a documentary on the Cathars in Southern France. The Cathars mounted the first major rebellion against the Catholic Church. They saw Rome as corrupt, rejected the church's hierarchy, and did not build cathedrals, but rather worshiped outdoors. This lack of structure gave women more prominence and freedom, and because they were pacifists who repudiated all killing, they were vegetarians. Much about the history of 12th and 13th century France may today be fuzzy. But there is no dispute that in 1209, at the urging of Pope Innocent III, a band of northern French nobles rallied an army that swept into the south, where they unleashed a crusade so bloody it would make "Game of Thrones" look tame by comparison. This included the sacking of Beziers in July 1209 by an army under papal authority. Just before the attack, which would kill as many as 20,000 men, women and children, the pope's man on the scene, Arnaud Amalric, is reported to have uttered one of history's most famous orders: "Kill them all. God will know his own."

These crusaders were not living God's gospel of Love. Crusades were held throughout this time frame against Catharism, anti-Christians, Muslims and Catholics. Spanish Christian Crusades against the Muslims and the Inca Indians were but a few. As recent as the 20th century there was killing in Ireland between the Catholics and the Protestants and killing throughout the middle East between Christians and Muslims. Infidels abound with no love for God and neighbor. All the while denying God's commandment of "thou shalt not kill."

In the seventh century AD, the Islamic prophet, Muhammad, was sent by Allah (ie. God) for the salvation of Arabia. The Arabic term Islam means surrender to the will of Allah. Allah is

viewed as the sole God – creator, sustainer and restorer of the world. In Islam, Muhammad’s message in the Koran, consummates and completes the “revelations” attributed to the earlier prophets. A true Muslim man is just, kind, compassionate, forgiving, responsible, hard-working, humble, patient, forbearing, truthful, trustworthy, courageous, soft-hearted, honoring women, controlling his lower desires and impulses, fulfilling the needs of others before himself, continually refining his intellect, improving his character, seeking knowledge as a life-long learner, avoiding undignified behavior and sinful deeds, and emulating the character of the Prophet and his righteous followers to the best of their ability.

Hindus worship Brahman (i.e. God) or the Supreme Being. Brahman is beyond human understanding. However, Hindus try to explain Brahman through understanding the Hindu scriptures. Hindus believe that an enlightened master, or satguru, is essential to know the Transcendent Absolute, as are personal discipline, good conduct, purification, pilgrimage, self-inquiry, meditation and surrender to Brahman. Hindus believe that all life is sacred, to be loved and revered, and therefore practice ahimsa, noninjury, in thought, word and deed. Hindus believe in karma, the law of cause and effect by which each individual creates his own destiny by his thoughts, words and deeds. Hindus believe that no religion teaches the only way to salvation above all others, but that all genuine paths are facets of Brahman’s Light, deserving tolerance and understanding.

It seems that God’s message to believers of Christianity, Islam, and Hinduism are all similar. One is to surrender to God, turn from your sinful deeds and live a life that gives glory to God. One is to live God’s gospel of Love. Love for God and neighbor with tolerance and understanding. Judge no one, respect everyone, endure to the end and you will stand before God for judgement. Your belief in a particular prophet or attend a

specific church means nothing in the eyes of God unless you are to emulate your life based on the life of righteousness in which these prophets lived. God will judge you based on your adherence to his gospel of Love. There are to be no infidels. One thing for sure is that the lovers of God shall not attack each other. Man, judges after the flesh. God does not judge by the flesh. God will judge in the spirit of the heart and love.

John 8:15 - Ye judge after the flesh; I judge no man.

1 Peter 4:6 - For this cause was the gospel preached also to them that are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the spirit.

God's gospel of love is simple. One thing for sure is that God will absolutely know his own. Do not be offended by the truth in God's word. In this year of 2025, plan on living in the spirit and to live together as Godly people, doing the will of God and serving him! To spread God's gospel of Love.

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To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 1: Introduction

For anyone that is a parent, brother or sister you'll recognize that all members of a family are not made with the same level of empathy and love towards others. Everyone is different. Some will drop everything and jump right in to help others in need. Some will hoard money, while others will share freely. Some will care about others with an open heart, while others turn and walk away. Jesus told you exactly how people will behave. In this following parable, the certain man had to be a Jew traveling from the Jewish towns of Jerusalem to Jericho. After being robbed, a Jewish priest and a Jewish Levite passed by the man which was beaten half dead and laying on the street. A Samaritan, with love in his heart, dressed the man's wounds and then transported him to an inn to be cared for. He paid for the man's room and board at the inn.

Luke 10:30-36 - And Jesus answering said, A certain man went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves, which stripped him of his raiment, and wounded him, and departed, leaving him half dead. And by chance there came down a certain priest that way: and when he saw him, he passed by on the other side. And likewise a Levite, when he was at the place, came and looked on him, and passed by on the other side. But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was: and when he saw him, he had compassion on him, And went to him, and bound up his wounds, pouring in oil and wine, and set him on his own beast, and brought him to an inn, and took care of him. And on the morrow when he departed, he took out two pence, and gave them to the host, and said unto him, Take care of him; and whatsoever thou spendest more, when I come again, I will repay thee. Which now of these three, thinkest thou, was neighbour unto him that fell among the thieves?

In this parable, the priest and the Levite were the elite of the Jewish religion. They walked right past the injured Jew. It was a Samaritan that helped a Jew. In that culture, the Samaritans were half Jew and half Gentile. They were considered outcasts and the Jews wanted nothing to do with the Samaritans. Yet, it was a Samaritan that was full of love. Love that was made available to those that hate you. In this parable, who did the will of God? When God said love your neighbor, it goes beyond loving only those that look like you or who you associate with. Ironically, I went to a church service several months ago and the lector was teaching on helping your neighbors. He identified your neighbors as those that believe like you do! Exactly the opposite message from the word of God.

Out of the mouth of two or three witnesses, God's commandments are clear.

- 1) Love God with all your heart, mind, soul and strength.*
- 2) Love your neighbor as yourself.*

Luke 10:27-28 - And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself. And he said unto him, Thou hast answered right: this do, and thou shalt live.

All the other commandments from God are based on these two commandments. If you can do this, then thou shalt live. If man can follow these commandments, then the world shall be saved.

John 3:17 - For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.

God knew that the sons of Noah were not spiritually the same. Some descendants were spiritually strong, full of love and saw

God reflected in their daily lives. They lived in harmony and peace with the God of the earth. They loved God, loved the earth and loved each other. God did not have to worry about these spiritually strong individuals destroying the earth and mankind. These spiritually strong neighbors got along and occasionally had to defend themselves from the spiritually lost. These spiritually strong individuals are not spiritually lost. They are doing as commanded by the Lord God and Creator of heaven and earth.

God messages for mankind are sent by multiple prophets. God sends prophets where needed.

- 1) For Nineveh living in sin, God sent Jonah to teach them to repent and turn to God. God would judge them if they did not turn. They put on sackcloth and turned to God. God saw their works! God made them a great city.*

Jonah 3:10 - And God saw their works, that they turned from their evil way; and God repented of the evil, that he had said that he would do unto them; and he did it not.

- 2) God immediately saw the Israelites turn from him and worshipped the golden calf when Moses was collecting the ten commandments on Mt. Sinai. Works of animal sacrifice and cleansing of their sins with the spreading of blood on the altar. In all these works of religion, the Jews may not have experienced a change of heart toward God and fellow man. God sent Jesus Christ, to teach the gospel and for the people to do the will of God. When you hear and keep the sayings of God, you shall never see death. Jesus told you to repent and turn from your sin. To purify your heart by obeying the truth through the Spirit and love one another. To be converted from a child of the devil and to be born again as a child of God. To love God and your neighbor. To follow the gospel of God. To*

be willing to share God word. Not for lucre but out of a ready mind. God sees the heart and he will be the judge.

John 8:47,51 - He that is of God heareth God's words: ye therefore hear them not, because ye are not of God. Verily, verily, I say unto you, If a man keep my saying, he shall never see death.

1 Peter 1:22 - Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:

1 Peter 4:17 - For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?

1 Peter 5:2,8 - Feed the flock of God which is among you, taking the oversight thereof, not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind; Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:

3) *You know that the twelve apostles were equipped to preach the gospel to the Jews and Gentiles. God's gospel message was clear through Jesus and yet he was ignored. Eleven times, God said in the bible that out of the mouth of two or three witnesses, you shall know the truth. I do not serve an arrogant God, but a loving and understanding God. God knows the hearts of man. God then recruited Paul to bring God's gospel message to the Gentiles. Paul was a Roman as well as a Jew.*

4) *God knew that the Arabs were not going to worship God, brought to them out of the mouth of a Jew. God sent Muhammed to bring God's gospel message to the Arabs. Mohammed's gospel message brought worship and glory to the God, as the creator of the heavens and earth. In the seventh century AD, The Islamic prophet, Muhammad, was*

sent for the unification of Arabia. The Arabic term Islam means surrender to the will of Allah (God.) Allah is viewed as the sole God – creator, sustainer and restorer of the world. In Islam, Muhammad is considered the last of the series of prophets and his message in the Koran, consummates and completes the “revelations” attributed to the earlier prophets. A true Muslim man is just, kind, compassionate, forgiving, responsible, hard-working, humble, patient, forbearing, truthful, trustworthy, courageous, soft-hearted, honoring women, controlling his lower desires and impulses, fulfilling the needs of others before himself, continually refining his intellect, improving his character, seeking knowledge as a life-long learner, avoiding undignified behavior and sinful deeds, and emulating the character of the Prophet and his righteous followers to the best of his ability.

From 2), 3) and 4) above, you recognize that a true follower of God’s message brought by both Jesus and Muhammed is to live a righteous life in the love of God and neighbor. In God’s eyes, there is no difference.

On Saturday, 11/9/24, after a visit with a Christian friend, I visited Stonelick Lake. Stonelick Lake is where God gave me verse after verse on Saturdays, after the jail ministry, which has led to the doctrine based on the truth in God’s word out of the mouth of two or three witnesses.

After a period of prayer and meditation, God gave me Daniel 12:3

Daniel 12:3 - And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever.

What is 11/9/24 in Bible numbers:

11 - incompleteness, disorder, imperfection

9 - visitation

24 - priesthood

In the year, "24", of priesthood, God has visited us and is asking you to shine as the brightness on the firmament. He has a job for you. "To love him and to be his witness and bring others into his church of love, turning them unto righteousness."

Why incomplete? "11"

God has sent prophet after prophet with a message of believe, change, love and live a life unto righteousness. Simple enough, but man has turned each one of these prophet's messages into self-serving doctrine with a message of self-righteousness. Unless you believe like they believe, then you are going to hell. Man has turned God's word into hate and wars. The truth in God's word is not about worshipping the creature, but worshipping the creator.

Romans 1:25 - Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen.

Man has been ignorant to God's word.

Today, that changes. 11/10/24 launches the One World Church which follows God divine order.

10 – Divine Order, Law

In the One World Church, we recognize the divine order that God has given to man. We recognize that God sends prophets to spread his message of love and his Gospel to the lost. To teach the lost of sin and that after turning from sin, you are to live a righteous life by doing the will of God. To seek knowledge and to serve God by serving others. To be respectful of all and love

others as you love yourself. We are not ashamed to call on God, the creator of heaven and earth. With a heart turned from stone and with the spirit within, to do the will of God.

Ezekiel 36:26-27 - A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh. And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do them.

To live according to the royal law of love.

James 2:8 - If ye fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself, ye do well:

In the One World Church, we judge no one. We know that we will be judged by God. We worship God as the creator and not his creations. Regardless if you identify as Hindu, Christian, Islam or other, God will know if you love him and served others from the heart. The Inca Indians were living the will of God and religious men full of love for filthy lucre and false doctrine wiped out the Inca Indians in forty years. Do not worry how someone else may be serving God and ask yourself, if you are doing the will of God from the heart. God will know if you are ashamed of his gospel or if you trusted him and shared his word openly by your actions, words and acts of charity. Our God, is the God of love and not a God of hate. If you claim to be part of any religious denomination and you practice hate, sin, murder or think that only you are the only ones going to heaven, then you have misunderstood the truth in God's word.

Chapter 2: Great Flood

Scholars, men of the flesh and the devil wants you to believe that the great flood reported in the Bible and Quran (Noah's Ark) and the Hindu version of Noah named Manu are all but a myth. The migration of the three sons have been documented by looking at the male "Y" Chromosome from different parts of the world. The three witnesses reporting the global flood are consistent. God said in the bible that out of the mouth of two or three witnesses, you shall know the truth. In the 1980's Ron Wyatt prayed to God to help him prove the bible real. God is telling you to believe.

From the migration of Shem's descendants to the formation of Judaism, Buddhism, Christianity, Islam and Hinduism, it is apparent that Shem loved his dad and the things of God. Shem made sure he did all that Noah asked of him. Shem recognized righteousness and feared God. Shem loved God and is descendants knew it! Shem's descendants made sure that they documented the great flood as a sign of God's love for the righteousness of Noah and the God's dissatisfaction for the sins of man.

The creation of the atomic bomb and weapons of mass destruction came from the descendants of Japeth. God knew that the descendants of Japeth were going to be trouble. They were the intellectual type that loved money, sin and themselves.

The descendants of Ham, could easily be persuaded to the things of the flesh or the things of God. The genocide going on in Africa

today, is a reflection of the lack of God's spiritual guidance and no love of neighbor.

It is clear that God hates the arrogance of man. Any man that seems to be wise and to believe that he can out smart God is but a fool.

1 Corinthians 3:18-19 - Let no man deceive himself. If any man among you seemeth to be wise in this world, let him become a fool, that he may be wise. For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, He taketh the wise in their own craftiness.

Why the flood story of Noah is similar to the Hindu flood legend of Manu.

In the flood story of Noah, as recorded in the Old Testament (Genesis 6-9), God is saddened by seeing all the evil that has entered man's heart, and decides to destroy all life on Earth. Noah is chosen and instructed to build an ark. When completed, Noah, his family, and pairs of all animals are called upon to enter the ark. God makes it rain for 40 days and 40 nights, when all life outside of the ark perishes. After 150 days, the ark comes to rest on the mountains of Ararat. As the waters recede, all those aboard the ark disembark and have God's promise that he will never judge the Earth with a flood again. He gives the rainbow as the sign of this promise.

One of the oldest and most fascinating accounts originates in ancient Indian mythology. The Hindu version of Noah is named Manu. According to the texts Matsya Purana and Shatapatha Brahmana, Manu was warned by Matsya or Fish avatar, the first incarnation of God Vishnu, of the impending Great Flood that would destroy all life. Manu therefore built a boat which Matsya towed to a mountaintop when the flood came, and

thus he survived along with seven sages and some 'seeds of life' to re-establish life on Earth.

Despite discrepancies, this Hindu flood myth does bear striking similarity to the flood story of Noah as narrated in the Bible and the Quran.

Like Noah, Manu is also described as a virtuous individual and a chosen one. As the Satapatha Brahmana reports: "There lived in ancient time a holy man / Called Manu, who, by penances and prayers, / Had won the favor of the lord of heaven."

Manu was said to have three sons before the Flood – Charma, Sharma, and Yapeti, with startling similarity with the names of Noah's three sons – Ham, Shem, and Japheth.

Like Noah, Manu is also asked by God to 'build a strong ark' to protect life and good people from the Flood. However, in the story of Manu, the destruction of the world is treated as part of the natural order of things, rather than as a divine punishment.

Like Noah, Manu is also asked to fill the ark with 'seeds of all things' and 'pair of each animal' so to continue life on Earth.

After the flood, Noah's Ark is said to have rested on mountains of Ararat. Similarly, Manu's boat was described as being perched on the top of a range of mountains (the Malaya Mountains in this case) when the waters had subsided.

Both Noah and Manu were then said to repopulate the Earth, and all human beings could trace their ancestry to either one of these flood survivors.

It is clear from these events recorded in history that God loved man, so much so, that he planned eternal life for those that loved him and lived a life unto righteousness.

Titus 1:2 - In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie,
promised before the world began;

The only hope for man on this earth, was a doctrine of love for God and love of each other. The descendants of Shem took the lesson of the great flood and created the Hindu religion of love. To turn the descendants of Ham and Japeth from sin unto living a life of righteousness was brought by the prophets Jonah, Jesus, Paul and Muhammed. It is clear from these witnesses that God wants man to live in peace and love. On judgement day, God will judge your righteousness here on earth. He will know if you loved him by the life you've lived giving God the glory and that you loved and respected your neighbor. Not by loving those that looks like you, but by loving and serving those that are lost and in need. To share the word of God and his blessings.

This April 2025, we celebrated the one-year anniversary of God's church born on 4/8/2024. The truth in God's word from the mouth of two or three witnesses is used to establish God's doctrine of love brought to this earth by the prophets. These preponderance of evidence messages from the mouth of two or three witnesses are used to establish the doctrine of love brought to the earth by Jesus as presented in the Christian church, "Church of Nineveh".

God's messages of love from the churches of Islam, Hindu and the Church of Nineveh are then presented in the church, "One World Church."

This April 2025 is the start of my eighth year in the jail ministry, or in bible numbers, New Beginnings. This ministry will use God's doctrine of love using the teachings of Jesus. To teach the lost of God's doctrine of turning from darkness to the light.

Chapter 3: Noah the Prophet

You've heard the story of Noah's ark a hundred times. You may have just considered it a bible story, used to wow the little children. Not once did you think of Noah being a prophet. Noah lived a righteous life in the midst of wickedness that covered the earth. It repented the Lord God, that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart.

Genesis 6:5-6,22- And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. And it repented the Lord that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart. Thus did Noah; according to all that God commanded him, so did he.

In the midst of this wickedness was one man that feared God. When you recognize the power of God and fear him, only then will you find grace in the eyes of God, like Noah did.

Genesis 6:8,9,10 - But Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord. These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God. And Noah begat three sons, Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

God's message is sent to those that fear God.

Proverbs 1:7 - The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.

Acts 10:34-35 - Then Peter opened his mouth, and said, Of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons: But in every nation he that feareth him, and worketh righteousness, is accepted with him.

Acts 13:26 - Men and brethren, children of the stock of Abraham, and whosoever among you feareth God, to you is the word of this salvation sent.

At 500 years old, God gave Noah the directions to build an ark of gopher wood to save the things of this earth. Noah could have chosen great riches, silver and gold, but he didn't.

Proverbs 22:1 - A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches, and loving favor rather than silver and gold.

God spoke to Noah and Noah did as God commanded. It took 100 years to build the ark.

Genesis 7:6-7 – And Noah was six hundred years old when the flood of waters was upon the earth. And Noah went in, and his sons, and his wife, and his sons' wives with him, into the ark, because of the waters of the flood.

Noah and his family spent over a year in the ark under God's guidance. They knew the power of God. After seeing all of man wiped out by the flood, they would have feared God. They worshipped God! They knew how to serve God, by doing his will.

Genesis 8:13,15-16,20 - And it came to pass in the six hundredth and first year, in the first month, the first day of the month, the waters were dried up from off the earth: and Noah removed the covering of the ark, and looked, and, behold, the face of the ground was dry. And God spake unto Noah, saying, Go forth of the ark, thou, and thy wife, and thy sons, and thy sons' wives with thee. And Noah builded an altar unto the Lord ; and took of every clean beast, and of every clean fowl, and offered burnt offerings on the altar.

God blessed Noah and his sons. The rainbow was given in remembrance of God's covenant with mankind.

Genesis 9:1,8-9,12-16 - And God blessed Noah and his sons, and said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth. And God spake unto Noah, and to his sons with him, saying, And I, behold, I establish my covenant with you, and with your seed after you; And God said, This is the token of the covenant which I make between me and you and every living creature that is with you, for perpetual generations: I do set my bow in the cloud, and it shall be for a token of a covenant between me and the earth. And it shall come to pass, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that the bow shall be seen in the cloud: And I will remember my covenant, which is between me and you and every living creature of all flesh; and the waters shall no more become a flood to destroy all flesh. And the bow shall be in the cloud; and I will look upon it, that I may remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living creature of all flesh that is upon the earth.

The righteousness of Noah shined forth. God was looking for his sons to remember his power and to fear God. They knew of the wickedness that offended God. They knew of their father's righteousness that pleased God. All God was looking for was for the earth to be populated with the knowledge of God, of his power and for man to do as commanded by God.

2 Peter 2:5 - And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly;

The three sons had different ideas, different desires and different levels of fear. God told them to remember him by the rainbow. These sons were trained by Noah the prophet. He guided them on how to live a righteous life pleasing to God.

The Sons of Noah – Migrated in different directions:

Japheth - Europe

Shem -Asia

Ham -Africa

Japheth and his descendants, after the flood, are believed to have migrated to areas around the Black and Caspian Seas, Asia Minor, and the Greek islands (Aegean Sea Region). They are also thought to have settled in the islands of Cyprus, Crete and Rhodes. Now they were the grandchildren of Noah, in honor of whom names were imposed on the nations by those that first seized upon them. Japhet, the son of Noah, had seven sons: they inhabited so, that, beginning at the mountains Taurus and Amanus, they proceeded along Asia, as far as the river Tansis, and along Europe to Cadiz; and settling themselves on the lands which they light upon, which none had inhabited before.

Shem and his descendants, after the deluge, are believed to have migrated in areas on either side of the mighty Euphrates River and in the Arabian Peninsula. They also reached a section of Western Asia Minor and, according to Josephus, as far East as the Indian Ocean. Shem's progeny gave rise to the Persians, Assyrians, Chaldeans (Babylonians), Syrians, Lydians and others.

The children of Ham possessed the land from Syria and Amanus, and the mountains of Libanus; seizing upon all that was on its sea-coasts, and as far as the ocean, and keeping it as their own. The children of Ham possessed the land from Syria and Amanus, and the mountains of Libanus; seizing upon all that was on its sea-coasts, and as far as the ocean, and keeping it as their own. The descendants of Ham also populated many parts of northern and eastern Africa, including Egypt, Ethiopia, Libya,

Algeria, Tunisia, and other areas. Canaan, Ham's fourth son, lived in the part of the Holy Land later known as Judea and lent his name to the designation of the general area (the Land of Canaan).

Not all of the children of Noah sought fame, silver and gold. Some went off to live life to the glory of God, loving him and loving their neighbor. Abstaining from the things that displeased God and doing the things that please God. God was not worried about these individuals destroying the earth.

God recognized that man could revert to wickedness very quickly. God needed to send a message in the form of a man to reset civilization to the things of God. Not in the worship of the things of man, but in the worship of God, in peace with man. It was through the line of Shem that God sent Jesus, bringing a message of love. Love for God and love for your fellow man, seven days a week.

To God, that is all that matters. Worshipping God at church on Sunday, while hating your fellow man is not in God's plan. God will send you a message of love. Like Noah, you can choose to follow God's message or if you have no fear, you'll continue to do acts pleasing to self. Today, chose to fear God and follow his commandments. Love God and love your neighbor. Pray to God daily, that the love of God will reign supreme and for man can cease in the murder of others and stop the wars that ravage the earth.

Chapter 4: Three Sons

Noah and his family spent over a year in the ark under God's guidance. They knew the power of God. After seeing all of man wiped out by the flood, they would have feared God. They worshipped God and served him by doing his will. The righteousness of Noah shined forth. God was looking for his sons to remember his power and to fear God.

Genesis 5:32 - And Noah was five hundred years old: and Noah begat Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

They knew of the wickedness that offended God.

Genesis 6:8,13 - But Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord. And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth.

It rained for forty days and after one year on the Ark, each son took a different message from the purging of the evil and violence from the earth. These three sons spent almost a year on the Ark, taking care of the things of God. They were on the front line. They knew of their father's works and righteousness that pleased God. All God was looking for was for the earth to be populated with the knowledge of God and of his power and for man to do as commanded by God, loving God and loving each other. God told them to remember him by the rainbow. These sons were trained by Noah the prophet. He guided them on how to live a righteous life pleasing to God. If each of the three sons continued in the righteousness of Noah, God would have been well pleased. The bible never said that the righteousness of Shem, Ham or Japheth pleased the Lord. God knew their hearts. These three sons had different ideas, different desires and different levels of fear.

- *One of the sons loved the things of the flesh. He had doubt about his dad pushing to build this giant boat! He loved the things of the earth and if it wasn't for Noah being his father, he would be out there amongst the flesh.*
- *Another son, loved Noah and loved God. He was all for the ark. He would do and go wherever Noah wanted him to go. The spirit of God ruled his heart.*
- *Finally, one of the sons was indifferent about building the Ark. Building the Ark with his dad and brothers was something to do. He could be swayed either to the things of the flesh or the spirit of God.*

Each one of these sons would take their family and populate the earth with different levels of fear and love for God in their heart.

Genesis 9:18,22-23,25 - And the sons of Noah, that went forth of the ark, were Shem, and Ham, and Japheth: and Ham is the father of Canaan. And Ham, the father of Canaan, saw the nakedness of his father, and told his two brethren without. And Shem and Japheth took a garment, and laid it upon both their shoulders, and went backward, and covered the nakedness of their father; and their faces were backward, and they saw not their father's nakedness. And he said, Cursed be Canaan; a servant of servants shall he be unto his brethren.

- *Shem and his descendants migrated to Asia. The Israelites came from the line of Shem; in fact, the word Semite comes from the name of Shem. Other descendants of Shem include the Assyrians, Chaldeans, Elamites, Arameans, Moabites, Ammonites, and Edomites.*

- *Ham and his descendants migrated to Africa. Ham's line produced the Canaanites, the Babylonians, the Phoenicians, the Cushites, and the Egyptians.*
- *Japheth and his descendants migrated to Europe. Japheth's line produced the Persians, Romans, Scythians, and Macedonians.*

Each of the races and people-groups that exist today can trace their lineage back to one of these three brothers.

God recognized that man would forget him quickly. Those that love the things of the flesh were the most dangerous. God would no longer destroy the earth, but he recognized that man could.

Almost immediately, God saw the descendants in the lineage of Ham, in the town of Nineveh, turn from God. God sent Jonah with a message of repentance and turning back to God. They turned and God made them a great city in the Assyrian empire.

Following the enslavement of the Hebrews by the Egyptians, God moved the Hebrews to the promised land. Various kings brought into the worship of false gods onto the people. Their worship of God and their lack of love of neighbor displeased God. God had promised to send a savior. God sent Jesus with a message of repentance and sin forgiveness by the shed blood of Jesus's sacrifice on the cross and living one's life per God's commandments of love of God and love of neighbor. Live a righteous life with a promise of life everlasting. Most Israelites did not respond and God's promise was made available to the Gentiles.

God knew that he had to make this message available to the descendants of Japheth. He immediately converted Saul to a believer in God's message sent through Jesus and sent Saul (Paul) to Rome.

Acts 23:11 - And the night following the Lord stood by him, and said, Be of good cheer, Paul: for as thou hast testified of me in Jerusalem, so must thou bear witness also at Rome.

600 years later God sent Muhammed to the middle East, mainly to the descendants of Ham with a gospel of repentance, turning to God and loving God and loving your neighbor. The religion of Islam took hold and the people believed.

The Hindu religion of love was developed from the descendants of Shem that made their way to Central Asia. A religion of love and living a life unto righteousness as taught by Noah.

A simple message of love is just too complicated for those that love the things of the flesh. The power of religion and the love of filthy lucre has turned the followers of God, into believing that their religion is the only way to serve God and seek his favor. Instead of just loving each other and serving God, infidels and wars have blossomed from misunderstanding, the love of the flesh and the love of filthy lucre. God's message of do not judge and spread his word has turned into man judging, killing and conquering those for filthy lucre if they don't believe as you believe. In the end, only God will judge.

The judgement of God was made clear to me following the witness of the 4/8/24 Nineveh eclipse over North America. God launched his church of love with a dream on Ecclesiastes 4:12-15. God told me that my witness to the man-made churches was finished.

Ecclesiastes 4:12-15 - And if one prevail against him, two shall withstand him; and a threefold cord is not quickly broken. Better is a poor and a wise child than an old and foolish king, who will no more be admonished. For out of prison he cometh to reign; whereas also he that is born in his kingdom becometh

poor. I considered all the living which walk under the sun, with the second child that shall stand up in his stead.

His next dream sealed the deal for me with a recurring dream of death and destruction and his message of "Nothing Is as It First Appears." God use of saved in the Old Testament was about saving his people from destruction. Man has turned the Christian salvation message in the New Testament from saving his people to all about saving self.

God's salvation message starts with you living your life, loving God and loving your neighbor. On the sixth day, God put man on the world last. The world can thrive without man. It is up to man to live here without destroying this planet.

John 3:17 - For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.

God never ceases to use his believers and followers to spread his gospel. To seek the truth out of his word from the mouth of two or three witnesses. The message from his witnesses have been clear and consistent. To spread his gospel of turning from sin, to loving God and neighbor and living a life unto righteousness. To be a doer of his word and looking forward to being judged by God for a promise unto life everlasting.

Today, decide to repent from sin and turn to God. Live your life unto righteousness, serving God and serving your neighbor. In the end, God, you and his world wins.

Chapter 5: Why Nineveh

Ham was a son of Noah. According to Genesis 10:6-11, the descendants of Ham led to the building of Nineveh. Within several generations of Ham, the descendants forgot about the power of God and the death brought on by the flood. Nineveh had gone to the way of wickedness. God went to Jonah, who was an Old Testament prophet. God told Jonah to witness to the great city of Ninevah. Their wickedness was great and it offended the Lord. So much so, that he wanted Jonah to tell them about God and that their wickedness displeased him. This was not going to be a small act for Jonah. Nineveh was not kind to strangers, especially those preaching against their wicked behavior. It has been told that they would cube their enemy and eat them. Out of fear for his life, he ignored God's request and decided to go the opposite way to Tarshish in southern Spain.

Jonah 1:2-4 - Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and cry against it; for their wickedness is come up before me But Jonah rose up to flee unto Tarshish from the presence of the Lord, and went down to Joppa; and he found a ship going to Tarshish: so he paid the fare thereof, and went down into it, to go with them unto Tarshish from the presence of the Lord. But the Lord sent out a great wind into the sea, and there was a mighty tempest in the sea, so that the ship was like to be broken.

God knew that Jonah's faith was weak, so he decided to give Jonah strength. God used a large fish to swallow Jonah and Jonah stayed in his belly three days. Teachers will say that Jonah's time in the belly of the fish is symbolic of the three days that Jesus spent in the earth. I disagree. Jesus did not turn away from the Father and ignore what his Father wanted him to do. The three days in the belly of the fish was to correct for Jonah's path. Jonah was now a subject matter expert and hero. God

will build you up and give you the power to perform the job he has for you.

Jonah 1:1-5,15,17 - Now the word of the Lord came unto Jonah the son of Amittai, saying, Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and cry against it; for their wickedness is come up before me. But Jonah rose up to flee unto Tarshish from the presence of the Lord, and went down to Joppa; and he found a ship going to Tarshish: so he paid the fare thereof, and went down into it, to go with them unto Tarshish from the presence of the Lord. But the Lord sent out a great wind into the sea, and there was a mighty tempest in the sea, so that the ship was like to be broken. Then the mariners were afraid, and cried every man unto his god, and cast forth the wares that were in the ship into the sea, to lighten it of them. But Jonah was gone down into the sides of the ship; and he lay, and was fast asleep. So they took up Jonah, and cast him forth into the sea: and the sea ceased from her raging. Now the Lord had prepared a great fish to swallow up Jonah. And Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights.

Recognizing the predicament that Jonah was in, he prayed unto the Lord thy God, to take him out of this fish. For the lost, this fish with you in the belly is representative of you lost in your love of self, greed and addiction. When you decide that you want out, pray to God and tell him that you want out! God spit Jonah out of the mouth of the fish. God will give you the power to escape your greed and addiction and life of sin. Being spit out of the fish's mouth, it is time you decide to follow God's commandments, turn from sin, love God and love his children and follow him. God will direct your paths.

Jonah 2:1-2,9-10 - Then Jonah prayed unto the Lord his God out of the fish's belly, And said, I cried by reason of mine affliction unto the Lord, and he heard me; out of the belly of hell cried I,

and thou heardest my voice. But I will sacrifice unto thee with the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay that that I have vowed. Salvation is of the Lord. And the Lord spake unto the fish, and it vomited out Jonah upon the dry land.

God picked Jonah in the womb and God's plan for Jonah didn't change. Jonah stood up on the beach and did as God directed! He headed to Nineveh and told them of the impending doom that God had planned for their wicked city! Nineveh agreed and gave glory to God with a fast. They repented and turned from their evil ways and God was pleased. He was no longer going to wipe out the city.

Jonah 3:1-5,9-10 - And the word of the Lord came unto Jonah the second time, saying, Arise, go unto Nineveh, that great city, and preach unto it the preaching that I bid thee. So Jonah arose, and went unto Nineveh, according to the word of the Lord. Now Nineveh was an exceeding great city of three days' journey. And Jonah began to enter into the city a day's journey, and he cried, and said, Yet forty days, and Nineveh shall be overthrown. So the people of Nineveh believed God, and proclaimed a fast, and put on sackcloth, from the greatest of them even to the least of them. Who can tell if God will turn and repent, and turn away from his fierce anger, that we perish not? And God saw their works, that they turned from their evil way; and God repented of the evil, that he had said that he would do unto them; and he did it not.

The outcome of you serving the Lord is in God's plan. It will not always be what you want. Jonah was no longer going to witness the destruction of Nineveh and he was angry. He was ready to witness the destruction of Nineveh, but their corrective action and worship of God by the people of Nineveh pleased God.

Jonah 4:1-3,5-8,11 - But it displeased Jonah exceedingly, and he was very angry. And he prayed unto the Lord, and said, I pray thee, O Lord, was not this my saying, when I was yet in my country? Therefore I fled before unto Tarshish: for I knew that thou art a gracious God, and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repentest thee of the evil. Therefore now, O Lord, take, I beseech thee, my life from me; for it is better for me to die than to live. So Jonah went out of the city, and sat on the east side of the city, and there made him a booth, and sat under it in the shadow, till he might see what would become of the city. And the Lord God prepared a gourd, and made it to come up over Jonah, that it might be a shadow over his head, to deliver him from his grief. So Jonah was exceeding glad of the gourd. But God prepared a worm when the morning rose the next day, and it smote the gourd that it withered. And it came to pass, when the sun did arise, that God prepared a vehement east wind; and the sun beat upon the head of Jonah, that he fainted, and wished in himself to die, and said, It is better for me to die than to live. And should not I spare Nineveh, that great city, wherein are more than sixscore thousand persons that cannot discern between their right hand and their left hand; and also much cattle?

*The people of Nineveh listened to Jonah the prophet as sent by God.
The people of Nineveh did as God directed. God blessed
Nineveh and they went on to be a great city.*

*The doctrine for the One World Church was formed during the
seven year jail ministry for the addicted and lost from all
different religious denominations. Witness after witness and
lesson after lesson, God's word has been proven real. The One
World Church was born in Union City, Indiana during the full
eclipse on 4/8/24 that passed through several towns named
Nineveh. The world has turned to sin. God message of the*

Four times in the Old Testament and seven times in the New Testament, the witnesses have told you that you shall know the truth out of the mouth of two or three witnesses. A man shall not be put to death out of the mouth of one witness. Nor are you offered everlasting life out of the mouth of one witness.

Come read and understand God's doctrine as it was meant to be understood. Judge no one and love everyone. Today, surrender, repent, be born again and seek to live a righteous life as a servant, loving God and loving your neighbor. Walk in the light, grow God's kingdom and look forward to spending eternity in heaven! Pray to God that North America and the world, repent and lose its grip on the worship of the false god of greed. God sent his prophets to his people. His people are to restore their faith on the things of God and render themselves to the love of people. Pray that the people be delivered from the hate and judgement of the world and to be restored to the love of God and the love of the things of this earth. If you are into greed and self-fulfillment and not realizing the full potential that God has planned for you, then it is time to turn to God. To understand the teachings of his prophets. If your spirit has gone sour, then repent and turn from your sins and by the grace of God, may your sins be forgiven. Do not turn from God's direction as Jonah initially did. Do as God requests and do not judge others. It is time for you to turn to God. To go and live your life to the glory of God by serving others.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 6: The Prophets

Many Old Testament prophets were used to convey the word and will of God onto the Jews. God sent Jesus in the New Testament. Who is Jesus? Out of the mouth of the New Testament witnesses, let's investigate the truth.

There are eighty-one (81) verses in the New Testament where Christ is referred to as the son of God from five witnesses. Christ is not defined in the bible. Old Testament prophets predicted the God would send a chosen one or an anointed one to save the world from sin. To deliver the world from bondage. We know that Jesus was conceived by the Holy Ghost and born of a woman in the flesh. His death on the cross and shed blood is a sacrifice for sins. Christ is not the minister of sin and for the continuation of a sinful life, once you believe in God grace.

Matthew 1:20-21 - But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost. And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.

Matthew 16:16 - And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God.

Luke 1:35 - And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.

John 11:27 - She saith unto him, Yea, Lord: I believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world.

Acts 9:19-20 - And when he had received meat, he was strengthened. Then was Saul certain days with the disciples which were at Damascus. And straightway he preached Christ in the synagogues, that he is the Son of God.

Romans 3:25 - Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;

Hebrews 6:4-6 - For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost, And have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come, If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put him to an open shame.

Jesus grew up the oldest of his four brothers and several sisters.

Mark 6:3 - Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary, the brother of James, and Joses, and of Juda, and Simon? and are not his sisters here with us? And they were offended at him.

The preponderance of evidence testimony from the eight New Testament witnesses will confirm that Jesus was sent by God. God is the Father. Jesus as the Son of God. Jesus referred to himself as a prophet! Let's review the preponderance of evidence testimony.

Jesus referred to God as his father.

Matthew 23:9 - And call no man your father upon the earth: for one is your Father, which is in heaven.

Mark 11:26 - But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.

Luke 10:21 - In that hour Jesus rejoiced in spirit, and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes: even so, Father; for so it seemed good in thy sight.

Luke 22:42 - Saying, Father, if thou be willing, remove this cup from me: nevertheless not my will, but thine, be done.

John 20:17 - Jesus saith unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father: but go to my brethren, and say unto them, I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; and to my God, and your God.

John 20:21 - Then said Jesus to them again, Peace be unto you: as my Father hath sent me, even so send I you.

Jesus himself testified that there is but one God. One God and Father. Only one.

Matthew 19:17 - And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments.

Mark 10:18 - And Jesus said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God.

Luke 18:19 - And Jesus said unto him, Why callest thou me good? none is good, save one, that is, God.

Mark 12:29,32,33 - And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord. And the scribe said unto him, Well, Master, thou hast said the truth: for there is one God; and there is none other but he: And to love him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the soul, and with all the strength,

and to love his neighbor as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices.

John 17:3 - And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent.

Ephesians 4:6 - One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.

James 2:19 – Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.

1 Peter 1:12 - Unto whom it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into.

In multiple verses from the witnesses, God is referred to as our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ as separate beings.

Romans 15:5-6 - Now the God of patience and consolation grant you to be likeminded one toward another according to Christ Jesus: That ye may with one mind and one mouth glorify God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Ephesians 1:2 - Grace be to you, and peace, from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ.

2 Thessalonians 1:2 - Grace unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

1 Peter 1:3 - Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

Jude 1:1 - Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, and called:

2 John 1:3 - Grace be with you, mercy, and peace, from God the Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love.

Revelation 1:6 - And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

When Stephen was stoned to death, he saw Jesus as the Son of man, standing on the right hand of God.

Acts 7:55-56,58-59 - But he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God, And said, Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing on the right hand of God. And cast him out of the city, and stoned him: and the witnesses laid down their clothes at a young man's feet, whose name was Saul. And they stoned Stephen, calling upon God, and saying, Lord Jesus, receive my spirit.

The works of Jesus were to glorify the Father.

John 15:1,8-10 - I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman. Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples. As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love. If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.

James 2:19 - Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.

1 Peter 4:10-11- As every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

James 3:9 - Therewith bless we God, even the Father; and therewith curse we men, which are made after the similitude of God.

From the preponderance of evidence in the testimonies of witnesses, the truth is revealed. In Jesus's own words, he declares that there is only one God, God the Father. Jesus was born of woman and declares himself to be the Son of God as the Son of man and to sit on the right hand of God the Father of the power of God.

Luke 22:69 - Hereafter shall the Son of man sit on the right hand of the power of God.

Jesus called on God the Father, during his crucifixion.

Matthew 27:43,46 - He trusted in God; let him deliver him now, if he will have him: for he said, I am the Son of God. And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?

Jesus as the "I am" is referred to many things by only one witness. This not considered truth in establishing God's doctrine and God's will out of the mouth of two or three witnesses.

John 6:35 - And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.

John 8:12 - Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

John 10:7,11 - Then said Jesus unto them again, Verily, verily, I say unto you, I am the door of the sheep. I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.

John 11:25 - Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:

John 14:6 - Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

John 15:5 - I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.

Jesus never declared himself to be a god or equal to God. He loved God, his Father, and did all things to please him. Jesus performed miracles as his apostles did, after they received the gift of the Holy Ghost.

Acts 10:38 - How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Acts 19:11 - And God wrought special miracles by the hands of Paul:

Hebrews 2:4 - God also bearing them witness, both with signs and wonders, and with divers miracles, and gifts of the Holy Ghost, according to his own will?

Jesus and the witnesses, declared Jesus to be a prophet.

Matthew 10:40-41 - He that receiveth you receiveth me, and he that receiveth me receiveth him that sent me. He that receiveth a prophet in the name of a prophet shall receive a prophet's reward; and he that receiveth a righteous man in the name of a righteous man shall receive a righteous man's reward.

Matthew 21:11,46 - And the multitude said, This is Jesus the prophet of Nazareth of Galilee. But when they sought to lay hands on him, they feared the multitude, because they took him for a prophet.

Mark 6:4-5 - But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, but in his own country, and among his own kin, and in his own house. And he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed them.

Luke 4:24 - And he said, Verily I say unto you, No prophet is accepted in his own country.

Luke 7:16 - And there came a fear on all: and they glorified God, saying, That a great prophet is risen up among us; and, That God hath visited his people.

John 4:19,43-44 - The woman saith unto him, Sir, I perceive that thou art a prophet. Now after two days he departed thence, and went into Galilee. For Jesus himself testified, that a prophet hath no honour in his own country.

John 6:14 - Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said, This is of a truth that prophet that should come into the world.

John 7:37-38,40 - In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. Many of

the people therefore, when they heard this saying, said, of a truth this is the Prophet.

John 9:14,17 - And it was the sabbath day when Jesus made the clay, and opened his eyes. They say unto the blind man again, What sayest thou of him, that he hath opened thine eyes? He said, He is a prophet.

You are warned not to worship the creature more than the Creator. That worship is reserved for God.

Romans 1:25 - Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen.

Only one witness speaks of the trinity as one. In your heart, they dwell as one. Using the preponderance of evidence testimony from the mouth of two or three witnesses, the truth is not out of the mouth of one witness.

1 John 5:7-9 - For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one. And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one. If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater: for this is the witness of God which he hath testified of his Son.

Multiple Christian denominations like to refer to the false doctrine as Jesus being God, based on this one witness verse.

John 10:30 - I and my Father are one.

Jesus referred to God as "my Father" One hundred and three (103) times in the New Testament. Witnesses: Matthew, Mark, Luke, John, Paul, Peter and John in Revelations. It is clear, that Jesus is the Son and God is his Father. Jesus respected his Father. God told you exactly how to worship him in spirit and truth.

- 1) *There is one God, God the Father. Creator of heaven and earth.
Do not worship idols.*
- 2) *God the Father gave you the Son of God as a prophet and a
blood sacrifice for the forgiveness of the sins of the world.*
- 3) *Holy Ghost is given by God to dwell in your heart, guiding you to
be a light of life and to do the will of God.*

*Using the preponderance of evidence testimony from the eight New
Testament witnesses, it is clear that Jesus is not God. Jesus was
sent by God as the Son and to be a prophet for God our Father.*

*As a son and daughter of God, it is your responsibility to go live your
life for the glory of God. Do the will of the Father and get ready
for the kingdom of God. A kingdom offered to both Jews and
Gentiles by the grace of God. Worship God and be prepared to
give him glory in everything you do! Today, your walk with God
has begun. As new man, renewed in spirit, judge no one and
share God's gospel of love with a hope of everlasting life.*

Matthew 7:21 - Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall
enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of
my Father which is in heaven.

2 John 1:9 - Whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the
doctrine of Christ, hath not God. He that abideth in the
doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son.

Romans 12:2-3 - And be not conformed to this world: but be ye
transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove
what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that
is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he
ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath
dealt to every man the measure of faith.

You shall know the doctrine of Christ as God's gospel of Love in the two commandments he has given you. Spoken by all eight witnesses!

- *Love God.*
- *Love your neighbor as yourself.*

Now, go live your life for the glory of God.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 7: Paul the Roman

God knows the future. The question is, do you want to be part of it? Jeremiah buried the Ark of the Covenant, which 600 years later was used for the blood sacrifice of Christ the Savior. No longer serving God or accepting his power, the Ark was hidden during the time of Jeremiah.

Jeremiah 3:16 - And it shall come to pass, when ye be multiplied and increased in the land, in those days, saith the Lord, they shall say no more, The ark of the covenant of the Lord : neither shall it come to mind: neither shall they remember it; neither shall they visit it ; neither shall that be done any more.

The death and shed blood of Jesus Christ was orchestrated by God, so that the shed blood of Jesus would be a sin offering. The rock was split at the base of the cross to above the mercy seat. Jesus's blood fell through that crack and onto the mercy seat of the Ark of the Covenant. There it was an offering as a sacrifice for your sins.

Matthew 27:50-51 - Jesus, when he had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost. And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent.

In several dreams, Joseph was told to relocate to save Mary and the newborn child.

Matthew 2:12-14, 19-20 - And being warned of God in a dream that they should not return to Herod, they departed into their own country another way. And when they were departed, behold, the angel of the Lord appeareth to Joseph in a dream, saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and flee into Egypt, and be thou there until I bring thee word: for Herod will seek the young child to destroy him. When he arose, he took

the young child and his mother by night, and departed into Egypt: But when Herod was dead, behold, an angel of the Lord appeareth in a dream to Joseph in Egypt, Saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and go into the land of Israel: for they are dead which sought the young child's life.

Jesus picked the twelve apostles. With the exception of Judas, they persisted unto his resurrection, after which they received the gift of speaking in tongues.

Acts 2:1-11 - And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven. Now when this was noised abroad, the multitude came together, and were confounded, because that every man heard them speak in his own language. And they were all amazed and marvelled, saying one to another, Behold, are not all these which speak Galilaeans? And how hear we every man in our own tongue, wherein we were born? Parthians, and Medes, and Elamites, and the dwellers in Mesopotamia, and in Judaea, and Cappadocia, in Pontus, and Asia, Phrygia, and Pamphylia, in Egypt, and in the parts of Libya about Cyrene, and strangers of Rome, Jews and proselytes, Cretes and Arabians, we do hear them speak in our tongues the wonderful works of God.

The Apostles were Jews and well equipped to teach the word of God in all foreign lands, including Rome. God knew that these eleven Apostles were not enough.

One man, Saul, persecuted Christians, including the stoning of Stephen.

Acts 8:1-4 - And Saul was consenting unto his death. And at that time there was a great persecution against the church which was at Jerusalem; and they were all scattered abroad throughout the regions of Judaea and Samaria, except the apostles. And devout men carried Stephen to his burial, and made great lamentation over him. As for Saul, he made havock of the church, entering into every house, and haling men and women committed them to prison. Therefore they that were scattered abroad went every where preaching the word.

This non-Christian man was picked by God to spread his word. On the way to persecute more Christians in Damascus, God stopped him in his tracks. After this conversion, Saul is referred to as Paul in the bible.

Acts 9:3-5 - And as he journeyed, he came near Damascus: and suddenly there shined round about him a light from heaven: And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? And he said, Who art thou, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest: it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks.

Paul decided to be part of God's kingdom here on earth. He was already a Pharisee. God needed him to spread the gospel of love that Jesus taught to the Apostles. But why Paul? There were a couple of reasons.

- 1) *At that time, the Jews were being kicked out of Rome. To reach Europe and the descendants of Japeth, God knew it was critical to preach his word, starting in Rome. The original eleven Jewish apostles would not be not capable of teaching in Rome.*

Acts 18:1-2 - After these things Paul departed from Athens, and came to Corinth; And found a certain Jew named Aquila, born in Pontus, lately come from Italy, with his wife Priscilla; (because that Claudius had commanded all Jews to depart from Rome:) and came unto them.

2) *God told Paul that he must go to Rome.*

Acts 19:20-21 - So mightily grew the word of God and prevailed. After these things were ended, Paul purposed in the spirit, when he had passed through Macedonia and Achaia, to go to Jerusalem, saying, After I have been there, I must also see Rome.

3) *Paul was also Roman!*

Acts 22:25-27 -And as they bound him with thongs, Paul said unto the centurion that stood by, Is it lawful for you to scourge a man that is a Roman, and uncondemned? When the centurion heard that, he went and told the chief captain, saying, Take heed what thou doest: for this man is a Roman. Then the chief captain came, and said unto him, Tell me, art thou a Roman? He said, Yea.

4) *Not only did Paul make it to Rome, he dwelt there two years in his own hired house and was able to freely preach the kingdom of God.*

Acts 28:16-18,28-31 - And when we came to Rome, the centurion delivered the prisoners to the captain of the guard: but Paul was suffered to dwell by himself with a soldier that kept him. And it came to pass, that after three days Paul called the chief of the Jews together: and when they were come together, he said unto them, Men and brethren, though I have committed nothing against the people, or customs of our fathers, yet was I delivered prisoner from Jerusalem into the hands of the

Romans. Who, when they had examined me, would have let me go, because there was no cause of death in me. Be it known therefore unto you, that the salvation of God is sent unto the Gentiles, and that they will hear it. And when he had said these words, the Jews departed, and had great reasoning among themselves. And Paul dwelt two whole years in his own hired house, and received all that came in unto him, Preaching the kingdom of God, and teaching those things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ, with all confidence, no man forbidding him.

God had twelve Apostles to spread his word, but he could not use them in Rome. He needed Paul, a non-Christian to spread God's gospel of love. 700 years later, God needed someone to spread his gospel to the Middle East. It wasn't happening nor effective by the Apostles. So, ask yourself, "Did God choose Muhammad?" God knows who he needs, to spread his gospel of love. When God calls on you, will you do as he directs or will you deny him before men?

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 8: Gospel to the Romans

As you study the New Testament using the preponderance of evidence standard, you can see the doctrine from the books align. This is to be expected as the eight witnesses talked to each other. Paul had high regard for Mark's doctrine of Jesus. Mark was profitable for the ministry.

2 Timothy 4:11 - Only Luke is with me. Take Mark, and bring him with thee: for he is profitable to me for the ministry.

We also recognize that Jesus's salvation message in Mark aligns with the other Gospels, with the end, everlasting life.

Mark 13:13 - And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.

Even Jude says to keep yourself in the love of God by doing and living a righteous life. Looking for God's mercy unto eternal life.

Jude 1:21 - Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

When you study Romans, Paul is very descriptive. The Romans had hung Jesus at the persistence of the Jews. The Romans viewed the Jews worship of God as a cult. Killing Jesus was the only way a cult could eliminate the heretic. Paul, a prior persecutor of Christians, is now willing to die for Jesus and shows up in Rome and tells the Romans that they too can have the power of the almighty God, by just putting their trust in Jesus and not by Jewish blood bath of animal sacrifice. For Paul this was a monumental task. With conviction, he uses repetition to make the salvation message clear. When we look at Romans as a whole contract, God's message of salvation also aligns with the

other books written by the New Testament witnesses, as it does!

Paul had to convince them that the Jesus in the flesh as the Son of God was the power unto salvation and is available to all.

Romans 1:3,4,16,28-32 - Concerning his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh; And declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead: For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

Works of religion and Jewish circumcision means nothing. Sin is sin in the eyes of God. All that matters is the circumcision of the heart. When the heart is right with God, you seek and praise God and live a righteous life. You are a doer of his word.

Romans 1:28-32 - And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient; Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, Backbiters, haters of God, spiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, Without understanding, covenant breakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful: Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them.

Romans 2:22, 24,28-29 – Thou that sayest a man should not commit adultery, dost thou commit adultery? thou that abhorrest idols, dost thou commit sacrilege? For the name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles through you, as it is

written. For he is not a Jew, which is one outwardly; neither is that circumcision, which is outward in the flesh: But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of God.

Romans 4:16 - Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all.

Romans 3:10-11,18,22-25,28 - As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one: There is none that understandeth, there is none that seeketh after God. There is no fear of God before their eyes. Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference: For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law.

Romans 5:5-6,8,18 - And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us. For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life.

Paul tells the Romans that sin will destroy their life and God's gift of life. They must become as a new creature and walk in the newness of life. Present your body as a living sacrifice. Live a life unto righteousness, not serving sin. Obey God's word from the heart.

Romans 12:1-2 - I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Romans 6:4,6,8-11,13,14,16-18 - Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin. Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him: Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him. For in that he died, he died unto sin once: but in that he liveth, he liveth unto God. Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord. Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God. For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace. Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness? But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine

which was delivered you. Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness.

Paul tells the Romans to repent of their sins and be delivered from the bondage of corruption. Living to the flesh shall lead to death. Being married to Christ, live in the spirit and you shall have life bringing forth fruit unto God.

Romans 6:1-2 - What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?

Romans 8:12-13, 21 - Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh. For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live. Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God.

Romans 7:4 - Wherefore, my brethren, ye also are become dead to the law by the body of Christ; that ye should be married to another, even to him who is raised from the dead, that we should bring forth fruit unto God.

With a pure heart, they are to live by faith unto righteousness. Confess and repent of their sin daily. Loving God and one another as Jesus commanded. Not being ashamed of his glorious gospel. You do his word. Serve God by serving others.

Romans 10:10-11 - For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.

Romans 13:8 Owe no man anything, but to love one another: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law.

In the end you will be judged by God. Live your by being a doer of his word. Repent of your sins, live a righteous life unto the Lord, love God, love one another, follow his commandments as a servant to God and in the end, everlasting life.

Romans 14:8-12 - For whether we live, we live unto the Lord; and whether we die, we die unto the Lord: whether we live therefore, or die, we are the Lord's. For to this end Christ both died, and rose, and revived, that he might be Lord both of the dead and living. But why dost thou judge thy brother? or why dost thou set at nought thy brother? for we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ. For it is written, As I live, saith the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God. So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.

Romans 5:21 - That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord.

Romans 6:22 - But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life.

Chapter 9: Love according to Jesus

The prophet Paul's message is simple. Recognize God as the Almighty, repent and turn from sin, love God and love your neighbor, living a life unto righteousness, endure to the end and live. All eight witnesses wrote on the same gospel message. God's gospel message of love.

Out of love for mankind, God sent Jesus as a witness, so that both the Jews and the Gentiles could have a relationship with God. This relationship is about loving in the state of righteousness and walking in the light of the world.

God gave me this verse:

Daniel 12:3 - And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever.

There are many examples of wise individuals that showed their love of God after being exposed to his light as Jesus walked on the earth. The first being the Samaritan lady that had many husbands at Jacob's well. Without doubting the righteousness of Jesus, she immediately went into Samaria and told others of Jesus.

John 4:28-30 - The woman then left her waterpot, and went her way into the city, and saith to the men, Come, see a man, which told me all things that ever I did: is not this the Christ? Then they went out of the city, and came unto him.

Another being the man that lived and abused himself among the dead and tombs in the Gadarenes, out of which Jesus drove out the devil and was cured. He wished to travel with Jesus, but Jesus asked him to be his witness.

Mark 5:18-20 - And when he was come into the ship, he that had been possessed with the devil prayed him that he might be with him. Howbeit Jesus suffered him not, but saith unto him, Go home to thy friends, and tell them how great things the Lord hath done for thee, and hath had compassion on thee. And he departed, and began to publish in Decapolis how great things Jesus had done for him: and all men did marvel.

That woman and that man could be any modern-day sinner. The guys in the jail abused themselves with drugs and alcohol and hung out with the dead in spirit. Like this Gadarene, when you understand the truth in God's word, you turn from your sin and your new life as a witness for what the power of God can do in your life. These Gentiles did not hide their light under a bushel basket and boast about meeting Jesus. They immediately became a witness for Jesus. To spread God's word.

The word love is used 442 times in both the Old and New Testaments, about equal number of times in both. It is clear that our God, is the God of Love. All eight witnesses spoke on love. Not out of the mouth of two or three witnesses, but out of the mouth of all eight witnesses. It is the only subject that all eight witnesses have spoken on and the message is consistent. Not one witness, but all eight. Not once did the witnesses speak on loving yourself. God's message is about:

- 1) Loving God*
- 2) Loving neighbor*
- 3) Walking in the light.*

Anyone that promotes or votes for death, abortion, war and hate is not a child of love but a child of the devil who abides in darkness and death. God does not agree with you when you say that you love him and you vote for killing babies. When

you say you love God, God is telling you that you are to love the things of this earth. You cannot say you love God and serve the devil or money.

John 3:19,21 - And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.

Matthew 6:24 - No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

Loving God and your neighbor is not an ordinance of man's religion, it is a commandment from God, for God is good.

Matthew 19:17-19 - And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments. He saith unto him, Which? Jesus said, Thou shalt do no murder, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Honour thy father and thy mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

Mark 12:30-31 - And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment. And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.

Luke 10:27-28 - And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself.

And he said unto him, Thou hast answered right: this do, and thou shalt live.

Matthew 22:37-40 - Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

John 13:34 - A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.

Romans 13:8-10 - Owe no man any thing, but to love one another: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law. For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. Love worketh no ill to his neighbour: therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.

Galatians 5:13-14 - For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another. For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

James 2:8 - If ye fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself, ye do well:

Every ordinance you perform in man's church is about love of self. Jesus has told you that if you hate your life of self-love, then you shall keep your life, unto life eternal! To provoke love and good works.

John 12:25 - He that loveth his life shall lose it; and he that hateth his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal.

Hebrews 10:24 - And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

With the Holy Ghost residing in your heart, God has given you power, love and a sound mind. To love one another with a pure heart. Keeping yourself in the love of God unto eternal life.

2 Timothy 1:7 - For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

1 Peter 1:21-22 - Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God. Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:

John 14:15,21 - If ye love me, keep my commandments. He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.

Jude 1:2,21 - Mercy unto you, and peace, and love, be multiplied. Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

All eight witnesses spoke on loving God and loving your neighbor. When you love your neighbor, you want to make sure that they have the love of God residing in their heart as a born-again child of God that has turned from sin. 2024 was a wonderful year for witnessing for God. From the 350 gospel tracts shared at Union City Indiana for the Nineveh eclipse or the 250 tracts shared at the Ohio State football opening day or the 250 gospel tracts shared at Notre Dame campus in twenty minutes, there

is no doubt that the time is ripe to share God's word. Sharing God's word is not about the love of self and being saved. Sharing God's word is about the love of others and walking in the light of the world. This year decide to be a witness for God and share his love. When you love God and love your neighbor, you spread God's word as a light of the world!

Chapter 10: Love according to Mohammed

"Serve God, and join not any partners with Him; and do good – to parents, kinsfolk, orphans, those in need, neighbors who are near, neighbors who are strangers, the companion by your side, the wayfarer (ye meet), and what your right hands possess." [The Holy Qur'an, al-Nisaa 4:36]

2) Treating one's neighbor with respect and duty.

When asked what the rights of the neighbor are, the Prophet Mohammed answered: "The least of a neighbor's rights on him is that if he asks him for a loan he should grant it to him. If he

asks for help, he should help him. If he wants to borrow something from him, he should lend it to him. If he needs him to donate something to him, he should do so. If he invites him, he should accept his invitation. If he gets sick, he should go and visit him. If he passes away, he should attend his funeral procession.” [Mustadrak al-Wasa’il, v.2, p.79]

3) Loving a neighbor like family.

The Prophet Mohammed is reported to have said: “If he [a neighbor] receives some blessings, he should be happy and not envious of him. If a tragedy befalls him, he should grieve for his grief. He should not build a tall building in front of his dwelling which would trouble him due to it’s overlooking his house and obstructing the passage of breeze. If he is presented with some novelty in his house, then he should present him a part of it, if he knows that he does not have something like it, otherwise he should conceal it from him and his family if he desires it for himself.” [Mustadrak al-Wasa’il, v.2, p.79]

4) Those who fulfil the rights of neighbors are blessed.

After describing the rights of neighbors, the Prophet Mohammed is reported to have stated: “Listen to what I tell you. Only a few people who are blessed by God’s Mercy fulfil the rights of neighbors. God enjoined on me the rights of the neighbor to the extent that I thought He would appoint him as an heir.” [Mustadrak al-Wasa’il, v.2, p.79]

5) Respecting neighbors is a duty upon Muslims.

The Prophet Mohammed stated: “Whoever believes in God and the Final Day should not trouble his neighbors.” [Mustadrak al-Wasa’il, v.2, pp.78-79]

6) Treating your neighbor like your mother.

In another hadith, the Prophet is reported to have stated: "The reverence of a neighbor incumbent on the neighbor is like the reverence due to one's mother." [Mustadrak al-Wasa'il, v.2, pp.78-79]

7) Helping out a neighbor in need may end up helping you as well.

"Treating one's neighbors with kindness and being a good neighbor will result in an increase in one's share of daily bread and the development of towns." [Mustadrak al-Wasa'il, v.2, pp.78-79]

8) Not fearing your neighbors.

The Prophet is reported to have stated in regards to not fearing one's neighbors: "The neighbor because of whom one locks the door, out of fear for one's family and wealth, is not a believer." [Tafsir-i-Namunah, v.3, pp.380-381]

9) One must not trouble their neighbors.

In one narration, someone complained to the Prophet Mohammed about his neighbor. The Prophet reportedly turned his face away from him, and then stated to those around him: "Go and publicly announce that the curse of God and the angels is on one who troubles his neighbor." [Mustadrak al-Wasa'il, v.2, pp.78-79]

10) Believing in the Prophet means believing in helping out your community and neighbors.

"One who spends the night with a full stomach while his neighbor is hungry, has not believed in me. One who spends the night clothed, while his neighbor has no clothes, has not believed in me." [Mustadrak al-Wasa'il, v.2, pp.78-79].

Forget any man that calls his religion the one true religion. God's witnesses have a consistent testimony. God will be the judge.

Today, decide to repent from sin and surrender to God. Live your life unto righteousness, loving God and loving your neighbor. In the end, God, you and his world wins.

Chapter 12: Heart Burn

First, I'd like to thank those that have walked with me on this journey into understanding the truth in God's word. If you are like me, I was not sure where this journey was going to take us. It has been twenty-two months and two hundred bible matters later, when the doctrine of the truth out of the mouth of two or three witnesses had entered into the bible lessons. Every man in the jail was confused about God's word and the lessons they had previously been taught. These men were of different religious denominations and all had different beliefs, commandments and ordinances. Many studied the bible, knew the verses and didn't understand the differences in church doctrine that they had been exposed to. If there is one God, then why are there so many religious denominations. These men needed to understand the truth in God's word.

I had participated in United States Federal court trials in Pasadena and Cincinnati as a professional witness and on multiple juries. I participated in civil trials in Cincinnati on juries several times. I participated in a trial at work as a professional witness. I participated in civil trials in Cincinnati and Warren County as a plaintiff. The two elements of trials are the contract and the multiple witnesses. The outcome of these cases is not always what one would have expected!

That is exactly the experience of what we have learned in the last twenty-two months. The outcome of these lessons were not as I expected, but it is what God wanted you to know. For many members of this ministry, these lessons were just the beginning of the heartburn created in comparison to what you had previously been taught. God had sent me three messages on 2/25/23 & 2/26/23 that lead to a bible lesson on salvation, In Bible numbers: 2 is Witnesses; 28 is led by the spirit. God led me by the spirit to create this bible message. It is the study of

salvation as reported by the eight New Testament bible witnesses. In summary: God's message of salvation is clear. Believe in God, repent of your sins and be converted or born again as a child of God. Live a righteous life by doing the will of God by serving and showing your love for God and neighbor and not abiding in darkness or sin. Religious acts are not required for God's gift. Keep yourself in the love of God, show your faith by your works and endure to the end, with everlasting life in heaven.

1 Corinthians 1:17 - For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect.

It is clear that God does not offer salvation in terms of a verse or two from the bible. Many of you have been told that you are saved because you believe a couple of verses from Romans and/or John. A wicked doer should take heed and recognize your life as an abomination in the sight of the Lord. The wicked man would pervert the ways of God's judgement. Be wise with a merry heart and live a righteous life for God.

Proverbs 17:23 -A wicked man taketh a gift out of the bosom to pervert the ways of judgment.

In this case, the contract is the offer of a relationship with God for the Gentiles as presented in the New Testament. You don't pluck and choose verses from the Old Testament as an ordinance that God requires of you as a Gentile.

The number one question the men had from the jail was on drinking alcohol. Not once in the New Testament does God's word present drinking alcohol as a sin. God's word warns you from multiple witnesses of the sin of drunkenness. Drunkenness serves only self and the devil. When you walk in drunkenness, you are walking with the devil in darkness and death. This

lesson is heartburn for those walking in drunkenness and thinking they are saved.

The number two question the men had was on baptism. Many men were baptized by water several times, thinking they are saved while walking with the devil in the state of drunkenness and sin. Baptism by the Holy Ghost occurs when you recognize your life as a sinner and you repent of your sin and ask to be with God. You turn from the devil and walk in the light of the world, serving God. Baptism by water is but a sign and does nothing to guarantee salvation. This offers the biggest heartburn of all for those that are totally putting their trust only in water baptism to be with God.

The number three question is on the subject matter as to who is God. From the testimony of the witnesses, we know that God is the creator of the heavens and the earth and all that we see and don't see. No one has seen God at any time. The men have accepted the following lessons without heartburn. Many lessons are published in "Team Abba" that reinforces the truth in God's word. These include: God the Spirit, God Is, True God, One God, One Lord God and God is King.

The heartburn comes when you have been deceived into believing that Jesus is God and by believing that Jesus is God, somehow guarantees you everlasting life. Some religious denominations use a verse from John which implies that Jesus is the Word, therefore Jesus is God. We know that God accomplishes all things by his Word. In the lessons, Word and Jesus Is POE, the study of the witnesses and the testimonies leading to the doctrine that Jesus is a man, sent by God. From these testimonies you know the following:

Jesus referred to God as "my Father" One hundred and three (103) times in the New Testament. Witnesses: Matthew, Mark, Luke,

John, Paul, Peter and John in Revelations. It is clear, that Jesus is man and as the Son of God, God is his Father. Jesus respected his Father. God told you exactly how to worship him in spirit and truth.

- 1) There is one God, God the Father. Creator of heaven and earth. Do not worship idols.*
- 2) God the Father gave you the Son of God, Jesus, as a blood sacrifice for the forgiveness of the sins of the world.*
- 3) Holy Ghost is given by God to dwell in your heart, guiding you to be a light of life and to do the will of God.*

Jesus never declared himself to be a god or equal to God. He loved God, his Father, and did all things to please him. Jesus performed miracles as his apostles did, after he received the gift of the Holy Ghost.

Acts 10:38 - How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Before his death on the cross, Jesus asked the Father to forgive them!

Luke 23:34 - Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.

Believing that Jesus is but a man is major heartburn for many Christian believers. You see, it is easy to believe in the truth in God's doctrine established by two or three witnesses, when the study says that God does not require circumcision to enjoy everlasting life, because only one witness spoke of it in the New Testament.

The doctrine of two or three witnesses starts to be questionable when you learn that God does not require a tithe in the New Testament or that God wants women to serve equally with men in the New Testament. Only one witness Paul, spoke out against women serving in the church equal with men. Ignore Paul's testimony on this subject and if you are a woman and called to serve God, then serve him in all his glory using the talents he has given you.

Now ask yourself. Does God's doctrine and living your life per the will of God, change whether Jesus is a man or if you believe he is God. The answer is no. For most of you, it has given you a means to judge others that do not believe that Jesus is God. This is false doctrine leading to a false sense of security that implies you are going to heaven and all those that don't believe that Jesus is God are going to hell.

It is clear by the doctrine of two or three witnesses, that you will be judged by God when you die. The testimonies of the two men in my ministry that died and went to heaven and returned to earth, both said they talked to God. It is clear from the testimonies of Howard Pitman and MK McDaniels (Kathy) that when you show up at the gates of hell or heaven that God already knows what is in your heart. You have been judged already, based on your belief in God and how you have loved him and your neighbor here on earth. God made it clear that you are not to treat salvation as a commodity, as in silver and gold. It is not something you carry in your pocket, but carry in your heart shining forth to all in the glory of God.

Acts 17:29-31 - Forasmuch then as we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Godhead is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art and man's device. And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent: Because he hath appointed a day, in the

which he will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom he hath ordained; whereof he hath given assurance unto all men, in that he hath raised him from the dead.

For many members of this ministry, believing that you are saved or guaranteed everlasting life by just believing in Jesus, creates the most heartburn of all. This doctrine is not established by the testimony of two or three witness. If you are living your life per the will of God, then believing that you are saved or not saved, doesn't matter when it comes to the judgement by God. The problem comes when you think you are saved, being baptized in water and while walking with the devil, thinking you are going to heaven. In this condition, you are blaspheming the Holy Ghost. You are told not to blaspheme the Holy Ghost. When living your life in the state of sin, the witnesses refer to you being a backslider.

To cure that heartburn, just worship God in spirit and truth. Show your love of God, by loving your neighbor and always looking for ways to serve and doing the will of God with fervent acts of charity. Do not be afraid to share God's word and be a doer of his word. Make a New Years resolution to know the truth in God's word and do not be offended. Share God's message of salvation and look forward to being judged by God in the end. Hang-in there and looks for ways to share God's word and love!

Chapter 13: Saved the Sequel

My wife and I witnessed to some men this week that said they are saved. They took the “Best You Now” gospel tract, but implied they didn’t need it. What does it mean when someone says they are saved? Let’s review.

My wife and I won a court case this past year against a man and wife that said they are saved. They respect no one and are evil in their dealings with neighbors.

Several times a week a witness tells me that they are saved!

Let’s look at the Pharisee and the publican in Luke. Clearly the Pharisee believes he is saved as he judges himself against others! This is exactly what God has told you not to do! The publican knows he is a sinner and humbly begs for God’s mercy. God hears and will exalt the humble.

Luke 18:11-14 - The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican. I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess. And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner. I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.

It is no mystery that the word “saved” is the catch phrase used by man in modern day churches to make promises that only God can make! They may even throw in a work of water baptism and use this one witness verse as your justification to receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

Acts 2:38 - Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

An act of man cannot save you and give you the gift of the Holy Ghost. Jesus in the flesh could not give the gift of the Holy Ghost. He breathed on his followers in the upper chambers during Pentecost, but the Holy Ghost didn't come.

John 20:22 - And when he had said this, he breathed on them, and saith unto them, Receive ye the Holy Ghost:

It wasn't until Jesus ascended into heaven did God send the gift of the Holy Ghost to those followers that were not afraid to be a testimony for the Lord and assembled into the upper chambers. These followers had just witnessed the crucifixion of Jesus. Jesus was considered a heretic. These followers were aware of the consequences for being a follower of Jesus. Peter had just denied Jesus three times. These followers decided that being a witness and spreading the gospel of love was more valuable than their own life.

Acts 2:2,4 - And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

It is clear that the Holy Ghost is a gift of God that cannot be given by any act of man. If the Holy Ghost were a reward given by man, then Jesus could have promised the gift of the Holy Ghost and "eternal life" to the rich man. Jesus knew that he couldn't do that. Three witnesses offer testimony on Jesus's command to follow him. (Matthew 19:16-21, Luke 18:18-23, Mark 10:17-21)

Luke 18:18-23 - And a certain ruler asked him, saying, Good Master, what shall I do to inherit eternal life? And Jesus said unto him, Why callest thou me good? none is good, save one, that is, God. Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Honour thy father and thy mother. And he said, All these have I kept from my youth up. Now when Jesus heard these things, he said unto him, Yet lackest thou one thing: sell all that thou hast, and distribute unto the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, follow me. And when he heard this, he was very sorrowful: for he was very rich.

Jesus's command was simple. Come and follow him. God is looking for your change of heart and works of righteousness. Not by living a sinful life. Philip and then Peter and John testified to the Samaritans exactly what God is looking for. Simon practiced the art of sorcery and witchcraft to the Samaritans. He loved Philip's message. He was impressed with the miracles being performed. Simon asked if that gift could be purchased with money. Peter told him that his heart must be right with God.

Acts 8:9,12-15,17-24 - But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one: But when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women. Then Simon himself believed also: and when he was baptized, he continued with Philip, and wondered, beholding the miracles and signs which were done. Now when the apostles which were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent unto them Peter and John: Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Ghost: Then laid they their hands on them, and they received the Holy Ghost. And when Simon saw that through laying on

of the apostles' hands the Holy Ghost was given, he offered them money, Saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost. But Peter said unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou hast thought that the gift of God may be purchased with money. Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God. Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee. For I perceive that thou art in the gall of bitterness, and in the bond of iniquity. Then answered Simon, and said, Pray ye to the Lord for me, that none of these things which ye have spoken come upon me.

Joseph of Arimathea was a rich man and a disciple that cared for Jesus. He made sure that Jesus received a proper burial. His heart was right with God. Medieval interests have recorded Joseph as the founder of British Christianity.

Matthew 27:57-61 - When the even was come, there came a rich man of Arimathea, named Joseph, who also himself was Jesus' disciple: He went to Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus. Then Pilate commanded the body to be delivered. And when Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, And laid it in his own new tomb, which he had hewn out in the rock: and he rolled a great stone to the door of the sepulchre, and departed.

John 19:38 - And after this Joseph of Arimathea, being a disciple of Jesus, but secretly for fear of the Jews, besought Pilate that he might take away the body of Jesus: and Pilate gave him leave. He came therefore, and took the body of Jesus.

It is clear that when you believe, your heart is right with God and you follow the teachings of Jesus by doing the will of God.

Endure to the end and look forward to God's judgment. The testimony of the witnesses could not have been clearer.

1 Peter 4:16-19 - Yet if any man suffer as a Christian, let him not be ashamed; but let him glorify God on this behalf. For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God? And if the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear? Wherefore let them that suffer according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls to him in well doing, as unto a faithful Creator.

Do not be lured into believing that your salvation is a function of following the acts of man, walking after the flesh and living a life of sin. The Lord will know how to deliver you out of temptations.

2 Peter 2:9-10,15-16,19-20 - The Lord knoweth how to deliver the godly out of temptations, and to reserve the unjust unto the day of judgment to be punished: But chiefly them that walk after the flesh in the lust of uncleanness, and despise government. Presumptuous are they, selfwilled, they are not afraid to speak evil of dignities. Which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray, following the way of Balaam the son of Bosor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness; But was rebuked for his iniquity: the dumb ass speaking with man's voice forbad the madness of the prophet. While they promise them liberty, they themselves are the servants of corruption: for of whom a man is overcome, of the same is he brought in bondage. For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning.

God anointed Jesus with the Holy Ghost and he did the will of God.

Acts 10:37-38 - That word, I say, ye know, which was published throughout all Judaea, and began from Galilee, after the baptism which John preached; How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Do not be offended by the truth in God's word. Do not be lured into believing that you are "saved" and do nothing for the Lord. In this year of 2025, plan on living in the spirit, doing the will of God and serving your neighbor! To spread the gospel and the love of God.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 14: The Brick

As you study God's word, you'll read his word many times. As you read the testimony of the witnesses, one or several testimonies may influence your understanding of another. Three times in Acts, the sanctification of Saul into Paul on the way to Damascus were presented. Three testimonies of the sanctification of Saul are similar but different. From the testimony of these three witnesses, you shall know the truth.

- 1) God wanted all three of these testimonies in Acts.*
- 2) Jesus spoke to Saul by the means of a bright light.*
- 3) Jesus did not speak to Saul by means of a body.*
- 4) First and second witnesses, said that Saul was led by the hand into Damascus. Saul as also the third witness did not report this fact. Saul may have deemed this fact insignificant and did not report it to King Agrippa.*
- 5) The first testimony said the associates heard the voice, with no body. The second testimony said his associates did not hear a voice. The third testimony doesn't address the associates hearing a voice. Thus, it is not clear if the associates heard the voice or not. If the first testimony was of one of the associates, then from the first-hand reporting standard, then the associates heard the voice of Jesus.*
- 6) Jesus gave simple instructions in the first and second testimonies. Saul appears to expand on the instructions in the third testimony.*

You can see from this example that you must use two or three witness to establish God's Will in the New Testament.

My friend Bill has read over these verses for over forty years. God's word was clear. Share God's word, freely.

Matthew 10:7-14 - And as ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand. Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give. Provide neither gold, nor silver, nor brass in your purses, Nor scrip for your journey, neither two coats, neither shoes, nor yet staves: for the workman is worthy of his meat.

Mark 6:6-9 - And he marvelled because of their unbelief. And he went round about the villages, teaching. And he called unto him the twelve, and began to send them forth by two and two; and gave them power over unclean spirits; And commanded them that they should take nothing for their journey, save a staff only; no scrip, no bread, no money in their purse: But be shod with sandals; and not put on two coats.

Luke 9:3 - And he said unto them, Take nothing for your journey, neither staves, nor scrip, neither bread, neither money; neither have two coats apiece.

Recently, while studying the bible, God's word hit me like a brick. Over the past several months, I had completed several Bible Matters on God including, God Is, True God, One God, One Lord God and God is King. You also know that Jesus is a man sent by God. Jesus never declared himself to be a god or equal to God. He loved God, his Father, and did all things to please him. Jesus performed miracles as his apostles did, after they received the gift of the Holy Ghost. As I was reading Acts, two chapters reinforced the lessons presented on God and Jesus. Both Peter and John spoke these testimonies. It is clear that all things are directed by the Lord God, the Father. God sent his Son as told by Moses, as a prophet, to turn everyone from his iniquities.

Acts 3:1-2,4-6,8-10,13-15,18-22,25-26 - Now Peter and John went up together into the temple at the hour of prayer, being the ninth hour. And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms of them that entered into the temple; And Peter, fastening his eyes upon him with John, said, Look on us. And he gave heed unto them, expecting to receive something of them. Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk. And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God. And all the people saw him walking and praising God: And they knew that it was he which sat for alms at the Beautiful gate of the temple: and they were filled with wonder and amazement at that which had happened unto him. The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath glorified his Son Jesus; whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let him go. But ye denied the Holy One and the Just, and desired a murderer to be granted unto you; And killed the Prince of life, whom God hath raised from the dead; whereof we are witnesses. But those things, which God before had shewed by the mouth of all his prophets, that Christ should suffer, he hath so fulfilled. Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord; And he shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you: Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began. For Moses truly said unto the fathers, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you. Ye are the children of the prophets, and of the

covenant which God made with our fathers, saying unto Abraham, And in thy seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed. Unto you first God, having raised up his Son Jesus, sent him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities.

Peter and John testified that God raised Jesus from the dead. Jesus is the Christ, sent by God. The same God which had made heaven, earth, and the sea, and all that are in them. Once filled with the Holy Ghost, they spoke the word of God with boldness.

Acts 4:1-2,7-10,13-14,18-21,24-27,29-31 - And as they spake unto the people, the priests, and the captain of the temple, and the Sadducees, came upon them, Being grieved that they taught the people, and preached through Jesus the resurrection from the dead. And when they had set them in the midst, they asked, By what power, or by what name, have ye done this? Then Peter, filled with the Holy Ghost, said unto them, Ye rulers of the people, and elders of Israel, If we this day be examined of the good deed done to the impotent man, by what means he is made whole; Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole. Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marvelled; and they took knowledge of them, that they had been with Jesus. And beholding the man which was healed standing with them, they could say nothing against it. And they called them, and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus. But Peter and John answered and said unto them, Whether it be right in the sight of God to hearken unto you more than unto God, judge ye. For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard. So when they had

further threatened them, they let them go, finding nothing how they might punish them, because of the people: for all men glorified God for that which was done. And when they heard that, they lifted up their voice to God with one accord, and said, Lord, thou art God, which hast made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all that in them is: Who by the mouth of thy servant David hast said, Why did the heathen rage, and the people imagine vain things? The kings of the earth stood up, and the rulers were gathered together against the Lord, and against his Christ. For of a truth against thy holy child Jesus, whom thou hast anointed, both Herod, and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles, and the people of Israel, were gathered together, And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word, By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus. And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.

God anointed Jesus with the Holy Ghost and he did the will of God. Do not be offended by the truth in God's word. When God anoints you with the Holy Ghost, you live, serve and speak the word of God with boldness. In this year of 2025, plan on living in the spirit, doing the will of God and serving the Lord! To spread his gospel and the love of God.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 15: One Witness

God was clear in the Old and New Testaments that the truth in his word can only be obtained out of the mouth of two or three witnesses. Four times in the Old Testament and seven times in the New Testament, witness testimony has been provided from multiple witnesses that establishes God's standard for establishing the truth out of the mouth of two or three witnesses. Two witnesses have provided testimony that God is also clear that the testimony of one witness shall not be used to put one to death or to rise up against an iniquity.

Numbers 35:30 - Whoso killeth any person, the murderer shall be put to death by the mouth of witnesses: but one witness shall not testify against any person to cause him to die.

Deuteronomy 17:6 - At the mouth of two witnesses, or three witnesses, shall he that is worthy of death be put to death; but at the mouth of one witness, he shall not be put to death.

Deuteronomy 19:15 - One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.

We've studied multiple one witness testimonies in the New Testament. One witness testimony does not establish God's doctrine for his gospel of Love in the New Testament. You'll recognize some of the false doctrine that has been studied already.

Only one verse in Acts gave testimony that certain men from Judea wanted to impose the Jewish religious work of circumcision to be saved. Of course, in this verse it is not clear exactly what saved means. Jesus was the minister of the circumcision of the heart. All that matters is that you are a new creature that

surrenders to God and turns from sin. Your belief in one God is by faith. That is what matters.

Acts 15:1 - And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved.

Romans 2:25-27 - For circumcision verily profiteth, if thou keep the law: but if thou be a breaker of the law, thy circumcision is made uncircumcision. Therefore if the uncircumcision keep the righteousness of the law, shall not his uncircumcision be counted for circumcision? And shall not uncircumcision which is by nature, if it fulfil the law, judge thee, who by the letter and circumcision dost transgress the law?

Romans 15:8 - Now I say that Jesus Christ was a minister of the circumcision for the truth of God, to confirm the promises made unto the fathers:

Galatians 6:15 - For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision, but a new creature.

Romans 3:30 - Seeing it is one God, which shall justify the circumcision by faith, and uncircumcision through faith.

You also know that God wants women to serve in his ministry, side by side and equal with men, delivering his gospel of Love in the New Testament. Only one witness, Paul, spoke out against women serving in God's ministry. This is false doctrine that Paul delivered. Just because he spoke about women not serving in two messages, does not make his testimony that of two witnesses. It is still but one witness testimony and is to be ignored!

1 Corinthians 14:34-35 - Let your women keep silence in the churches: for it is not permitted unto them to speak; but they are commanded to be under obedience, as also saith the law.

And if they will learn any thing, let them ask their husbands at home: for it is a shame for women to speak in the church.

1 Timothy 2:9-12 - In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array; But (which becometh women professing godliness) with good works. Let the woman learn in silence with all subjection. But I suffer not a woman to teach, nor to usurp authority over the man, but to be in silence.

It has been clear in these men driven ministries, that they have offended God's little ones by exercising false doctrine out of the mouth of one witness. If you are a woman that feels qualified to serve the Lord, then serve and make God proud!

Mark 9:42 - And whosoever shall offend one of these little ones that believe in me, it is better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he were cast into the sea.

Christians celebrate in remembrance of Jesus's last supper before his death on the cross. Multiple witnesses have provided testimony of this event! Eating or drinking the bread (i.e. body) and the wine (i.e. blood) of Christ means nothing, unless the word of God changes your heart.

Matthew 26:26-28 - And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed it, and brake it, and gave it to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body. And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, Drink ye all of it; For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

Mark 14:22-24 - And as they did eat, Jesus took bread, and blessed, and brake it, and gave to them, and said, Take, eat: this is my body. And he took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he

gave it to them: and they all drank of it. And he said unto them, This is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many.

Luke 22:19-20 - And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake it, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me. Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you.

1 Corinthians 10:16 - The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ?

Hebrews 9:20,22 - Saying, This is the blood of the testament which God hath enjoined unto you. And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.

Only one witness provides testimony that one should not partake of the bread and wine unworthily. One is required to repent of your sins to start your walk with the Lord. Humble yourself and repent of you sins daily to keep you walk with the Lord pure.

1 Corinthians 11:24-25,27-28 - And when he had given thanks, he brake it, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me. After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me. Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink this cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord. But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup.

Only one witness provides testimony that when you eat and drink the body and blood of Jesus shall you live forever and have everlasting life.

John 6:47-51,53-58 - Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life. I am that bread of life. Your fathers did eat manna in the wilderness, and are dead. This is the bread which cometh down from heaven, that a man may eat thereof, and not die. I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live forever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world. Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have no life in you. Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day. For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed. He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him. As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me. This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live forever.

From the preponderance of standard, it is clear that one-off testimonies mean nothing. God wants you to celebrate the body and blood of Christ celebration as performed by Jesus during the last supper on Pentecost in remembrance of him. Just doing this alone will not guarantee everlasting life in heaven.

From the testimony of the witnesses, it is clear that God requires you to do the will of God for his gift of everlasting life. God sent his gospel of Love to the Jews and Gentiles through Jesus. Jesus had a monumental task. The Jews loved and served no one but themselves. They shared the love of God with no one.

The laws of religious works required the Jews to burn, sacrifice and offer animals daily for the forgiveness of sins. The church offered them righteousness by their sacrifices. This method of self-righteousness showed no love of neighbor. Jesus offered his sacrifice on the cross as a way to turn the Jews away from the worship of self to the worship and love of God and love of neighbor.

God gave you two commandments in the New Testament.

- *Love God*
- *Love Neighbor*

Jesus Christ was sent by God the Father to present to man, the gospel of Love. One is to live a godly life, loving and serving God and his neighbor. These are the words that the Lord Jesus brought to man

1 Timothy 6:3 - If any man teach otherwise, and consent not to wholesome words, even the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to the doctrine which is according to godliness;

The works and laws of animal sacrifice are destroyed. These are the works that Paul refers to in his messages. Jesus said he would destroy the temple in three days. The Temple curtain split in two when Jesus died on the cross. The law of serving self was destroyed. The law of serving God and neighbor was created by faith in the teachings of God. With his death on the cross, Jesus was obedient to the will of God. Multiple witnesses have provided testimony of his death on the cross.

Matthew 27:42 - He saved others; himself he cannot save. If he be the King of Israel, let him now come down from the cross, and we will believe him.

Mark 15:32,39 - Let Christ the King of Israel descend now from the cross, that we may see and believe. And they that were crucified with him reviled him. And when the centurion, which stood over against him, saw that he so cried out, and gave up the ghost, he said, Truly this man was the Son of God.

Luke 23:33 - And when they were come to the place, which is called Calvary, there they crucified him, and the malefactors, one on the right hand, and the other on the left.

John 19:23,30 - Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took his garments, and made four parts, to every soldier a part; and also his coat: now the coat was without seam, woven from the top throughout. When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, It is finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.

Philippians 2:8 - And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

Consistent with the use of the word "save" in the Old and New Testament, "saved" was the avoidance of destruction by the enemy or physical death, saved from violence or to be saved from wrath.

2 Samuel 22:3 - The God of my rock; in him will I trust: he is my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge, my saviour; thou savest me from violence.

Matthew 27:42 - He saved others; himself he cannot save. If he be the King of Israel, let him now come down from the cross, and we will believe him.

Romans 5:8-9 - But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then,

being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.

Hebrews 11:7 - By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.

Jude 1:5 - I will therefore put you in remembrance, though ye once knew this, how that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that believed not.

A review of God's word for testimony providing evidence of "Saved" meaning everlasting life or eternal life is not present in the New Testament. None of the eight New Testament witness testimonies have ever defined saved as meaning eternal life. Only one time in the Old Testament has one witness used saved in conjunction with everlasting salvation. To blindly assume that everywhere in the New Testament that the word "saved" implies "everlasting life" is false doctrine.

Isaiah 45:15-18 - Verily thou art a God that hidest thyself, O God of Israel, the Saviour. They shall be ashamed, and also confounded, all of them: they shall go to confusion together that are makers of idols. But Israel shall be saved in the Lord with an everlasting salvation: ye shall not be ashamed nor confounded world without end. For thus saith the Lord that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I am the Lord ; and there is none else.

One witness has provided testimonies which states that when you believe in the Son of God should not perish and have everlasting life.

John 3:16 - For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

John 3:36 - He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.

John 5:24 - Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.

John 6:40,47 - And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day. Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life.

In contrast to one just believing unto eternal life, multiple witnesses have testified that when you believe you do the will of God. You do because you believe. The man of God is to be thoroughly furnished unto good works. Your faith is shown by your works.

Matthew 7:21 - Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

John 3:19,21 - And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.

3 John 1:4-7,11 - I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth. Beloved, thou doest faithfully whatsoever thou

doest to the brethren, and to strangers; Which have borne witness of thy charity before the church: whom if thou bring forward on their journey after a godly sort, thou shalt do well: Because that for his name's sake they went forth, taking nothing of the Gentiles. Beloved, follow not that which is evil, but that which is good. He that doeth good is of God: but he that doeth evil hath not seen God.

2 Timothy 3:15-17 - And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works.

Hebrews 6:10 - For God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have shewed toward his name, in that ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister.

1 Peter 2:11-12,15-16 - Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul; Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by your good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation. For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men: As free, and not using your liberty for a cloke of maliciousness, but as the servants of God.

1 Peter 5:2 - Feed the flock of God which is among you, taking the oversight thereof, not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind;

James 2:14,17 - What doth it profit, my brethren, though a man say he hath faith, and have not works? can faith save him? Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone.

James 4:17 - Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.

Above all, God requires you to do the will of God. To glorify God and his gospel of Love in all that you do. Not by saying you just believe, but by picking up your cross and following Jesus. When you celebrate the last supper in remembrance of Jesus, you shall live by Jesus's teachings.

Peter 1:3,5,17,21-23 - Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. And if ye call on the Father, who without respect of persons judgeth according to every man's work, pass the time of your sojourning here in fear: Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God. Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently: Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

1 Peter 4:16-19 - Yet if any man suffer as a Christian, let him not be ashamed; but let him glorify God on this behalf. For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God? And if the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear? Wherefore let

them that suffer according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls to him in well doing, as unto a faithful Creator.

James 1:18-22 - Of his own will begat he us with the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures. Wherefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath: For the wrath of man worketh not the righteousness of God. Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls. But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.

Matthew 19:16-17,21-22 - And, behold, one came and said unto him, Good Master, what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life? And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments. Jesus said unto him, If thou wilt be perfect, go and sell that thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come and follow me. But when the young man heard that saying, he went away sorrowful: for he had great possessions.

Mark 10:17-21 - And when he was gone forth into the way, there came one running, and kneeled to him, and asked him, Good Master, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life? And Jesus said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God. Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honour thy father and mother. And he answered and said unto him, Master, all these have I observed from my youth. Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt

have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow me.

John 9:31 - Now we know that God heareth not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper of God, and doeth his will, him he heareth.

1 John 4:4,6-7,21 - Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world. We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error. Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God. And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also.

God's gospel of love is not established by one witness testimonies.

- *Circumcision doesn't do it.*
- *Celebrating the last supper doesn't do it.*
- *Believing to be saved doesn't do it.*

God wants women in his ministry.

Using multiple witness testimonies, men and women doing the will of God and following his gospel of love does it.

God gave you two commandments in the New Testament.

- *Love God*
- *Love Neighbor*

One is to live a godly life, loving and serving God and his neighbor.

Do not be offended by the truth in God's word out of the mouth of two or three witnesses by using the preponderance of evidence standard. In this year of 2025, plan on turning from sin, living in the spirit and to live together as Godly people, doing the will of God and serving him! To spread God's gospel of Love. Endure to the end and look forward to being judged by God, enjoying everlasting life in heaven.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 16: Deception and Truth

Throughout the New Testament, one witness testimonies abound.

How man has chosen to believe and use one witness testimonies has led to hate and deception among the countless number of religions. These religions have chosen one witness testimonies as the Holy Grail to their salvation in the kingdom of God. In God's eye, this is all deception, heaped upon man. God is not the author of confusion.

1 Corinthians 14:33 - For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints.

You may like the single witness verse that implies that Jesus is God and because he is God you have special privileges.

John 10:30 - I and my Father are one.

You may like the single witness verse that says if you believe in Jesus, then you shalt be saved.

Acts 16:31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.

You can't differentiate the meaning of saved in the New Testament as it has many meanings in different verses. So, you love this one witness verse and use it as your guarantee to everlasting life.

John 3:16 - For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

You may like the preaching that says your past, present and future sins have been forgiven. Because you believe in Jesus, you have everlasting life guaranteed and can't lose it. Your salvation is guaranteed by Jesus.

John 10:28 - And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.

With no regard for sin because of false preaching or false teaching, you go out and live your life for the glory of you, enjoying alcohol and drugs. The love the feeling of being numb to the world. You have all the time in the world for self, but none for the things of God.

Do not be deceived. You dig a little deeper and find conflicting evidence. Getting drunk is no big deal, except this one witness verse cautions you against drunkenness. According to this one verse, you won't see the kingdom of God.

1 Corinthians 6:10 -Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.

A once true believer in one witness verses you then find a one witness verse said only your past sins are forgiven.

Romans 3:25 - Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;

It is clear from the truth in God's word that those that do the will of God the Father shall inherit the kingdom of God.

Matthew 21:31 - Whether of them twain did the will of his father?
They say unto him, The first. Jesus saith unto them, Verily I say unto you, That the publicans and the harlots go into the kingdom of God before you.

The doctrine established by the clear and preponderance of evidence testimony from the mouth of two or three witnesses is the truth in God's word. God's word is not found hidden between words with implied meanings. There are no hidden

*verses that are to be treated as the Holy Grail of salvation.
Once you understand the truth from the mouth of two or three
witnesses, you can't forget it. God wants you to turn from sin,
be the light of the world and not abide in darkness.*

Philippians 2:15 That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world;

Matthew 5:14 Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.

John 1:9 That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.

John 3:19 - And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.

John 8:12 - Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

John 12:46 - I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness.

2 Corinthians 4:4 - In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

Philippians 2:15 - That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world;

Jesus told his disciples, "to come and follow me."

Matthew 10:38 - And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me.

Matthew 16:24 - Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.

Mark 8:34 - And when he had called the people unto him with his disciples also, he said unto them, Whosoever will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.

Mark 10:21 - Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow me.

Luke 9:23 - And he said to them all, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me.

John 10:27 - My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

John 21:19,22 - This spake he, signifying by what death he should glorify God. And when he had spoken this, he saith unto him, Follow me. Jesus saith unto him, If I will that he tarry till I come, what is that to thee? follow thou me.

The witnesses could not have been clearer in their testimonies that when you believe in Jesus, you follow his lead. You follow his teachings. You start to come around to the preponderance of evidence and recognize that Jesus told his disciples that he will not drink of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God. If you are to follow Jesus, as told to you by Jesus, then you too should not drink of the fruit of the vine.

Matthew 26:29 - But I say unto you, I will not drink henceforth of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom.

Luke 22:18 - For I say unto you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine, until the kingdom of God shall come.

Mark 14:25 - Verily I say unto you, I will drink no more of the fruit of the vine, until that day that I drink it new in the kingdom of God.

God's word is clear. When you follow Jesus, you follow his doctrine and do the will of God. Always ready to share his love, truth and gospel by not walking in sin and darkness. As a believer, you turn from sin and do the will of God. Do not be deceived. It is your responsibility to understand the truth in God's word from the mouth of two or three witnesses. You have testimony that cautions you to know the truth and worship only the creator!

Romans 1:25 - Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen.

Start your walk by serving God and the things of God. Worship the creator and give him glory in everything you do.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 17: Game Plan

God's word is the most powerful weapon on planet earth, bar none! God is Lord. The word of the Lord appears 420 times in the Old Testament and 21 times in the New Testament. Since no one has seen God at any time, we know that God created all things by his word. From nothing, all things were created. God the Father is the one and only Lord, the Creator and most High. Believe in this and your walk with the Lord God has begun. A walk giving glory to only the creator and not the creature.

Romans 1:20-25 - For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse: Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened. Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools, And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things. Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves: Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen.

1 Peter 1:21,23,25 - Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God. Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever. But the word of the Lord endureth forever. And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you.

“The word of the Lord” in the New Testaments refers to the words that both God and Jesus spoke. The words that Jesus spoke does not make him God the Creator. Jesus spoke the words to God’s gospel of love, that God gave to the earth, so that all could live in peace. To follow that commandment given to Moses, thou shall not kill. Man was no longer going to rule the earth. God as King and Lord is in charge. God as your Savior.

John 1:17-18 - For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ. No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.

Your walk in righteousness is according to God’s word in godliness. For this is the will of God that your walk be pure. Your works and walk will put to silence the ignorance of foolish men.

1 Timothy 6:3 - If any man teach otherwise, and consent not to wholesome words, even the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to the doctrine which is according to godliness;

1 Timothy 4:8 - For bodily exercise profiteth little: but godliness is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come.

1 Peter 2:12-13,15-17 - Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by your good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation. Submit yourselves to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake: whether it be to the king, as supreme; For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men: As free, and not using your liberty for a cloke of maliciousness, but as the servants of God. Honour all men. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honour the king.:

Willing to lead in love, peace, godliness, honesty, kindness and charity. Not for the love of money, but for the love of God and neighbor, following after righteousness. Ready always unto the coming of the day of God unto eternal life.

1 Timothy 2:2-3 - For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour;

2 Peter 1:3-7 - According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity.

1 Timothy 6:1,6-7,10-11,17-19 - Let as many servants as are under the yoke count their own masters worthy of all honour, that the name of God and his doctrine be not blasphemed. But godliness with contentment is great gain. For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out. For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows. But thou, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness. Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy; That they do good, that they be rich in good

works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate; Laying up in store for themselves a good foundation against the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life.

James 3:13,17-18 - Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? let him shew out of a good conversation his works with meekness of wisdom. But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace.

2 Peter 3:11-12 - Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness, Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?

In this year of blessing, look to please God with good works, ready to distribute and willing to communicate. Always ready to share God's love and word.

1 Timothy 6:18 - That they do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate;

Your walk must be in patience per the will of God. To be your best by feeding his flock with a ready mind. Do not deny God!

Hebrews 10:24,36 - And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.

Titus 3:8,14 - This is a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, that they which have believed in God might be careful to maintain good works. These things are

good and profitable unto men. And let ours also learn to maintain good works for necessary uses, that they be not unfruitful.

1 Peter 5:2 - Feed the flock of God which is among you, taking the oversight thereof, not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind;

Titus 1:15-16 - Unto the pure all things are pure: but unto them that are defiled and unbelieving is nothing pure; but even their mind and conscience is defiled. They profess that they know God; but in works they deny him, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate.

Saul as a Pharisee taught and practiced the works of animal and blood sacrifice to the Jews. The apostles and Paul taught that the works of animal worship means nothing. Forgiveness of sins is only possible with a surrender to God and a change of heart, conversion or born-again spirit from a lover of sin to a lover of righteousness and godliness. God is looking for your good works. Your good works give glory to God and is a testimony of your love of God and love of neighbor.

Matthew 5:16 - Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

Do not be offended by the truth in God's word out of the mouth of two or three witnesses by using the preponderance of evidence standard. In this year of 2025, plan on turning from sin, living in the spirit and to live together as Godly people, doing the will of God and serving him! To spread God's gospel of love. Endure to the end and look forward to being judged by God and enjoying everlasting life in heaven.

Chapter 18: Lord thy God

The worship and love of the Lord thy God, as mandated by God's prophets, is the common message. Out of the mouth of two or three witnesses, you shall know the truth in God's word. It was given to you by Moses, repeated by Jesus Christ and his multiple witnesses, reinforced by Muhammed and in the teachings of Hindu. When you love the Lord thy God, you love your neighbor.

John 8:17 - It is also written in your law, that the testimony of two men is true.

If you hate your neighbor, who you see, then you can't claim to love the Lord thy God who you can't see. In the state of mind of hating your neighbor, your practice of religion in the eyes of God means nothing. In this state of mind of walking in darkness, you have no fear of the Lord thy God.

1 John 4:20 - If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?

When you fear the Lord, you obey the voice of his servants.

Isaiah 50:10 - Who is among you that feareth the Lord, that obeyeth the voice of his servant, that walketh in darkness, and hath no light? let him trust in the name of the Lord, and stay upon his God.

Wisdom and knowledge of the truth in God's word shall be your stability and strength. The Lord thy God is exalted, when you walk in the light per the voice of his servants.

Isaiah 33:5-6 - The Lord is exalted; for he dwelleth on high: he hath filled Zion with judgment and righteousness. And wisdom and

knowledge shall be the stability of thy times, and strength of salvation: the fear of the Lord is his treasure.

When Moses brought the Hebrews out of bondage by the Egyptians, The Lord thy God gave Moses the ten commandments. Worship of only the Lord thy God, was first on the list. God shows mercy on those that love him and keep his commandments.

Exodus 20:2-6 - I am the Lord thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. Thou shalt have no other gods before me. Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the Lord thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

Deuteronomy 4:2 - Ye shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish ought from it, that ye may keep the commandments of the Lord your God which I command you.

Love of the Lord thy God is from the heart.

Deuteronomy 6:1-2,4-6,13-18 - Now these are the commandments, the statutes, and the judgments, which the Lord your God commanded to teach you, that ye might do them in the land whither ye go to possess it: That thou mightest fear the Lord thy God, to keep all his statutes and his commandments, which I command thee, thou, and thy son, and thy son's son, all the days of thy life; and that thy days may be prolonged. Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God is one Lord: And thou shalt love the

Lord thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might. And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: Thou shalt fear the Lord thy God, and serve him, and shalt swear by his name. Ye shall not go after other gods, of the gods of the people which are round about you;

1 Chronicles 28:9 - And thou, Solomon my son, know thou the God of thy father, and serve him with a perfect heart and with a willing mind: for the Lord searcheth all hearts, and understandeth all the imaginations of the thoughts: if thou seek him, he will be found of thee; but if thou forsake him, he will cast thee off forever.

Matthew 22:37-39 - Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.

Mark 12:29-31 - And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord: And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment.

When you worship the Lord thy God, only him do you serve! When you serve your neighbor, you serve the Lord thy God.

Deuteronomy 10:19-21 - Love ye therefore the stranger: for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt. Thou shalt fear the Lord thy God; him shalt thou serve, and to him shalt thou cleave, and swear by his name. He is thy praise, and he is thy God, that hath done for thee these great and terrible things, which thine eyes have seen.

Matthew 4:10 Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.

Luke 4:8 - And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.

Let your light shine before men and glorify the Lord thy God which is in heaven.

Matthew 5:14-16 - Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

Today, decide to repent from sin, surrender and turn to the Lord thy God. Live your life unto righteousness, serving God and serving your neighbor. In the end, God, you and his world wins.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 19: Spirit of God

It is no mystery that holy ones of God lived a life unto righteousness as they were filled with the Spirit of God. This spirit guided them in a manner to do and serve as directed by God. You all know the story of Noah. God saw righteousness and Noah did as directed by God. Noah and his family lived because they did as the Lord commanded.

Genesis 7:1,4-5,23 - And the Lord said unto Noah, Come thou and all thy house into the ark; for thee have I seen righteous before me in this generation. For yet seven days, and I will cause it to rain upon the earth forty days and forty nights; and every living substance that I have made will I destroy from off the face of the earth. And Noah did according unto all that the Lord commanded him. And every living substance was destroyed which was upon the face of the ground, both man, and cattle, and the creeping things, and the fowl of the heaven; and they were destroyed from the earth: and Noah only remained alive, and they that were with him in the ark.

When I started my dedicated walk with the Lord God and having a desire the understand his word, this one verse pricked my heart.

Proverbs 30:5-6 - Every word of God is pure: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him. Add thou not unto his words, lest he reprove thee, and thou be found a liar.

At that point in my life, I had been involved with my addiction forty years. God had waited forty years for me to turn to him. As I look back on that date, 12/3/13, my life has changed to give God the glory in all that I do. My addictions are but a distant memory. After spending, 8 years studying the truth in God's word, I know how God directed the righteous in the New Testament. You start by repenting of and turning from your

sins. When the church I attended with the jail ministry, had promoted the giving the gift of the Holy Ghost and saving men, I knew it was wrong. God then gave me that ministry to teach the men the truth. When you do as directed by God, he will set you free. I had grown up knowing of the Spirit of God (ie. Holy Ghost), but I never used the Spirit of God to serve him. The Spirit of God will give you life.

Job 33:4 - The Spirit of God hath made me, and the breath of the Almighty hath given me life.

The Spirit of God, holy Spirit and Holy Ghost are used throughout the Old and New Testament. In the bible, the Spirit of God is used fourteen times in the Old Testament and twelve times in the New Testament. Holy Spirit is used three times in the Old Testament and four times in the New Testament. The Holy Ghost is used eighty-nine times in the New Testament. The Spirit of God was in the beginning. The Spirit will give you the wisdom that you need to know.

Genesis 1:1-2 - In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.

Exodus 31:3 - And I have filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, and in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship,

The direction provided by the Spirit of God, may not always be pleasing in your sight. Man plans and God directs. When God directs, you act.

1 Samuel 11:6 - And the Spirit of God came upon Saul when he heard those tidings, and his anger was kindled greatly.

2 Chronicles 15:1 - And the Spirit of God came upon Azariah the son of Oded:

It is immediately clear in the New Testament, that the Spirit of God and Holy Ghost comes down from God. Mary was found with child of the Holy Ghost.

Matthew 1:18 - Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise:
When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost.

Matthew 3:16 - And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:

Luke 3:21-22 - Now when all the people were baptized, it came to pass, that Jesus also being baptized, and praying, the heaven was opened, And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased.

Mark 1:9-11 - And it came to pass in those days, that Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee, and was baptized of John in Jordan. And straightway coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens opened, and the Spirit like a dove descending upon him: And there came a voice from heaven, saying, Thou art my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

When the Spirit comes, you know it and will lead you according to God's plan. Jesus was not planning on going into the wilderness, but he did.

Luke 4:1 - And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost returned from Jordan, and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness,

Mark 1:12 - And immediately the Spirit driveth him into the wilderness.

The Spirit led Jesus to Jacob's well to be a witness to the Samaritan woman who had five husbands. Jesus did as commanded by the Spirit of God.

John 4:4,6-7,18 - And he must needs go through Samaria. Now Jacob's well was there. Jesus therefore, being wearied with his journey, sat thus on the well: and it was about the sixth hour. There cometh a woman of Samaria to draw water: Jesus saith unto her, Give me to drink. For thou hast had five husbands; and he whom thou now hast is not thy husband: in that saidst thou truly.

Jesus living in the spirit, did as commanded by the Spirit of God. The natural man in the flesh cannot please God. When you are led by the Spirit, you are the sons of God. Therefore, let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth.

1 Corinthians 2:14 - But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

Romans 8:7-9,14 - Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be. So, then they that are in the flesh cannot please God. But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his. For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

Ephesians 4:29-30 - Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers. And grieve not the

holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

Jesus came in the flesh to purge you of your sins. Cleansed from sins through the blood of Jesus. The Spirit of God is sent to those that are of God. To those that have turned to God and converted and to be born again by the word of God as a little child. To humble yourself with a heart of love for the things of God. The salvation of God is available to both Jew and Gentile. God which knowest the heart, gives the gift of the Holy Ghost to those that obey him accordingly to his will.

Hebrews 9:14 - How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

1 John 4:1-2 - Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God:

Matthew 18:3-4 - And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven. Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

John 3:3 - Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

1 Peter 1:21-23 - Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God. Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying

the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently: Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

Acts 28:27-28 - For the heart of this people is waxed gross, and their ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes have they closed; lest they should see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and should be converted, and I should heal them. Be it known therefore unto you, that the salvation of God is sent unto the Gentiles, and that they will hear it.

Acts 15:8 - And God, which knoweth the hearts, bare them witness, giving them the Holy Ghost, even as he did unto us;

Acts 5:32 - And we are his witnesses of these things; and so is also the Holy Ghost, whom God hath given to them that obey him.

Hebrews 2:4 - God also bearing them witness, both with signs and wonders, and with divers miracles, and gifts of the Holy Ghost, according to his own will?

God knows your heart. When your heart is right with God, he sends the gift of the Holy Ghost. Man has no patience for the gift of the Holy Ghost sent by God. Jesus could not give the gift of the Holy Ghost. He said receive ye the Holy Ghost, but the Holy Ghost did not descend onto his followers, but later sent by God after Jesus ascended into heaven.

John 20:22 - And when he had said this, he breathed on them, and saith unto them, Receive ye the Holy Ghost:

John 20:17 - Jesus saith unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father: but go to my brethren, and say unto

them, I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; and to my God, and your God.

It is no coincidence that man tries to purchase the Holy Ghost or promise the gift of the Holy Ghost with water baptism.

Acts 8:20-22 - But Peter said unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou hast thought that the gift of God may be purchased with money. Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God. Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee.

Start your walk by serving God and the things of God. To know his word and keep his commandments. Worship the creator and give him glory in everything you do.

John 14:15-16,26 - If ye love me, keep my commandments. And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you forever; But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 20: Serving God

When you put your trust in God, you can't serve God and money. You are told that it is one or the other. God has given you talents that he is looking for you to use to serve him. The problem with man is that one likes to compare what one is doing and judging it against others. All to justify a menial service to God. The common misconception is that you go to church on Sunday and your service to the Lord is done for the week. You judge this service as acceptable because that is what all the other church goers are doing! Not long after Jesus rose from the dead and witnessed to his disciples and left, Peter told the followers that he was going fishing and asked if anyone wanted to come along!

John 21:3 - Simon Peter saith unto them, I go a fishing. They say unto him, We also go with thee. They went forth, and entered into a ship immediately; and that night they caught nothing.

Jesus arrived at the fishing spot in the morning after a night of catching nothing and he instructed the disciple to fish on the right side of the boat and they caught many fish. After dinner, Peter was comparing his service to the service of the one that Jesus loved. Jesus gave Peter a simple instruction, "Don't you worry about him, but follow thou me."

John 21:14-17,19-22 - This is now the third time that Jesus shewed himself to his disciples, after that he was risen from the dead. So when they had dined, Jesus saith to Simon Peter, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me more than these? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my lambs. He saith to him again the second time, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my sheep. He saith unto him the third time, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me? Peter was grieved because he said unto

him the third time, Lovest thou me? And he said unto him, Lord, thou knowest all things; thou knowest that I love thee. Jesus saith unto him, Feed my sheep. This spake he, signifying by what death he should glorify God. And when he had spoken this, he saith unto him, Follow me. Then Peter, turning about, seeth the disciple whom Jesus loved following; which also leaned on his breast at supper, and said, Lord, which is he that betrayeth thee? Peter seeing him saith to Jesus, Lord, and what shall this man do? Jesus saith unto him, If I will that he tarry till I come, what is that to thee? follow thou me.

As seen from the above, the issue with serving God is two-fold.

1. *Heart is not into it.*
2. *Man judges.*

Children, you have been deceived. Your heart has been hardened with the love of self and the love of many has been waxed cold! Let not the hardness of your hearts reject the truth in God's word. May your heart learn to love the things of God and by your actions may God's gospel of love be preached in all the world.

Matthew 24:11-14 - And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many. And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold. But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved. And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

The heart of the people is waxed gross, ears are dull of hearing and their eyes are closed. God is looking for you to see with your eyes, hear with your ears and understand with the heart, to be converted as a child of God and be healed.

Acts 28:27 - For the heart of this people is waxed gross, and their ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes have they closed; lest they should see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and

understand with their heart, and should be converted, and I should heal them.

1. The Heart:

When it comes to loving and serving God, all that matters is your heart. If Peter loved God from the heart, then not long after seeing Jesus in the risen form from the dead, he wouldn't have told his fellow disciples, "I go a fishing." Three times, Jesus told Peter to follow thou me. Standing face to face to Jesus, Peter says, "What shall this man do." Peter didn't write a gospel, but he wrote a very comprehensive epistle. Peter needed that final visit from Jesus, before Jesus ascended into heaven. When you obey the truth and your heart is converted from a lover of self to a lover of other then you understand God's word.

1 Peter 1:22-23 - Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently: Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

Your goal is to seek to sanctify the Lord God in your heart. Your positive hope and love for another will destroy man's opinion of you. They will not understand why you have such a positive attitude. Of course, that hope in you is in the Lord God. Always be willing to give God the credit.

1 Peter 3:15 - But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear:

That man that Jesus loved got the same message. You are to love one another in deed and in truth. Not just in lip service.

1 John 3:18-23 - My little children, let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in truth. [19] And hereby we know that we are of the truth, and shall assure our hearts before

him. For if our heart condemn us, God is greater than our heart, and knoweth all things. Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, then have we confidence toward God. And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight. And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment.

Peter recognized that you cannot have a converted heart, with eyes full of sin by serving two masters. Adultery in the following verse can be anything that takes you away from serving God.

2 Peter 2:14 - Having eyes full of adultery, and that cannot cease from sin; beguiling unstable souls: an heart they have exercised with covetous practices; cursed children:

Luke 21:34 - And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares.

2 Timothy 2:21-22 - If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet for the master's use, and prepared unto every good work. Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

Draw nigh to God and purify your heart, to be one with a singular purpose and that is to serve God.

James 4:8 - Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded.

Hebrews 10:22 - Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.

Luke 12:34 - For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.

James cautions you for not knowing the truth. The Sunday go to church crowd often misses the truth in God's word.

James 1:26 - If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's religion is vain.

But when God's will is put in your heart, you will know it! You have no fear in spreading the truth in God's word. You will speak on the matters of the heart, unto good works.

Revelation 17:17 - For God hath put in their hearts to fulfil his will, and to agree, and give their kingdom unto the beast, until the words of God shall be fulfilled.

Luke 6:45 - A good man out of the good treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is evil: for of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaketh.

2 Thessalonians 2:17 - Comfort your hearts, and stablish you in every good word and work.

Proverbs 4:4 - He taught me also, and said unto me, Let thine heart retain my words: keep my commandments, and live.

2. The Judge:

Jesus was clear when he told Peter not to judge anyone. Just follow his teachings, period.

John 21:21,22 - Peter seeing him saith to Jesus, Lord, and what shall this man do? Jesus saith unto him, If I will that he tarry till I come, what is that to thee? follow thou me.

The minute you judge, you minimize your work for the Lord. Ever person you come across has been put there by God. That person may be one witness away from following and doing the will of God. They may have been turned off by lucre loving churches and just desire the truth in God's word. That truth and this ministry coming out of you, may lead that person to do the will of God. You see, when you judge, you deny the Father.

Matthew 7:1-2 - Judge not, that ye be not judged. For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again.

Luke 6:37 - Judge not, and ye shall not be judged: condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned: forgive, and ye shall be forgiven:

John 7:24 - Judge not according to the appearance, but judge righteous judgment.

Jesus judged no man.

John 8:15 - Ye judge after the flesh; I judge no man.

His most faithful servant was Mary Magdalene, out of who Jesus cast out seven devils. That person you judge by denying this ministry may be God's next Mary Magdalene.

Mark 16:9 - Now when Jesus was risen early the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast seven devils.

When you judge, you put a stumbling block in the way of the lost.

Romans 14:13 - Let us not therefore judge one another anymore: but judge this rather, that no man put a stumbling block or an occasion to fall in his brother's way.

Remember, there is only one that judges and that is the Lord God.

1 Corinthians 4:4 - For I know nothing by myself; yet am I not hereby justified: but he that judgeth me is the Lord.

Starting today, judge no one and be a doer of God's word by loving God and loving your neighbor.

James 4:10-11 - Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up. Speak not evil one of another, brethren. He that speaketh evil of his brother, and judgeth his brother, speaketh evil of the law, and judgeth the law: but if thou judge the law, thou art not a doer of the law, but a judge.

Luke 10:27 - And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself.

Out of a pure heart and by judging no one, God is looking for you to fulfill his commandment.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 21: Worship

Man worships in the flesh. When you grow up in the flesh then you look for ways to worship in the flesh. This is evident in big box store churches that pack in the people. You start out with coffee and donuts. You go into the worship hall and the musicians are warming up with horns, guitars, drums, violins and flutes. When the service starts, the music blares and people are dancing in their seats. At one church I witnessed to in 2024, the pastor even showed the people how they were supposed to hold their hands in the air and jump up and down to the music to worship God! He explained that if you really want to worship God then you keep the sabbath holy, get baptized in water and give tithes to the church. You can do this all on line. After the caffeine and sugar kicks in, you are good and pumped up, the music stops and then they go after your pocket book with requests for tithes, special offerings and money for the building fund. A quick verse or two and service from the bible and then you are released for another week of serving the things of man in the flesh.

In one church witness, the guitar player decided to put on a show for some young visitors. He confided with one of the parishioners and said he was going to give the visitors a show. He took a jacket and rolled it up to support his neck. During a prayer service by the pastor in the front of the church, the guitar player fell down, as though he had passed out and was flopping around on the floor. The pastor prayed over him and he stopped flopping and stood up as though the pastor healed him.

Another church witness was just the opposite. The pastor came out and assured the people that they are saved and have everlasting life by just believing in Jesus. The piano started playing and you could hear no one singing. After the music, he

told the congregation that they could place their tithes in the baskets at the back of the church. He gave a service from the bible, again promised the people everlasting life by believing in Jesus and the people were released for another week of serving the things of man. This was the most depressing witness.

In those fifty plus church witnesses, I've seen it all. Every church witness was somewhere between these extremes. Modern day church worship is all about serving the creature! They have changed the truth in God's word into a lie.

Romans 1:25-32 - Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen.

From the mouth of one or two witnesses, none of worship services provide any worship to God. Jesus told you how to worship God. He did not tell you to go to church on the sabbath. He did not tell you to give tithes. He did not tell you to get baptized in water. When the devil tempted Jesus and said you can have all this if you worship me, Jesus said that to worship God and him shall you serve.

Matthew 4:10 - Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.

Jesus told you to worship God, then you keep the commandments!

Matthew 19:16-17 - And, behold, one came and said unto him, Good Master, what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life? And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments.

Mark 10:18 - And Jesus said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God.

Luke 18:19 - And Jesus said unto him, Why callest thou me good?
none is good, save one, that is, God.

When you recognize that God is good, you don't seek to please him by whooping, hollering and serving at man's church service. You don't flop around like a fish on a beach to deceive the little ones. You don't promise salvation as that is something only God can give. God gave me this verse at Stonelick Lake, which calls out those that promise salvation to the lost, as a wicked man.

Proverbs 17:23 - A wicked man taketh a gift out of the bosom to pervert the ways of judgment.

Once a false prophet ignores the truth in God's word from the mouth of two or three witnesses and takes a text out of context and promises everlasting life to a lost person, that lost person may never serve God, love God nor love their neighbor. Peter warns against these false prophets.

2 Peter 2:1 - But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.

Jesus gave you two commandments. Love God and love your neighbor. Jesus said to come and follow him.

Luke 18:22 - Now when Jesus heard these things, he said unto him,
Yet lackest thou one thing: sell all that thou hast, and distribute unto the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, follow me.

When you follow Jesus, you do as Jesus did. Jesus bowed his head and prayed often to God the Father. Jesus served his followers. He made sure the hungry were fed. The sick were healed. The misfortunate are taken care of and never think of yourself as

being too good as to serve. As Jesus said, "Happy are they that do them."

John 13:3-8,14-17 - Jesus knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he was come from God, and went to God; He riseth from supper, and laid aside his garments; and took a towel, and girded himself. After that he poureth water into a bason, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel wherewith he was girded. Then cometh he to Simon Peter: and Peter saith unto him, Lord, dost thou wash my feet? Jesus answered and said unto him, What I do thou knowest not now; but thou shalt know hereafter. Peter saith unto him, Thou shalt never wash my feet. Jesus answered him, If I wash thee not, thou hast no part with me. If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet. For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you. Verily, verily, I say unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord; neither he that is sent greater than he that sent him. If ye know these things, happy are ye if ye do them.

When you obey the Gospel of God, you worship God by doing his will. When you believe in God, you worship him by serving your fellow man. Your worship him by your well doing unto a faithful creator.

1 Peter 4:17-19 - For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God? And if the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear? Wherefore let them that suffer according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls to him in well doing, as unto a faithful Creator.

To worship God in spirit and truth and to make a joyful noise unto the Lord.

John 4:23-24 - But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

Psalms 66:1-4 - Make a joyful noise unto God, all ye lands: Sing forth the honour of his name: make his praise glorious. Say unto God, How terrible art thou in thy works! through the greatness of thy power shall thine enemies submit themselves unto thee. All the earth shall worship thee, and shall sing unto thee; they shall sing to thy name. Selah.

To worship God as King and to serve no other gods.

Daniel 3:18 - But if not, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.

Start today by not serving your addiction and self, but by +serving your family and your children. Put your social media down and fix that one thing you've been meaning to fix or that one room you've been meaning to paint. Clear your brain and your being to be able to make time to serve others. To serve that one friend or neighbor that needs your help. Find a volunteer activity at school, church or other to serve man. And most of all, make a joyful noise unto God. To sing unto the Lord. To share the truth in God's word! To share this ministry.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 22: Child of God

“The truth is now you are a child of God, made in the image of a perfect King.” When you choose to live God’s gospel of love unto righteousness, God is waiting for you. You are a child of God. A child of God, sanctified in the womb, to serve the Lord God.

Jeremiah 1:4-5 - Then the word of the Lord came unto me, saying, Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations.

A child of God, chosen to be the light of the world, lost in the things of the Lord God.

Matthew 5:3-10,12,14,16 - Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Blessed are they that mourn: for they shall be comforted. Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth. Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled. Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy. Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God. Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God. Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you. Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

Where do you start? Start as a little child, turning from the sins of the past and turning to God. Recognize God as the creator of the heaven and earth. Start as a little child and seek the truth in his word out of the mouth of two or three witnesses. Accept

God's direction in your life, being led by the spirit out of the bondage of corruption. Only then will you be ready for the kingdom of God.

Mark 10:15 - Verily I say unto you, Whosoever shall not receive the kingdom of God as a little child, he shall not enter therein.

Romans 8:16,21 - The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God.

Do not be led by the vain words of deceit. When you walk as children of God, you turn from the works of the devil.

Ephesians 5:1,3-4,6-8 - Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children; But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints; Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather giving of thanks. Let no man deceive you with vain words: for because of these things cometh the wrath of God upon the children of disobedience. Be not ye therefore partakers with them. For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light:

God's gospel of love is about loving God and loving your neighbor. The devil's gospel is about loving yourself. Drunkenness, hate, stealing, laziness and disobedience are all about self-love. My forty years in addiction was all about self-love. In the eyes of God, self-love means nothing. In the eyes of God, righteousness and love of your brothers and sisters, is all that matters.

1 John 3:10-11 - In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not

of God, neither he that loveth not his brother. For this is the message that ye heard from the beginning, that we should love one another.

When you love one another, you are of God. When you love not, you are not of God.

1 John 4:4,7-8 - Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world. Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God. He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love.

When you love God, then you JUDGE NO ONE. God will reward those that live his Gospel. God looks at your righteousness. Not because you do as others do, but because you live your life for the glory of God.

Psalms 18:24 - Therefore hath the Lord recompensed me according to my righteousness, according to the cleanness of my hands in his eyesight.

When you live your life unto the glory of God, means you broaden your understanding of God's children. Man's religion judges those that come into the church building as being acceptable in the eyes of God. In God's eyes it is just the opposite. God welcomes all his children into his kingdom. Even those that don't look like or act like you. Do not be wise in your own conceit, but live peaceably among all men and women.

Romans 12:16,18-20 - Be of the same mind one toward another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits. If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men. Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.

Therefore, if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head.

God will recompense those that love him and love their neighbor.

Romans 14:3-4,12-13 - Let not him that eateth despise him that eateth not; and let not him which eateth not judge him that eateth: for God hath received him. Who art thou that judgest another man's servant? to his own master he standeth or falleth. Yea, he shall be holden up: for God is able to make him stand. So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God. Let us not therefore judge one another any more: but judge this rather, that no man put a stumblingblock or an occasion to fall in his brother's way.

Hebrews 10:30 - For we know him that hath said, Vengeance belongeth unto me, I will recompense, saith the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge his people.

Hebrews 12:23 - To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect,

James 4:10-12 - Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up. Speak not evil one of another, brethren. He that speaketh evil of his brother, and judgeth his brother, speaketh evil of the law, and judgeth the law: but if thou judge the law, thou art not a doer of the law, but a judge. There is one lawgiver, who is able to save and to destroy: who art thou that judgest another?

God will know his own. His own are not always perfect in your eyes. To that young man in jail, that loved more than any other man, God's spirit was in his heart. He wanted to make sure the service had a positive experience, without video difficulties.

Most judged that young man, negatively. No man in the flesh is capable of judging the heart of a child of God.

In today's chemical laced foods and drug society, the impact on the human body is not understood by man. That impact is understood by God. To that lady I met, her testimony is a severe reaction to food dyes. Red dye number 40 would bring on seizures and lethargic aftermath. Dyes in her son's diet triggers ADHD behavior. To my friend that cares for his daughter that has had several hundred seizures, brought on by foods and refined sugars. You all know of the harmful effects of glyphosate (Roundup) on the human body with exposure leading to non-Hodgkin's lymphoma.

The reaction to these chemicals on the living can be both physical and physiological.

Atrazine is a herbicide that is used to stop pre- and post-emergence broadleaf and grassy weeds in crops such as sorghum, maize, sugarcane, lupins, pine, and eucalypt plantations, and triazine-tolerant canola.

In the United States as of 2014, atrazine was the second-most widely used herbicide after glyphosate, with 76 million pounds (34 thousand metric tons) of it applied each year, nearly identical to its usage in 1974, of 76.8 million pounds. Atrazine continues to be one of the most widely used herbicides in Australian agriculture. Its effect on corn yields has been estimated from 1% to 8%, with 3–4% being the conclusion of one economics review. In another study looking at combined data from 236 university corn field trials from 1986 to 2005, atrazine treatments showed an average increase of 5.7 US bushels per acre (0.50 m³/ha) (~400 kilograms per hectare (360 lb/acre)) than alternative herbicide treatments. Effects on sorghum yields have been estimated to be as high as 20%,

owing in part to the absence of alternative weed control products that can be used on sorghum.

The herbicide atrazine, one of the world's most widely used pesticides, screws up the sex lives of adult male frogs, emasculating three-quarters of them and turning one in ten into females, according to a new study by UC Berkeley's Tyrone Hayes.

You see the effects of atrazine on male frogs. Turns one in ten into females. The effect on humans is not documented nor understood by man.

But what about other drugs ending in -zine. There is a class of medications that end in -zine is known as antipsychotics (also known as neuroleptics). Antipsychotics are primarily used to treat various mental health conditions, such as schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, and severe depression.

Here are a few examples of antipsychotic medications that end in -zine:

- 1. Chlorpromazine: This medication is one of the first-generation antipsychotics and is commonly used to treat psychotic disorders, including schizophrenia.*
- 2. Promethazine: Although primarily used to relieve allergies and nausea, promethazine also has sedative and antipsychotic*
- 3. Thioridazine: Another first-generation antipsychotic, thioridazine is used to manage symptoms of schizophrenia and other related conditions.*

Medications ending in -zine are primarily phenothiazines, a class of antipsychotic drugs managing conditions like schizophrenia. They differ from benzodiazepines, which end in -lam or -pam and are used primarily for anxiety. The medications that

typically end in the suffix -zine are phenothiazines, a class of antipsychotic drugs. These medications are used to manage psychosis, including schizophrenia and bipolar disorder, and work by blocking dopamine receptors in the brain. Examples include chlorpromazine and thioridazine. However, there are also drugs in other classes with names that end in -zine, used for different purposes, such as promethazine, which is an antihistamine. It is important not to confuse these with benzodiazepines, another class of medications often used for anxiety, which have a suffix of -lam or -pam.

The effects of drugs ending in -zine, or benzodiazepines that end in -lam or -pam on a person with a psychotic condition or even promethazine for allergies on unborn fetus is unknown. Atrazine can turn a male frog into a female. Who is to say that these antipsychotic or allergy drugs couldn't have an effect or change the DNA of a human to have characteristic of the opposite sex. None of us have the ability to judge the physical or physiological details of a person as it relates to loving God from the heart. I know that young man in the jail, loved from the heart.

In grade school I was often picked by the teacher to show new students around the school. In the third grade, Paul was not like the others. I showed him around the school, like any other new student. Paul was a loner in school and very few people befriended Paul. Years later, I visited my brother-in-law in the hospital and Paul shared a room with him. Paul was in hospice and dying from a brain tumor. At that time, I asked myself if Paul would have been treated differently if a third grader knew that Paul had a health of physiological issues? This was my first-hand witness of man judging in the flesh. As an adult, I still can't see the physiological makeup of anyone I meet. That is exactly why God said to judge no one! All I can see is their love of self or love or hatred of fellow man.

God's gospel is clear. Turn from sin, love God and love your neighbor. Judge no one. Do this and you shall live.

Romans 14:13 - Let us not therefore judge one another anymore:
but judge this rather, that no man put a stumbling block or an
occasion to fall in his brother's way.

Luke 10:27-28 - And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy
God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy
strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself.
And he said unto him, Thou hast answered right: this do, and
thou shalt live.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 23: Tetelestai

As Christians celebrate the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus this Easter season, let's look at the testimonies of the four witnesses that reported on the event. The preponderance of evidence of the witnesses, should tell you exactly what happened.

Matthew 27:45-50 - Now from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land unto the ninth hour. And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? Some of them that stood there, when they heard that, said, This man calleth for Elias. And straightway one of them ran, and took a sponge, and filled it with vinegar, and put it on a reed, and gave him to drink. The rest said, Let be, let us see whether Elias will come to save him. Jesus, when he had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost. And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent; And the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints which slept arose, And came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many. Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of God.

Mark 15:33-39 - And when the sixth hour was come, there was darkness over the whole land until the ninth hour. And at the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani? which is, being interpreted, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? And some of them that stood by, when they heard it, said, Behold, he calleth Elias. And one ran and filled a sponge full of vinegar, and put it on a reed, and gave him to drink, saying, Let alone; let us see whether Elias

will come to take him down. And Jesus cried with a loud voice, and gave up the ghost. And the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom. And when the centurion, which stood over against him, saw that he so cried out, and gave up the ghost, he said, Truly this man was the Son of God.

Luke 23:32,36-47 - And there were also two other, malefactors, led with him to be put to death. And the soldiers also mocked him, coming to him, and offering him vinegar, And saying, If thou be the king of the Jews, save thyself. And a superscription also was written over him in letters of Greek, and Latin, and Hebrew, THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS. And one of the malefactors which were hanged railed on him, saying, If thou be Christ, save thyself and us. But the other answering rebuked him, saying, Dost not thou fear God, seeing thou art in the same condemnation? And we indeed justly; for we receive the due reward of our deeds: but this man hath done nothing amiss. And he said unto Jesus, Lord, remember me when thou comest into thy kingdom. And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, To day shalt thou be with me in paradise. And it was about the sixth hour, and there was a darkness over all the earth until the ninth hour. And the sun was darkened, and the veil of the temple was rent in the midst. And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost. Now when the centurion saw what was done, he glorified God, saying, Certainly this was a righteous man.

John 19:28-30 - After this, Jesus knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the scripture might be fulfilled, saith, I thirst. Now there was set a vessel full of vinegar: and they filled a sponge with vinegar, and put it upon hyssop, and put it to his mouth. When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he

said, It is finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.

Four witnesses with similar, but different testimonies. Let's compare:

Four witnesses testified that vinegar was offered to Jesus to drink.

Four witnesses testified that Jesus gave up the ghost or died on the cross.

Three witnesses testified that a sponge was soaked in vinegar and offered to Jesus.

Three witnesses testified that the veil of the temple was rent or split from top to bottom.

Two witnesses stated that Jesus cried in a loud voice – “My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?”

Two witnesses testified that the centurion stated that truly this man was the Son of God.

One witness testified that the inscription on the cross was, THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS.

One witness testified that Jesus told the malefactor that defended him, “Verily I say unto thee, Today shalt thou be with me in paradise.”

One witness testified that when Jesus stated, “Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit; and having said thus, he gave up the ghost,” right before he passed.

One witness testified that the graves were opened and bodies of saints rose and went into the city, after Jesus's resurrection.

One witness testified that Jesus's last word on the cross, in Greek, was "Tetelestai." Translated from Greek to English, it means "It is finished."

It is clear from the testimonies of two or three witnesses and the preponderance of evidence that you know for sure that Jesus was offered vinegar to drink on the cross, the temple veil was rent in two, Jesus yelled out that God had abandoned him, Jesus died on the cross and the centurion testified that Jesus was surely the Son of God.

Jesus's death on the cross confirmed that God had sent Jesus as a blood sacrifice for sin and repentance for Israel. God was tired of the Jews living in sin with a continuum of blood and animal sacrifices performed with no change of heart. Burnt offerings made for the remembrance of and pleasure of sin every year. Blood and sacrifice made for the forgiveness of sins. Paul made it clear to the Hebrews that the blood and goats and bulls cannot take away sin.

Hebrews 10:3-6,8,11 - But in those sacrifices there is a remembrance again made of sins every year. For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins. Wherefore when he cometh into the world, he saith, Sacrifice and offering thou wouldest not, but a body hast thou prepared me: In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin thou hast had no pleasure. Above when he said, Sacrifice and offering and burnt offerings and offering for sin thou wouldest not, neither hadst pleasure therein ; which are offered by the law; And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins:

Jesus was required to be the final sacrifice for sin, so the Jews could live God's gospel of love. Turning from sin, loving God and loving their neighbor.

Matthew 26:28 - For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

Mark 14:24-25 - And he said unto them, This is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many.

Luke 22:20 - Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you.

Acts 5:31 - Him hath God exalted with his right hand to be a Prince and a Savior, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins.

Acts 13:38-39 - Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins: And by him all that believe are justified from all things, from which ye could not be justified by the law of Moses.

Acts 26:18 - To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.

Colossians 1:14 - In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:

Ephesians 1:7 - In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

Hebrews 10:12 - But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down on the right hand of God;

Romans 3:25 - Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the

remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;

This was not going to be a small task for Jesus. The first sacrifice of a ram was performed by Abraham. Between Abraham and Jesus were 42 generations. 42 generations and millions of participants performing daily, weekly and yearly animal burnt offerings and blood sacrifice for the forgiveness of sin engrained into their religious acts. Doing anything less than the traditions passed down throughout the generations would be considered heresy.

Genesis 22:13 - And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind him a ram caught in a thicket by his horns: and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering in the stead of his son.

Exodus 10:24-25 - And Moses said, Thou must give us also sacrifices and burnt offerings, that we may sacrifice unto the Lord our God.

Leviticus 1:3-4 - If his offering be a burnt sacrifice of the herd, let him offer a male without blemish: he shall offer it of his own voluntary will at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation before the Lord. And he shall put his hand upon the head of the burnt offering; and it shall be accepted for him to make atonement for him.

Numbers 29:5 - And one kid of the goats for a sin offering, to make an atonement for you:

Ezekiel 45:23 - And seven days of the feast he shall prepare a burnt offering to the Lord, seven bullocks and seven rams without blemish daily the seven days; and a kid of the goats daily for a sin offering.

Turning from sin by repentance was not performed in Old Testament. The wickedness of man was great on the earth and God had repented the creation of man. God had repented multiple times for the wickedness in man.

Genesis 6:5-6 - And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. And it repented the Lord that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart.

God repented of the evil for the people of Nineveh and when they followed Jonah, God repented.

Jonah 3:9-10 - Who can tell if God will turn and repent, and turn away from his fierce anger, that we perish not? And God saw their works, that they turned from their evil way; and God repented of the evil, that he had said that he would do unto them; and he did it not.

Matthew 12:41 - The men of Nineveh shall rise in judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: because they repented at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas is here.

God will judge his people. If the nation turns from sin, then God will repent of the evil that he would do unto them.

Jeremiah 18:5,8 - Then the word of the Lord came to me, saying, If that nation, against whom I have pronounced, turn from their evil, I will repent of the evil that I thought to do unto them.

Psalms 135:14 - For the Lord will judge his people, and he will repent himself concerning his servants.

The act of water baptism was introduced by John the Baptist as an act meant for repentance and turning from sin. An act

designed to replace burnt offerings and blood sacrifice. Jesus preached repentance.

Matthew 3:2 - And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Mark 1:4 - John did baptize in the wilderness, and preach the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins.

Matthew 4:17 -From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Matthew 9:13 - But go ye and learn what that meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

Mark 6:12 - And they went out, and preached that men should repent.

Luke 5:32 - I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

Luke 13:3,5 - I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish. I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.

Luke 15:10 - Likewise, I say unto you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner that repenteth.

Acts 8:22 - Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee.

2 Peter 3:9 -The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

Revelation 16:11 - And blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and repented not of their deeds.

With Jesus being rebuked by the Jews, God made the gift of life available to the Gentiles.

Acts 11:18 - When they heard these things, they held their peace, and glorified God, saying, Then hath God also to the Gentiles granted repentance unto life.

Acts 26:20 - But shewed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judaea, and then to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God, and do works meet for repentance.

Decision: From the preponderance of evidence testimonies out of the mouth of two or three witnesses, God was clear in his gospel the direction of righteousness required for the Jews and the Gentiles.

- 1) *God no longer desired animal and blood sacrifice for the forgiveness of sins.*
- 2) *Jesus's death on the cross was the final blood sacrifice for sin.*
- 3) *God requires man to live a life unto righteousness by repenting and turning from sin.*
- 4) *A righteous life by giving glory of God, loving God and loving your neighbor. No longer walking in darkness with the devil.*
- 5) *God's gift of everlasting life is made available to the Gentiles.*

In this Christian holiday season of celebrating Easter, it is clear that the word that Jesus spoke, "Tetelestai", meant exactly the translation quoted in the bible, "It is finished," and nothing more. The physical church used for the sacrifice of animals and blood is finished as indicated by the temple veil being rent.

The animal sacrifice for past sins is finished. Your sinful life is finished as your turn from darkness and sin, being born again as a child of God, walking in the light of the Lord. Your old life is finished as God wants your heart being led by the Holy Ghost, living a life giving him the glory. When you decide to live God's gospel of love, your war with Satan has just begun. He wants you back, living a life of sin. Stand firm, be not afraid and use the power of God to maintain your walk in the light.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 24: Signs and Wonders

God knows your heart.

1 Samuel 16:7 - But the Lord said unto Samuel, Look not on his countenance, or on the height of his stature; because I have refused him: for the Lord seeth not as man seeth; for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the Lord looketh on the heart.

When it comes to believing and walking with the Lord thy God, you must have faith. Faith in the almighty, the creator of heaven and earth. When one is brought up in the church, walking to the beat of the church has replaced the true walk with the Lord thy God. Faith has been replaced by the beat of the church. You say you believe in God, because you associate with those that say they believe and do the things of the church. The question is do you believe in God and are you doing the will of God. The disciples walked with Jesus and they too had trouble believing.

John 4:48 - Then said Jesus unto him, Except ye see signs and wonders, ye will not believe.

Following the resurrection of Jesus Christ, he had witnessed to the women that believed in him and they remembered his words. The disciples and others did not believe the women, when they reported that Jesus had risen from the dead. Those non-believers were but fools.

Luke 24:8-11,24-26 - And they remembered his words, And returned from the sepulchre, and told all these things unto the eleven, and to all the rest. It was Mary Magdalene, and Joanna, and Mary the mother of James, and other women that were with them, which told these things unto the apostles. And their words seemed to them as idle tales, and they

believed them not. And certain of them which were with us went to the sepulchre, and found it even so as the women had said: but him they saw not. Then he said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken: Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory?

At the first meeting of the resurrected Jesus with his believers, Thomas was not present. Despite all the miracles that Jesus performed, Thomas did not believe that Jesus rose from the dead. In the second meeting, Thomas was present.

John 20:26-31 - And after eight days again his disciples were within, and Thomas with them: then came Jesus, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, Peace be unto you. Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing. And Thomas answered and said unto him, My Lord and my God. Jesus saith unto him, Thomas, because thou hast seen me, thou hast believed: blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed. And many other signs truly did Jesus in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book: But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name.

When you walk with God, he will use you to promote and do the will of God. Many that say they believe, will not believe that God can still communicate with his followers on earth. When you seek the truth, God will prevail.

When I witnessed to a pastor that God had texted me. "Ecclesiastes", and later, in a time of distress against preaching false doctrine, God had texted me, "Romans 8:28", the pastor said that God doesn't reach people like that. God created

heaven and earth. God can text! To be used of God, is all that God is looking for.

Romans 8:28 - And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

God texted me Romans 8:28 on 9/6/21. At the time I did not realize it, but in bible numbers. 9/6/21 translates into "a message from God to a man in distress." I was distressed, because a church of man, cannot save anyone from death and the promise of life everlasting, especially a man lost in self-love and addiction. You must believe and accept a future with God, by your own free-will by believing in God and his gospel. You must believe that God sent Jesus to present his gospel of love. To believe that you are to repent of your sins and turn your life over from self-love to loving God and loving your neighbor. God never said to fall in love with yourself. Addiction and sin are all about self-love. Man's church, in love with filthy lucre, wants you to believe that you are saved from death by telling yourself that you believe in Jesus and you are saved. Saved from what, I do not know. I am here to tell you that God wants your heart. Until you give God your heart, only then will your life change. If you are addicted to drugs and alcohol, then the addiction to the things of the devil will keep you from enjoying life, living to the glory of God, that he has designed for you.

Never doubt the power of God. Do not doubt that God has a plan for you. Think back on those times when God has saved you from destructionIf there is one instance in your memory where God has spared you from destruction, then that is a sign, that God has been waiting for you.

God is not looking for bible scholars. God picked twelve disciples to spread his word with Jesus, that were far from bible scholars.

They were everyday blue-collar workers, fishermen, tax collector and a zealot that hated Roman rule. Not scholarly by any means. I was trained in living a life for God, but was not fluent in bible knowledge. At 59 years old, God told me that I needed to understand his words in the bible. His training in the dealings in my life and his words that you shall know the truth out of the mouth of two or three witnesses, is a game changer. Ten gospel books later, God prevails. If you let God use you, then he will. Do not get confused by comparing your life against others. Decide today to live your life for the glory of God. Compare your life to no one. Compare your life against the life that God has waiting for you to live. To spread his word of love and to be used of God. Today, tell others of this ministry. Do not be ashamed of God's word.

Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord unto eternal life.

To God be the glory in all you do, Amen.

Chapter 25: Lord's Commandments

By now it should come as no surprise to you that the eight witnesses did not testify to the truth in God's word out of the mouth of one witness. God wants women to serve equally with men in the New Testament. Only one witness Paul, spoke out against women serving in the church equal with men. Likewise, when we think of the New Testament Commandments, you also know that the witnesses, Matthew, Mark, Luke, John and Peter walked with Jesus. As Jesus's brothers, James and Jude knew him as one. Let's look at their testimonies. As far as the commandments go, let's review what the Lord has told us.

Matthew 5:19,21,27,31-32,43-44 - Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven. Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not kill; and whosoever shall kill shall be in danger of the judgment: Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not commit adultery: It hath been said, Whosoever shall put away his wife, let him give her a writing of divorcement: But I say unto you, That whosoever shall put away his wife, saving for the cause of fornication, causeth her to commit adultery: and whosoever shall marry her that is divorced committeth adultery. Ye have heard that it hath been said, Thou shalt love thy neighbour, and hate thine enemy. But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;

Matthew 19:17-19 - And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments. He saith unto him, Which? Jesus said, Thou shalt do no murder, Thou shalt not

commit adultery, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Honour thy father and thy mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

Mark 10:17-21 - And when he was gone forth into the way, there came one running, and kneeled to him, and asked him, Good Master, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life? And Jesus said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God. Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honour thy father and mother. And he answered and said unto him, Master, all these have I observed from my youth. Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow me.

Mark 12:29-31 - And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord: And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment. And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.

Luke 18:20-22 - Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Honour thy father and thy mother. And he said, All these have I kept from my youth up. Now when Jesus heard these things, he said unto him, Yet lackest thou one thing: sell all that thou hast, and distribute unto the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, follow me.

Jesus told you that when you love God the Father, you keep his commandments.

John 14:15,31 - If ye love me, keep my commandments. But that the world may know that I love the Father; and as the Father gave me commandment, even so I do. Arise, let us go hence.

John 15:10-12 - If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love. These things have I spoken unto you, that my joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full. This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you.

2 John 1:6 - And this is love, that we walk after his commandments. This is the commandment, That, as ye have heard from the beginning, ye should walk in it.

John 8:12 - Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

James is clear. These commandments are to be treated individually. If you break one commandment, then you break them all. Give your heart to God and he will lift you up.

James 2:11 - For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill. Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill, thou art become a transgressor of the law.

James 4:7-8,10,17 - Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded. Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up. Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.

The love of God is perfected in you when you keep his commandments and abide in the light. To obtain the promises, then keep yourself from the lusts of the flesh.

1 John 2:3,5,7-8,10,15-16 - And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments. But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him. Brethren, I write no new commandment unto you, but an old commandment which ye had from the beginning. The old commandment is the word which ye have heard from the beginning. Again, a new commandment I write unto you, which thing is true in him and in you: because the darkness is past, and the true light now shineth. He that loveth his brother abideth in the light, and there is none occasion of stumbling in him. Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

Peter 1:4 - Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

By doing the will of God, you will not pass away.

1 John 2:16-17 - For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.

1 Peter 2:12,15-17 - Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by your good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation. For so is the will of God, that with

well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men:
As free, and not using your liberty for a cloke of maliciousness,
but as the servants of God. Honour all men. Love the
brotherhood. Fear God. Honour the king.

1 Peter 4:2 - That he no longer should live the rest of his time in the
flesh to the lusts of men, but to the will of God.

*Both Matthew and Luke caution you not to waste the days until the
coming of the Lord.*

Matthew 24:48-51 - But and if that evil servant shall say in his
heart, My lord delayeth his coming; And shall begin to smite
his fellowservants, and to eat and drink with the drunken; The
lord of that servant shall come in a day when he looketh not
for him, and in an hour that he is not aware of, And shall cut
him asunder, and appoint him his portion with the hypocrites:
there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Luke 12:45-46 - But and if that servant say in his heart, My lord
delayeth his coming; and shall begin to beat the menservants
and maidens, and to eat and drink, and to be drunken; The
lord of that servant will come in a day when he looketh not for
him, and at an hour when he is not aware, and will cut him in
sunder, and will appoint him his portion with the unbelievers.

Luke 21:34 - And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your
hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and
cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares.

*God's commandments are clear for the New Testament believer:
Do not commit adultery; Do not kill; Do not steal; Do not bear
false witness; Honor thy father and thy mother; Love God; Love
neighbor. If you break one of these, you break them all. You
are told to walk in the light doing the will of God with a pure
heart and not serving the lusts of the flesh as in drunkenness.*

Instead of doing the will of God, you may be distracted and your gut instinct will want to judge others against the sins of the flesh referred to in the epistles of Paul. Paul is but one witness. You are told not to judge others, as God is the judge. You have been given the commandments. Keep yourself in the love of God and may the peace of the Lord be with you. Judge no one, share God's word and pray for God's blessings in 2025. Do this and you shall live.

The question is, are you walking with God today? Are you open to the truth in God's word, that out of the mouth of two or three witnesses you shall know the truth. Never doubt the power of God and what he can do in your life. Starting today, give God a chance and your life will change!
